APPLETON OPENS GULFSTREAM SEASON

Hibernian Rhapsody (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}) won his American debut over this green last February by 9 1/2 lengths, but would sooner forget his most recent appearance when a dead-heat fourth in the Nov. 5 Fraise S. The Irish-bred returned to form with a come-frombehind victory in the GIII Tropical Turf H. at Calder Nov. 27 and is reunited this afternoon with jockey Jose Santos. New kid on the block Band Is Passing (Pass the Line) is a neck away from a five-race winning streak and has won his last two starts, including a 5 1/4-length victory in the Pete Axthelm S. at Calder in his last start Nov. 13. The new four-year-old has won each of his last two starts off a layoff and looms a ground-saving threat. Divide and Conquer (Danzig) won only twice from 12 starts in 1999, but was third in the GII Dixie in the spring and in the fall was second in both the GIII Fourstardave H. at today's trip and the one-mile GII Kelso. The bay was a non-threatening seventh in the Fraise. "He ran well in New York and I think if he gets a clean trip, he'll run well again," said trainer Shug McGaughey.

GO LIB GO GOES ALL THE WAY

Trainer Kenny McPeek knows a good bargain when he sees it. In 1993, he threw down \$20,000 for Tejano Run, who proceeded to run second in the 1994 Breeders' Cup Juvenile and 1995 Kentucky Derby, before going on to win graded stakes on turf and dirt. Now, his \$21,000 investment (on behalf of owner Ray Cottrell) in Go Lib Go (Septieme Ciel) looks to be a good one, as the chestnut celebrates the new year with a graded stakes win of his own in the GIII Tropical Park Derby at Calder vesterday. The winner of a grassy allowance at the Kentucky Downs meet in September, Go Lib Go returned to win the Frank Arsenault S. at Hawthorne, but was a disappointing eighth in the Prized S. at Gulfstream Park Nov. 5. Well bet here off a narrow miss in the Mecke S. at Calder Nov. 20, Go Lib Go was rank into the first turn while stalking the pace of Mr. Livingston (El Prado {Ire}) from fourth position while saving all the ground. Still scraping the paint into the lane, jockey Jose Santos angled his mount outside of Mr. Livingston, hooked that rival at the eighth pole and prevailed. "I was a little concerned going into the race," McPeek said. "He had gotten a little bug after his last start, which we treated, but you can't be sure they get over it." The sophomore could show up in the Florida Derby series at Gulfstream, according to the trainer.
