CROWD, HANDLE RECORDS ECLIPSED AT 10TH BREEDERS' CUP A record crowd of 87,674 at Santa Anita and its satellite locations wagered a North American record \$36,258,799 on Saturday's 10th Breeders' Cup Championship card. The previous North American handle mark of \$28,534,599 was set by the Churchill Downs satellite network on the '93 Kentucky Derby Day program. The previous single-day attendance record at Santa Anita was 85,527, set on the day of the '85 Santa Anita Handicap. The on-track attendance at Santa Anita Saturday was 55,130; the on-track handle was \$15,006,557. In appreciation of fans' support on Breeders' Cup Day, there will be free general admission today at Santa Anita Park.

SURPRISE ENDING FOR CLASSIC The 10th edition of the \$10 million Breeders' Cup Championship at Santa Anita followed the script very closely—until 133-1 longshot Arcangues upset the final act. It was either the favorite or the second choice taking five of the first six Breeders' Cup races, and as the Classic field flew down the stretch, it looked like Bertrando, the solid choice, would play the starring role in the finale. But a little-known player from France spoiled his performance, coasting by the favorite inside the eighth pole to win by two lengths. Arcangues paid \$269.20 at Santa Anita, the highest price ever for a Breeders' Cup winner. He gave trainer Andre Fabre his second Breeders' Cup win; it was the five year old's first start on the dirt. Fabre nearly pulled off a similar feat in the '92 Breeders' Cup when his Jolypha, a threeyear-old filly trying the main track for the first time, finished third in the Classic, just 2 1/2 lengths behind A.P. Indy.

KEENELAND'S NOV. SALE STARTS MONDAY

Keeneland's November Breeding Stock Sale starts Monday with more than 2,500 horses and stallion shares scheduled to be sold during the seven-day auction. Broodmares (1,376) and weanlings (1,031) comprise the bulk of the horses cataloged for the annual sale. Among the dispersals offered are Woodrow D. Marriott, Carelaine Farm, and Wooden Horse Investments. Each of the 10 leading sires, including Danzig and Mr. Prospector, will be represented by mares carrying their foals and by weanlings. Last year, Keeneland sold 1,938 horses and shares for \$73,228,900. Sessions begin at 10:00 a.m. daily.

Making his first-ever start on the dirt, rank outsider Arcangues galloped past favored pacesetter Bertrando in deep stretch to take the Classic under jockey Jerry Bailey. Sent off at odds of 133-1, the Kentucky-bred five year old saved the day for the European contingent and set a record for the highest priced winner in Breeders' Cup history. The victory gave both trainer Andre Fabre (In the Wings, '90 Turf) and Jerry Bailey (Black Tie Affair, '91 Classic) their second Breeders' Cup wins. Peteski was scratched from the race due to swelling in his right front ankle.

Mandella a perfect two-for-two Breeders' Cup Day, as the trainer also saddled winner Phone Chatter in the Juvenile Fillies. The win was the first in a Breeders' Cup race for Desormeaux; it also gave Kotashaan his fifth Grade I triumph on the year, solid credentials for a bid at Horse of the Year honors.

Keeping his record unblemished, Brocco makes his stakes debut a winning one as he powered by the field for a commanding five-length win in the Juvenile. Ridden by Gary Stevens, the two year old set a new Breeders' Cup Juvenile stakes record, running the mile and a sixteenth in 1:42 4/5; he is now threefor-three. This was the second Breeders' Cup win of the day for the stallion Kris S., who also sired Distaff winner Hollywood Wildcat, as well as '89 Turf winner Prized. Dehere, the only odds-on favorite of the afternoon, stalked the pace and made a move to the leaders on the far turn, but faded in the stretch to finish eighth.

Despite the fact that jockey Eddie Delahoussay lost his whip in the final yards, the choice in the eight-horse field was able to hold off the late charge of the older Paseana to win by a nose. It was the seventh Breeders' Cup win for Delahoussaye, tying him with Laffit Pincay Jr. for most Cup wins by a jockey. This was the first of two Breeders' Cup winners on the afternoon for sire Kris S.

As happened in the Oak Leaf Stakes four weeks ago, Phone Chatter rallied on the outside to catch the speedy Sardula in the final strides for the victory in the Juvenile Fillies. Sent off as the third choice at 5-2, the two year old notched her second consecutive Grade I stakes and gave her trainer, Richard Mandella, his first of two Breeders' Cup wins on the day. The win was the seventh in a Breeders' Cup race for jockey Laffit Pincay Jr., tying him with Eddie Delahoussaye for most Cup wins for a rider. Favored Heavenly Prize stayed close to the pace early and made a bid for the lead from the inside at the top of the stretch, but could not sustain and finished third.

In a repeat of the 1992 Sprint, the filly Meafara sped out of the gate and set all of the fractions, but once again she was bested in the very last jump as this year's winner, Cardmania, closed from ninth to win by a neck under jockey Eddie Delahoussaye. There were three previous Breeders' Cup winners in the field: Gilded Time, making his first start since winning the '92 Juvenile, finished a very strong third; last year's Sprint winner Thirty Slews was fourth; and '90 Juvenile winner Fly So Free was a disappointing ninth. The seven-year-old gelding Cardmania became the oldest horse ever to win a Breeders' Cup race.
