NEWS:

BREEDERS' CUP PRE-ENTRIES FOR NOV. 6 CHAMPIONSHIP: The tenth annual Breeders' Cup Championship, set for November 6 at Santa Anita, has attracted 103 pre-entrants, including 23 from Europe. In races which are oversubscribed (more than 14 horses pre-entered), the top eight Breeders' Cup point earners gain automatic berths. The remaining six horses are selected by the Breeders' Cup Racing Directors/Secretaries panel. The first 14 horses pre-entered are listed in alphabetical order. The panel has also ranked all horses not selected into the field in preference order. Should there be defection from the fields, horses will fill any vacancies in the order of ranking until time of entry, Wednesday, November 3 at 10:00 a.m. Following are all pre-entrants in respective races:

Not selected, listed by preference: DIAZO, GRAND JEWEL, JOLYPHA, PLEASANT TANGO. **HERNANDO (Fr) - 1st preference is Turf; JOLYPHA - 1st preference is Distaff.

ADDITIONAL CUP CLIPS: BEST PAL and BERTRANDO are not nominated to the Breeders' Cup and must be supplemented to the Classic at a fee of \$360,000, or 12% of the total purse. PASEANA (Arg) and GOLD SPRING (Arg) must also pay the supplemental fees for their respective races at 20% of the total purse. Five of last year's Cup winners return—GILDED TIME, PASEANA (Arg), FRAISE, LURE, and THIRTY SLEWS. The other two '92 winners were ELIZA (sidelined) and A. P. INDY (retired). Juvenile fillies pre-entrant ASTAS FOXY LADY will be saddled by a new trainer, Frank Veiga, after former trainer Billy Bob Manuel was fired Monday due to "personal reasons," according to owner Murray Valene. BARRETT'S SALE POSTS 17.3% GAIN IN AVERAGE: Barretts Equine Limited Fall yearling and mixed sale concluded Tuesday with a 17.3% increase in average from the 1992 sale. The two-day vendue sold 425 horses for an average of \$5,070, compared to 548 lots averaging \$4,324

last year. Median price of \$2,800 was 12% higher than last year's median of \$2,500. JIG'S JOVE, a seven-year-old mare by NORTHERN JOVE out of the NEVER BEND mare JIG JIG brought the top bid of \$64,000 from leading buyer Jens L. List Jr. Leading consignor Cedar Hills Farm, agent, sold the mare in the final session, as well as the seven-year-old mare FIRE DAWN, the second-highest priced horse at \$50,000. Highest-priced weanling was a \$33,000 CAPOTE filly; top two-year-old was a WILD AGAIN filly for \$37,000, while two yearlings (by PHONE TRICK and TANK'S PROSPECT) each brought \$40,000.

SIXTH HORSE MUTILATION IN MARYLAND REPORTED: Maryland horsemen are concerned for their animals' welfare after a sixth case of mutilation was reported since June. The most recent attack was on an ex-racehorse in Marlboro, Md., in which the horse was humanely destroyed due to a severely cut sex organ and broken neck. Authorities assume the horse broke his neck when his perpetrator attempted to castrate him. Using national and international intelligence resources, Maryland police and surrounding state police are in the process of compiling a computer analysis of all such cases in Maryland, Pennsylvania, Delaware, and Virginia in hopes of obtaining a psychological profile. "We have leads and multiple suspects," said investigator Gary Bachtell. Although each case has differed somewhat, officials have "reason to believe the cases are linked."

INVITEES TO JAPAN CUP: Ten foreign-bred horses, including four based in North America, have been invited to the November 28 Japan Cup, the world's richest race with a total purse of \$3.645-million. Turf specialists KOTASHAAN (Fr), BIEN BIEN, FLAWLESSLY, and STAR OF COZZENE are the representatives from America. DR. KIERNAN, FRAISE, JOHANN QUATZ (Fr), KISSIN KRIS, KNOW HEIGHTS, LUAZUR (Fr), MISSIONARY RIDGE (GB), PETESKI, SAMOURZAKAN, and SOLAR SPLENDOR are reserves in the event any invitee does not compete. Europe will be represented by four invitees, as well: URBAN SEA, WHITE MUZZLE, HERNANDO, and OPERA HOUSE. (Reserves are APPLE TREE, DANCENNE, DERNIER EMPEREUR, HUSBAND, MISIL, PLATINI, SHEMAKA, USER FRIENDLY, VERT AMANDE, and VERVEINE). Two entrants from Australia and New Zealand have been invited: NATURALISM and THE PHANTOM CHANCE. Reserves from Oceania include OUR POMPEII, THE PHANTOM, and VEANDERCROSS.
