### SARDULA POINTING FOR HOLLYWOOD

**STARLET** Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies runner-up SARDULA is on schedule for the GI \$250,000 Hollywood Starlet Dec. 18, according to trainer Brian Mayberry. The 2-year-old will work at Santa Anita next Friday or Saturday.

### NONPRODUCTIVEASSET, JAHAFIL OUT OF TURF CUP

The Hollywood Turf Cup lost 2 prospective starters Saturday: trainer Wally Dollase said of his nominee NONPRODUCTIVEASSET, "He had mucous after he ran in the Hollywood Derby. It hasn't cleared up, so we're sending him to the farm for 10 days." Five-year-old JAHAFIL suffered an injury to his right foreleg during a workout at Hollywood yesterday; with Alex Solis in the saddle, the winner of the Political Ambition H. was in the final 1/16th of his breeze when he took a bad step and had to be vanned back to trainer Sanford Shulman's barn. While Shulman did not specify the extent of the injury, he did say it was not life-threatening.

### GUIDE TO HEAD BAY MEADOWS DERBY

Trainer Bob Hess, Jr. reported yesterday that Del Mar Derby winner GUIDE will make his next start in the GIII \$100,000 Bay Meadows Derby next Sunday. Hess, who acquired the 3-year-old through bloodstock agent Hubert Guy last July for \$250,000, said the colt would work Tuesday and ship Thursday. Guide has been on the board in 9 of 12 starts and now races for the partnership of Mike Sloan, George Wong, Robert Steibor and Marvin Susemihl. Also pointing for the 9-furlong grass test are RANGER LYKATILL HIL, SAVINIO, GOES ON and FERNANDAZO.

### MICHAEL LEE IMPROVING

According to Jerome Maida, assistant head nurse of Jackson Memorial Hospital's Rehab II, jockey Michael Lee continues to gain strength and to receive daily physical and occupational therapy. Lee, who was injured in a spill at Calder Nov. 12, will be in intensive therapy for another month. "There's movement in his limbs and in his legs," said Lee's father, Oswaldo. Tying the stakes record of 1:47 2/5 for the Native Diver, former claimer SLEW OF DAMASCUS scored a front-running victory under jockey Corey Nakatani to win his 7th stakes of '93; the 5-year-old has also set 2 course and 1 track record this year. "He's got so much natural ability," said the rider. "Today, every time Lottery Winner would come to put the pressure on him, he'd just go a little bit more to re-establish the lead and then he'd relax again. I really like this horse, and who knows how good he could get? He's genuine—turf, dirt, it doesn't matter to him." Trainer Craig Roberts revealed, "He kicked me pretty good in the paddock. That's very uncharacteristic of him, because he's usually calm. He didn't turn a hair and he wasn't wet, just on his toes." FAVORITE CASUAL LIES ran evenly to be 4th, beaten 4 lengths. Slew's jockey, Gary Boulanger, "Pace makes the race and (Slew Of Damascus) got a pretty easy lead. I expected them to go quicker up front and we wanted to be 4 or 5 lengths off of it, but we're disappointed with the effort. When horses like Slew Of Damascus get an easy lead, they're awful tough to catch."

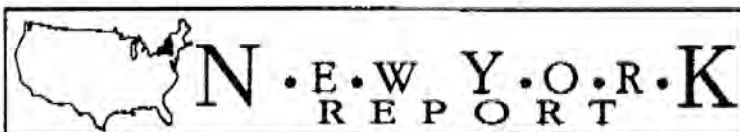

Smith, currently the nation's leading rider, gave more credit to his mount. "He's really developed into a nice horse, especially going long. I was just a good passenger." VIRGINIA RAPIDS, favored at 6-5, rallied from far back late I ended up 4th, 2 1/2 lengths behind the winner.

**THORO-GRAPH ANALYSIS By Jerry Brown**

Sunday's Silver Belles is a tough race to get a handle on, which leads to an important maxim of the professional horseplayer— when in doubt, make sure you get a good price. RE TOSS (Egg Toss) and SENATE APPOINTEE (Storm Cat) will be two of the favorites, the former off her strong third in the BC Distaff, the latter off her eight straight wins. PACIFIC SQUALL (Storm Bird) will also be bet on her overall record. But none of these are strong enough to take at a short price, so we're going to take a shot. CARGO (Caro) has put in big figures in her last two, both sprints, but last year ran well in two longer attempts. In a race lacking in early speed she should clear the field, drop over and save ground on an easy lead, which makes her worth a shot at a price.
