PASSING THE "BUCK"

Buck's Boy (Bucksplasher) was 3-10 for yesterday's GIII Mac Diamida H. at Gulfstream Park, but after dueling Special Coach (Zafarrancho {Arg}) through suicidal fractions of :45.87, 1:10.08 and 1:35.14, the 1998 Champion Turf Horse ran out of gas and was passed by the rest of the field. That left the race to Unite's Big Red (Unite), who closed from fourth to take a clear lead at the top of the lane and held on to best Thesaurus (With Approval) by a length. Buck's Bpy, winner of the '98 GI Breeders' Cup Turf, started only three times last season, finishing second in the Sept. 25 GIII Sky Classic H. at Woodbine and third in his attempt to repeat in the Turf. Making his first start since, the seven-year-old went right to the lead and opened up by 12 lengths on all but Special Coach after six furlongs, but tired badly and beat only that badger home. "Every time I tried to make a move, (Special Coach) went with me," said his jockey, Garrett Gomez. "Every time I tried to take back, he laid on me. I didn't expect that. He was on me the whole trip." The winner, first in the GII Pan American H. over this course last March, had been off the board in his last five, but came to life at 11-1. "He has always had bad feet, but run good," trainer Randy Mills said. "This year his feet were good, but he's been running bad. I almost didn't go in this race...but I've never been one to stay out of a race because of one horse." The winner goes next in the GIII Canadian Turf H. Jan. 22.

SURF'S UP IN SANTA YSABEL

Coming off a seven-length laugher in the Dec. 19 GI Hollywood Starlet, Surside (Seattle Slew) was sent off at 1-5 in yesterday's GIII Santa Ysabel S. at Santa Anita and demoralized her three rivals in another romp. The bay, who captured the GI Frizette by a head before running third in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, was giving eight to 10 pounds to her overmatched foes, but she carried her 123 pounds into the lead after a half in:47.01 and looked like she was equipped with jet engines instead of lead weights in the stretch, striding away to an eight-length score. "I probably did more with her last Monday when I worked her," trainer D. Wayne Lukas quipped, adding, "Everything is falling into place now because we can run back in the (GI) Las Virgenes (Feb. 12), then it's 30 days to the (GI Santa Anita) Oaks and then we can to either the Santa Anita Derby or the Ashland." Is the Kentucky Derby under consideration? "Because of her style and pedigree, Surfside looks more like a 1 1/4-mile horse...than Winning Colors," Lukas said, comparing the filly to his '88 Derby winner. "We haven't considered the Kentucky Derby this early in the year with any other filly."

A "MILLIONS" STRONG Magic Millions Managing Director Don Hancock's bold prediction that Australia's first yearling sale for 2000 would average A\$80,000 proved on the mark after the third and final premier session concluded Sunday with an overall average of A\$80,026 for 477 sold. The overall aggregate was A\$38,172,500. Trainer Gai Waterhouse, buoyed by the win of Assertive Lad (Aus) in Saturday's Magic Millions S., continued her buy-up to set a new sales record of 32 purchased for A\$2,895,000. She gave A\$300,000 in Friday's opening session for a Danehill colt from Joie De Vivre (Aus), herself a A\$1 million filly of 1989 who raced only once but produced South African Group 1 winner Joie De Grise (Aus). Joie De Vivre is out of multiple Group 1 winner Denise's Joy (Aus). Waterhouse went to A\$300,000 again yesterday for a Danehill--Very Droll (Aus) (Crown Jester {Aus}) filly, from a three-quarter sister in blood to Rory's Jester (Aus) and the dam of stakes-winner Dry Humour (NZ). She was offered by Collingrove Stud. First-time buyers from Ireland, England, Hong Kong and other parts of Asia were active as well. Yearlings by Danehill sire sons Flying Spur (Aus) and Danzero (Aus) were in demand. "Danehill is on the threshold of creating a sire line like Star Kingdom (Ire) and *Sir Tristram. His sons are really firing and, strangely, they throw offspring that look just like Danehill himself," said Hancock. As always, Danehill topped all sires, with his 18 sold averaging A\$252,778. The top three yearlings Sunday were both by Danehill. Lot 456, a colt from Shalbourne (Nureyev), brought A\$325,000. Offered by Glenlogan Park, he was purchased by Victorian trainer Tony Noonan. Shalbourne is a half-sister to Stormy Exchange, the dam of the Australian Oaks-winning filly Danendri (Aus). Coolmore Stud offered Lot 548, a colt from Vigne Vierge (Diesis {GB}) whose second dam is prolific producer Valhalla (Fr)

KEENELAND JANUARY SALE BEGINS The first major U.S. Thoroughbred auction of Y2K, the Keeneland January Sale, begins Monday in Lexington and it may signal a new era. But many think this "dawn of a new day" may shine just as brightly as the record-breaking seasons of the late 1990s. "I can't see any reason why we don't keep right on rolling in 2000, just like we have been," said Keeneland Director of Sales W.B. Rogers Beasley. "I think our catalogue...may be one of the strongest that we have ever had. We have a champion that will be going through the ring in Countess Diana and we've got a dispersal by Heronwood Farm and the continued reduction by Brookside Farm. I think we'll start off...with a bang and get the New Year rolling." The sale runs through Friday, Jan. 14, with bidding beginning at 10 a.m. daily. Already a record-breaker, the sale has 1,868 lots listed, including 1,866 horses and two stallion shares. All told, there are 877 broodmares, 208 broodmare prospects, 119 racing or broodmare prospects, 575 yearlings, 39 racing prospects, five stallions, 10 stallion prospects, two stallion shares and 28 horses of various other ages catalogued. It will top last year's edition by 157 head and exceeds the previous high of 1,829, set in 1991. "I think the sale will gross more and exceed what happened in 1999," said David Switzer, the executive director of the Kentucky Thoroughbred Association and the Kentucky Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association. "The economy looks like it will stay very strong and will continue to grow and we really think that will carry over into our industry. I certainly think that we will have a great chance to set another record."

Keeneland January a Record-Setter?

In '99, Keeneland January saw a top price of \$3.25 million paid by Reynolds Bell, Jr., as agent, for Escena. That set a January record for a broodmare or broodmare prospect, a record Beasley hopes to beat. There are reasons for optimism. The sale is full of quality stock. One of the top attractions is Countess Diana, who was the champion two-year-old filly in 1997 when she won the GII Walmac Int'l Alcibiades S. and the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. She will be offered Tuesday as part of the Eaton Sales consignment. There are three mares in foal to the late, great Mr. Prospector as well as mares carrying foals by some of the world's most popular stallions, including A.P. Indy, Deputy Minister, Kingmambo, Nureyev, Seattle Slew, Storm Cat and Unbridled, and yearlings by such as A.P. Indy, Danzig, Deputy Minister and Gone West."I think we have a chance to set a record," Beasley said. "There are all the ingredients. Now, we'll just have to wait and see."

The all-conquering David Payne stable continues to be the major force this Cape summer season. Sending out his New Zealand-bred Mythical Play as the second favorite at 4-1, he saw this talented daughter of Defensive Play return home by a comfortable 2 1/2 lengths, with the even-money favorite Lady Brompton (SAf) (Al Mufti) just over three lengths behind in fourth. Having finished third in her previous start, the G1 Cape Fillies Guineas, Mythical Play has now won four of her seven starts and is next scheduled to take on the colts in the G1 Cape Derby.

High-profile jockey Shane Dye has 86 Group 1 winners to date, but the A\$1 million Magic Millions had eluded him until Assertive Lad scored this authorative win and also gave trainer Gai Waterhouse, traditionally among the top five buyers at Magic Millions, her inaugural win in the race. Jumping from the inside barrier, the colt quickly took control of the race and, after becoming unbalanced on the turn and briefly losing the lead to Belle Du Jour (co-owned by former Prime Minister Bob Hawke and Magic Millions part-owner John Singleton), he fought back. A A\$110,000 yearling, he is by Zeditave, who numbered the G1 Blue Diamond S., Melbourne's premier two-year-old prize, among five Group 1 wins before going on to be champion threeyear-old. Assertive Lad will try to become the first Magic Millions winner to capture the A\$2.5 million Golden Slipper, to be run Apr. 15 at Rosehill, since that race was first run in 1987. "This horse has natural pace and improvement, which you need to win a Golden Slipper," said Dye, who has four Slipper trophies in his cabinet. Waterhouse revealed that the undefeated colt had his training compromised by corns in his feet. "A week ago he wasn't running," she said, but added, "He's the most precocious and exciting horse I have trained. He looked like he was headed and came again and that is the sign off a good horse. I was pretty active at the sales yesterday and I will terrorize them now."

REAL QUIET TO RACE IN 2000 After lengthy negotiations, it has been decided that 1998 Kentucky Derby winner Real Quiet (Quiet American) will return to the racetrack for a five-year-old campaign instead of heading off to stud duty, the Daily Racing Form reports. Discussions took place between Mike Pegram, owner of Real Quiet, and George Hofmeister, who has acquired the breeding rights to the horse after the end of this year. The talks reportedly surrounded the possibility of Hofmeister striking a deal with Pegram to stand Real Quiet one year earlier than originally planned. "He will not go to stud this spring," trainer Bob Baffert told the Form. "He's over at Hollywood Park jogging a mile every day." The bay has not raced since his victory in last year's GI Hollywood Gold Cup. He was injured while training for the GI Pacific Classic last August.
