SILVER ENDING RETIRES: Pegasus H. (G1) winner **SILVER ENDING** has been retired and will stand at Blue Ridge Farm near Upperville, Virginia. The six-year-old son of **SILVER HAWK** out of the ***HAWAII** mare **COPPERHEAD** won 8-of-37 starts, including four stakes (three graded), placed in five other stakes (three graded), and earned \$1,073,420. Recently acquired by Mr. and Mrs. Roy L. Ash, **SILVER ENDING** will stand for \$3,500 live foal.

MEADOWLANDS PURSE HIKE: Effective October 22, purses at Meadowlands will be raised 12%, resulting in an average \$14,000 per day increase in total daily purses. Originally, the hike was not scheduled to go into effect until November 1.

MACK MILLER SCHEDULED FOR SURGERY: Hall of Fame trainer Mack Miller, who conditioned **SEA HERO** to a Kentucky Derby (G1) victory earlier this year, is scheduled to undergo gall bladder surgery today in Kentucky.
