SLEW O'GOLD HOSPITALIZED According to a report in today's Daily Racing Form, Slew o'Gold (Seattle Slew), hospitalized Wednesday, has been diagnosed with equine protozoal myelitis and is currently under the care of Lexington's Rood and Riddle Clinic, EPM, a neurological disease which causes paralysis and loss of coordination, can be reversed if diagnosed guickly and treated with an aggressive course of antibiotics. The 16year-old is responding to treatment and Dan Rosenberg, the general manager of Three Chimneys Farm where the stallion stands, told the Form, "We're cautiously optimistic he'll be in business by February 15" when the 1997 breeding season begins. Slew o'Gold is the second major stallion to be stricken with EPM in the last two weeks; Relaunch was also diagnosed with the disease before falling victim to colic and being euthanized Tuesday night.

MIXED RESULTS AT FASIG-TIPTON FALL

MIXED SALE Showing an increase in gross but a drop in average, the Fasig-Tipton Fall Mixed Sale began yesterday at Newton Paddocks in Lexington. A total of 197 horses brought \$748,800, up 44 percent from the first day in 1995 when 106 hips grossed \$520,600, but the 1996 average of \$3,801 was down 23 percent from last year's average of \$4,911. Apprentice (Forty Niner), a six-year-old stallion prospect, brought a bid of \$29,000 to top the opening session. Consigned by Stonehedge Farm, the multiple stakes-placed winner of \$112,675 was purchased by East Stable. The four-day auction continues today at 10:00 a.m. with an offering of weanlings and the Bridlewood Farm reduction.

SUROOR TAKES BRITISH TRAINING

CHAMPIONSHIP Godolphin's trainer Saeed bin Suroor won his first British trainers' championship when the four-year-old filly Russian Snows (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) collected \$7,787 for winning the RJB Mining Conditions S. at Doncaster Friday. The title race officially continues until Dec. 31. But, since Suroor and his nearest rival Henry Cecil have both already stated they will not have any more runners after the turf season ends Monday, the Godolphin team now holds an unassailable advantage. Suroor considers the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. win by Mark Of Esteem (Ire) (Darshaan (GB)) as his high point of 1996. He added, "It has been a fantastic year for all of us and everybody--grooms, jockeys, the whole team--has worked hard during our seven months in England. We will be trying our best to win it again in 1997. But it will not be easy now that both Mark Of Esteem and Halling (Diesis {GB}) (hero of both the G1 Coral Eclipse S. and G1 Juddmonte International S.) have been retired."

SLAVIC TO MARGAUX FARM Grade II winner Slavic (Danzig), who started his stud career in Japan and had stood in that country since 1992, will return to the U.S. to stand the 1997 season at Margaux Farm in Midway, Kentucky. On the board in 11 of his 16 starts, the now nine-year-old captured the GII Breeders' Futurity and ran third as the favorite in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile; he was also second in the GI Florida Derby and the GI Cowdin and retired with earnings of \$468,182. Since going to stud, Slavic has been represented by 59 percent winners, including stakes winners Last Hit and Kippo Ric. He will stand for a fee of \$5,000, live foal.

HAWK ATTACK RETIRED Grade I stakes winner Hawk Attack (Silver Hawk), on the board in 12 of his 15 career starts and first in the GI Secretariat S. and GII Arlington Classic last year, has been retired and will stand the 1997 breeding season at Airdrie Stud in Midway, Kentucky. The four-year-old has not started since finishing 12th in the GI Hollywood Derby last November. He goes to the breeding shed with career earnings of \$499,643, and will stand for a fee of \$4,000, live foal.

MEADOWLANDS CANCELS FRIDAY With the weather forecast calling for heavy rain and high winds and with a tornado warning issued for the area, the Meadowlands Racetrack in New Jersey called off its Friday night card. The track remained open for simul-casting, and live racing is expected to resume this evening. Friday night's featured Just Smashing S. will be rescheduled for next weekend.


