NEWS:

JOLYPHA RETIRED AFTER SESAMOID INJURY: French champion filly JOLYPHA cracked a sesamoid in her right foreleg while working Thursday at Hollywood Park and will be shipped to her owner-breeder Juddmonte Farm's Kentucky division in three weeks to become a broodmare. The injury was not life-threatening and did not require surgery. The four-year-old KY-bred daughter of LYPHARD out of the DRONE mare NAVAJO PRINCESS won 4-of-10 starts in France and North America, and earned \$973,226. She finished third in last year's Breeders' Cup Classic (G1) in her initial dirt start. Trainer Bobby Frankel was pointing JOLYPHA, a full sister to multiple champion DANCING BRAVE (\$1,500,937), to the Distaff (G1).

PARTY CITED INJURED, DIAGNOSIS PENDING: PARTY CITED, another Distaff (G1) hopeful, kicked the back wall of her stall at Santa Anita Friday morning and injured her right hind leg. Trainer Rodney Rash will evaluate the preliminary X-rays and get different opinions from veterinarians. "We don't think it's a fracture at this point," Rash said. "It could be just soft tissue damage." Additional X-rays are scheduled.

SANTA ANITA AWARDED MAKE-UP DATE: Santa Anita was awarded November 15 as a make-up day to replace Thursday's cancellation due to dense smoke from the area's rampant wildfires.

STATOBLEST TO COOLMORE STUD: King George S. (Eng-G3) winner STATOBLEST has been bought to stand at Coolmore Stud for 1994. The seven-year-old son of Ahonoora—Statira, by Skymaster, which stood his first three seasons in England, won or placed in six stakes, including five group events, and earned \$205,803. His stud fee will be announced at a later date.

SANTAGATA ALL-TIME LEADING RIDER AT MEADOWLANDS: Nick Santagata registered his 739th career Meadowlands victory last night, eclipsing Herb McCauley's old mark of 738.
