#### MIKE SMITH BREAKS STAKES

RECORD Mike Smith established a new record for most stakes wins in a year yesterday at Aqueduct when he guided Hey Baba Lulu to a 1 3/4 length victory in the Ticonderoga H. It was Smith's 61st stakes victory of the year, which broke the record set by Pat Day in 1991. "I'm a happy man," said Smith. "I'm really glad I got this. I always try and just let things happen, but this is something I really wanted. I have to give a lot of credit to my agent, Steve Adika. He made me go a lot of places I didn't want to go. To me, this is the biggest accomplishment of my career. To me, this is a very prestigious record." Smith's next goal is to win the '93 Eclipse Award as the nation's leading jockey, but he realizes he faces formidable competition. "I know I've done my best to get the Eclipse Award. I've had an Eclipse Award year, but so have three other guys; there's Jerry Bailey, Kent Desormeaux and Eddie Delahoussaye. I just hope I'm the fortunate one."

GILDED TIME RETIRED David S. Milch announced yesterday that a majority interest in his 1992 Eclipse Award winner Gilded Time (Timeless Moment) has been acquired by Kentucky breeders Ben P. Walden Jr. and John R. Gaines, and that last year's champion two-year-old will be retired to Walden's Vinery, near Midway, Kentucky, for the 1994 breeding season. A purchase price was not disclosed, and a stud fee has not yet been published. Trainer Darrell Vienna stated that a post race exam following his disappointing finish in Sunday's Malibu revealed a chip in Gilded Time's right front ankle and the decision was made to retire him.
