NEWS:

FINNEY MAKING GOOD PROGRESS: John Finney was "very alert," sitting up and eating Thursday, following a heart transplant October 18. "His doctors are very pleased with his recovery rate," son Michael Finney said. "He's doing very well, all things considered." The former Fasig-Tipton Co. chairman underwent the transplant at the University of Kentucky before dawn on Monday.

ARBORCREST PUT DOWN: Multiple stakes winner ARBORCREST was humanely destroyed Saturday after developing an undetermined infection. The nine-year-old son of CHICAGO out of the GOOD COUNSEL mare BAD ADVICE, idle since June with a foot infection, became seriously ill Friday. Veterinarians at New Bolton Center were unable to determine the cause of the massive infection. ARBORCREST won 12-of-58 starts, three stakes, placed in 14 other stakes, and earned \$296,729.

FRENCH HORSES UNLIKELY FOR LAUREL: This weekend's Laurel Turf Festival will most likely run without the international flavor it had hoped to produce. Air France cargo workers remain on strike, thus eliminating any chance of French-based horses shipping publicly. Six horses from France had intended to compete during the festival. Britain-based INCHINOR (GB) arrived Wednesday for the Washington International Mile S. (G1), and MYZA is expected to arrive Thursday.

MACK MILLER DISCHARGED AFTER SURGERY. Hall of Fame trainer Mack Miller was discharged from the University of Kentucky's Markey Center yesterday morning, after a successful gall bladder operation.

LIEBAU RESIGNS AS PRESIDENT OF CTBA: Jack Liebau resigned as president of the California Thoroughbred Breeders Association Wednesday, at the CTBA's monthly board meeting. Earlier this year Liebau accepted a permanent position as president of Bay Meadows, and he found the two positions difficult to maintain.
