MIKE SMITH TIES RECORD Jockey Mike Smith tied Pat Day's record of 60 stakes wins in 1 calendar year Sat.; when his mount Long Gone Blues (Sovereign Dancer) took the 2nd Division of the Tropical Park Oaks at Calder by 3 1/2 lengths. Two races earlier, Smith had won the 1st division of the Oaks aboard Shahra Bay (Shahrastani). "I tell you, someone up there must be looking out for me, and these horses must know-- both these horses just ran their eyeballs out for me," said Smith. Smith tried for his record-breaking 61st stakes victory Sun. at Calder in the GIII Virginia H. aboard the 3-year-old filly Ophidian (Ogygian), but finished 2nd by a neck to 37-1 shot Lady Sonata (Fighting Fit). Smith has a possible 3 more chances to break the record before the year is over. He is scheduled to ride in the Ambernash Stakes at Laurel Tues. and, if necessary, the Ticonderoga Handicap Dec. 30 and the Bertram F. Bongard S. Dec. 31, both at Aqueduct.

**BAY MEADOWS RAISES PURSES** Racing will resume Wed. at Bay Meadows with purse increases of 10 percent across the board. The success of simulcasting races from Hollywood's recently ended autumn meet is what made the purse hikes possible. Bay Meadows has also changed its 12:15 post time to 1:15, which will make the exchanging of simulcast races with Santa Anita feasible in terms of scheduling.

Diazo, the 2nd favorite at 7-2, rallied inside in the stretch to hand 4-5 favorite Gilded Time his 2nd career defeat. Gilded Time set strong fractions on the lead before drifting out and fading to 6th in the final furlong. The Malibu marks the 3rd time in '93 that jockey Laffit Pincay Jr. and Diazo have teamed up to win a stakes. The pair also took the Relaunch H. and the GI Pegasus H. "By the time we got to the stretch, it was a matter of getting through or not," said Pincay. I saw McCarron's horse going a little bit out. I thought this is my chance. Luckily enough, I got through." Trainer Bill Shoemaker said of Diazo, "I took the blinkers off for this race to try and get him to relax. I'm hoping he'll rate better without blinkers in longer races now." Said jockey Chris McCarron of Gilded Time's disappointing performance, "By the time we got to the top of the lane, I didn't have any horse. He went too hard and too fast down the backside. Ideally, the plan was to let him run out of the gate a little bit and then just lay right behind the 1st flight. I just couldn't get him to cooperate the way I wanted him to." 2nd-place finisher Concept Win, who won the Bolsa Chica S. at Santa Anita in Feb., came to the Malibu off 2 straight allowance tallies. His jockey Gary Stevens said, "I couldn't have been happier with the position we were in, laying just off the speed. But it turned out the winner got an even better trip than we did. That was basically the difference."


