NEWS:

CREME FRAICHE OWNER IN WRECK: Brushwood Stable owner Elizabeth Moran, 63, who raced 1985 Belmont S. (G1) winner CREME FRAICHE, was in a single-car accident Wednesday evening in Pennsylvania. Mrs. Moran broke her left wrist and has a fractured hip. She will be in traction for two weeks.

SANTA ANITA SET FOR BREEDERS' CUP DAY: Santa Anita's backstretch is officially ready for Breeders' Cup X, as two barns have been converted into quarantine barns for the approximately 50 foreign-based horses expected to arrive within the next few weeks. Following a minimum 36-hour quarantine period, foreign horses must be isolated for the duration of their visit, according to the USDA. A separate barn on the grounds has been designated as the isolation barn. "In previous Breeders' Cups in southern California, the horses had to be quarantined at a facility near the airport," explained Tom Factor, stable superintendent for Santa Anita. "Every time you load or unload a horse, there's the possibility of an injury. This is just so much better for the horses, and much more convenient."

MASTER AGREEMENT BETWEEN LONE STAR, GRAND PRAIRIE: The Grand Prairie Sports Development Corporation signed a "master agreement" with the Lone Star Jockey Club, spelling out terms and conditions for the construction and operation of a \$105-million world-class racetrack in the city of Grand Prairie. The agreement clears the way for Lone Star to finalize financing for the facility's construction. The new racetrack will be named Grand Prairie's Lone Star Park and is expected to be complete by spring of 1995.
