SOARING SOFTLY TO BREEDING SHED?

A shoo-in to be named the champion turf mare of 1999, Soaring Softly (Kris S.--Wings Of Grace, by Key to the Mint) may rest on her laurels and head to the breeding shed, The Blood-Horse reports. Darby Dan Farm's John Phillips, co-owner and breeder of the fiveyear-old, told the publication that the likelihood of her retirement was, "as close to 100 percent as we can be without being certain," and added, "If she is retired, we've had a standing agreement with Overbrook Farm that a season to Storm Cat would be reserved for her." Soaring Softly capped a nearly perfect '99 campaign with a three-quarter length victory in the inaugural running of the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf at Gulfstream Park Nov. 6. After breaking her maiden and winning an allowance race on the dirt early in her career, the Kentucky bred was switched to the turf at the beginning of her four-year-old season and promptly won seven of her eight starts, including the GII Sheepshead Bay H., GII New York H. and GI Flower Bowl Invitational H. Overall, she had nine wins, a second and three thirds from 16 starts for earnings of \$1,270,433. Trained by Jimmy Toner, she has been stabled at Payson Park in Florida since her Breeders' Cup score and will remain there until a final decision on her future is made.

CHIEF SEATTLE TO GODOLPHIN

It has been confirmed that the Godolphin team has purchased the 1999 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile runnerup Chief Seattle (Seattle Slew) from William Betz and Philip Needham for an undisclosed sum. The colt started four times last year for trainer John Kimmel, breaking his maiden by 9 3/4 lengths in his debut at Saratoga before running fourth in the GI Futurity and second in the GI Champagne S. He was beaten 2 1/2 lengths by Anees in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile, increasing his bankroll to \$327,000. Now three, he has gone into quarantine at Payson Park and, while he is nominated to the Triple Crown, will be shipped to Dubai in February to ioin the rest of the Godolphin stable. Racing Manager Simon Crisford said yesterday, "We will see how he settles in when he reaches Dubai before deciding on a programme for this year."

SAINT STEALS SHOW FROM THIEF

You couldn't blame the Santa Anita crowd for overlooking Saint's Honor (St. Jovite) in yesterday's GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup S. Facing the likes of Grade I winners Cat Thief (Storm Cat) and General Challenge (General Meeting), the colt was making only his second attempt against graded-stakes foes, and his first foray had produced a 26-length drubbing by the infamous Valhol in the GII Arkansas Derby. But the 24-1 shot ignored the tote board, chasing Straight Man (Saint Ballado) through six furlongs in 1:10 1/5 before charging to the front and holding off 15-10 favorite Cat Thief for a shocking 1 1/2-length win. "After the Arkansas Derby, this colt had a problem in his left knee," explained winning trainer Craig Dollase. "He had surgery...and he has come back great, obviously." Away for seven months after his Oaklawn disappointment, the dark bay came back to be second in a Nov. 7 Santa Anita turf allowance and followed with a four-length score over Hollywood allowance company Dec. 11. "He's getting good right now and he's getting better with age," Dollase said. "The time off has done him a world of good." Cat Thief, in traffic at the three-eighths pole, got through in the final furlong and fought off 36-1 Mr. Broad Blade to get second. General Challenge was also banged around on the far turn, came wide into the lane and ran out of ground, finishing fourth.

"The longer he goes, the better he's going to get, so they're in trouble. He came out of the gate real quick... any one that would come to him today, he'd just take off again." Favored Greenwood Lake, winner of the GI Champagne S. and Gll Remsen S. last year, never threatened on his way to sixth-place finish. "He just didn't grab the track," said jockey Jean-Luc Samyn. "He warmed up well, but just couldn't get a hold of the track." His trainer, Nick Zito, said, "I guess he's just a little rusty."
