NEWS:

STORM TOWER REQUIRES KNEE SURGERY: 1993 Wood Memorial (G1) winner **STORM TOWER** will be sidelined at least four months following arthroscopic surgery to remove chips from his left knee. The three-year-old son of **IRISH TOWER** out of the **STORM BIRD** mare **STORM DOLL** has won 5-of-11 starts, including the Fountain of Youth S. (G2), placed in three other stakes, and earned \$661,394. The colt runs in the colors of Charles Hesse and the Estate of Anthony Toretta and is trained by Ben Perkins Jr.

WOODBINE GETS 193 THOROUGHBRED DATES FOR '94: The Ontario Racing Commission has awarded Woodbine 193 Thoroughbred race dates and 136 Standardbred dates for the 1994 racing season. Harness racing will commence January 1 through mid-March, make a return stint June through August, then resume again in December. Meanwhile, Thoroughbred racing will start March 19, and run continuously through December 10, five days a week. Greenwood will close its live horse-racing operation at the end of this year.

BELONG TO ME: RETIRES: Boojum H. (G3) winner **BELONG TO ME** has been retired, and will stand his first season at Sugar Maple Farm near Poughquag, New York. The four-year-old son of **DANZIG** out of the **EXCLUSIVE NATIVE** mare **BELONGING** won 7-of-16 starts, including the Belding S. (G3), placed in three other stakes, and earned \$25,000. Lou Salerno of Questroyal Stable purchased the New Jersey-bred from Joe and Mrs. Stevola who bred and raced **BELONG TO ME** under their Middletown Stable banner. He'll be syndicated, and the fee is set at \$5,000 live foal.

WAGERING UP 3% AT BELMONT: Belmont concluded its Fall meet yesterday, posting a record average daily handle (\$7,042,982 vs. \$6,840,000 in 1992). The increase is due to an 89.9% jump in pari-mutuel

wagering. Daily attendance was down 11.4% from last year's average (10,536 vs. 9,330). Mike Smith rode 20 more winners than his closest competitor (67), while Shug McGaughey took the trainer's title with 18 winners during the 41-day stand.

FORMER MONMOUTH CHAIRMAN SCHLEY DIES: Reeve Schley Jr., former Chairman of the Board of Monmouth Park Jockey Club, died Sunday at his home following a lengthy illness. He was 84. Horses he campaigned raced as Raritan Stable.

JOCK SHORTS: Apprentice jockeys Eibar Coa, Olaf Hernandez, and Teofilo Perdomo have each been handed 60-day suspensions for failing to account for all their riding victories prior to arriving in the U.S., thus abusing the privilege of the apprentice allowance. The Florida Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering will consider the recommendations for further penalty (suspensions of up to two years). Four other jockeys remain under investigation, including last year's Eclipse-award winning apprentice Jesus Bracho. Eddie Delahoussaye collected four wins (including a pair of stakes) at Santa Anita Sunday before the meet's largest crowd (36,708). Corey Black won three consecutive stakes on Cal Cup Day. Pat Valenzuela landed 31 Sunday.
