BRAVE NEW WORLD IN 2000 FOR BRAVE ACT

Brave Act (GB) (Persian Bold {Ire}) defeated both Native Desert (Desert Classic) and Bouccaneer (Fr) (Hero's Honor) in the GII Citation H. Nov. 27 at Hollywood, the last race for all, but was still second choice to Bouccaneer. At this time last year, Brave Act was winning every Southern California turf event in sight, taking four straight over a 3 1/2-month period, including a win in this race. But he won just two of his next eight, although running well in all, and the new six-year-old had something to prove. Jockey Alex Solis and Brave Act were content to sit at the back of this six-horse field, as Manndar (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}) set a comfortable pace up front. He was challenged by Bouccaneer into the final turn, put him away, but couldn't hold off the late charge of Native Desert or Brave Act. Those two had both come wide off the turn and closed together, with Brave Act just getting up at the wire in a typically game performance. "He's a very special horse," said Solis. "The last 25 yards, he wanted to win it bad. He just kept putting his head lower and lower to get in front of that other horse."

MAKING THE GRADE

Seeking the Sky (Storm Cat) picked up her first blacktype win in the Ruthless S. over the Aqueduct inner track Jan. 2, 1999 and added her first graded success nearly one year later in the first division of yesterday's GIII Interborough H. at Aqueduct. The bay had finished off the board in the Mar. 27 GIII Cicada S. and again in the May 12 GIII Nassau County S. and was given seven months off. She tuned up for her return to stakes competition with a third-place finish in an Aqueduct allowance Dec. 16 and was the second choice in her second start back. The regally pedigreed New York-bred shadowed pacesetter Flamingo Way (High Gold) through five furlongs in :58, came with her challenge in the final furlong and prevailed over a game runner-up despite drifting out during the drive. "The plan was to go for the early lead, but Flamingo Way jumped out so quickly and there was no opportunity," trainer Mike Hushion said. "What's good about her is that she doesn't have to be on the lead to win. There were some anxious moments the last 70 yards--when you're on the lead the stretch seems to go on forever, but when you're coming from off the pace, the wire seems to come up very quickly." Added jockey Mike Luzzi, "One of the other horses forced her to drift out a little in the stretch, but this filly has guts. She dug in and got the win."

Breaking third from the rail, the bay was clear of the chain-reaction bumping involving the five starters to her right. Unhurried early while saving ground, she came wide for the drive and just got up over Jena Jena. "I wanted to take back and get her to relax," said jockey Mike Luzzi, who captured both ends of the Interborough. "She does her best running when you keep her on the outside. She gave me that final surge when I needed it." Trainer John Kimmel's assistant Loretta Lusteg said, "She loves the inner track, so I'm hoping she'll stay up here for the rest of the winter. She has more confidence on the outside, so that's where I told Mike (Luzzi) to keep her."
