LADY WINS, HONESTLY

Maybe it was the removal of the blinkers, or perhaps it was the lunar eclipse on Friday night. In any case, Honest Lady (Seattle Slew) finally gave the performance that trainer Bobby Frankel knew she was capable of in nailing her first Grade I victory. The homebred captured the GII Santa Ynez by 4 1/2 lengths in just her second start and set out on the Triple Crown trail. The Derby dream was dimmed a bit when she was fifth, beaten only a length, in the GII San Rafael S. against colts, faded away when a non-threatening seventh in the GI Santa Anita Derby and she went to the sidelines with a cracked knee. Third in her return in a Belmont allowance Sept. 17, the dark bay rebounded with a victory in her turf bow at Santa Anita Nov. 4. Entered in the Monrovia, she stayed in despite the race's coming off the turf and finished third after getting rank with pilot Corey Nakatani. Sans blinkers for the first time, Honest Lady settled at the back of the pack, content to let Enjoy the Moment (Slew's Royalty) wing it on the front end in :22 and 44 1/5, with favored Hookedonthefeelin (Citidancer) and Kalookan Queen (Lost Code) in hot pursuit. Honest Lady still had 3 1/2 lengths to make up at the eighth pole, but went roaring by Kalookan Queen to score the victory. "Bobby told me he wanted to take the blinkers off to see if now she could settle and make that one run, and I told him I thought it would work," said Nakatani. "The trip was very nice today."

GOING PUBLIC

Public Purse (Private Account), a stakes winner as a sophomore, made the most of his three efforts at age four winning a pair of group stakes before finishing third as the choice in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden. The bay won only once in four European starts in 1999, but his fortunes changed when shipped to the U.S. where he was a 1 1/2-length winner of the GII C F Burke H. Oct. 31 in his stateside debut and most recently finished a one-paced second, beaten 1 1/4 lengths in the GI Hollywood Turf Cup Dec. 4. Public Purse broke well under Alex Solis and set a measured pace which saw six furlongs go in a moderate 1:12 1/5. The real running began as Public Purse began to get away from the field at the three-eighths marker. Dark Moondancer (Anshan) {GB}) uncorked a five-wide rally which carried him into second place at the furlong grounds, with some 3 1/2 lengths to come. He continued to close furiously, but the wire arrived just in time for Public Purse as he won by the narrow margin. Said winning trainer Bobby Frankel, "He's getting sharper and I knew the distance wasn't a stretch for him." The victor goes next in the GII San Luis Obispo (12 furlongs, Feb. 21) or the GII San Luis Rey (12 furlongs, Mar. 18) and then the marathon, 14-furlong GI San Juan Capistrano Apr. 22, according to Frankel.

Shamrock City, looking for his first victory since July, went straight to the front and dared the field to catch him. They didn't, and the Buckram Oak colorbearer came away with his first graded-stakes score. Second to Sharp Appeal in the Miami Breeders' Cup H. over the Calder lawn Oct. 2, the dark bay tried to steal the Fraise H. at Gulfstream Nov. 5, but ended up second once again. Caught near the line when third in the GIII Tropical Turf H. at Calder Nov. 27, he was shuffled back on the turn when third in the GII Appleton H. over this course Jan. 3. Breaking smoothly, Shamrock City skimmed the hedge as he set the pace, taking the field through moderate fractions. Challenged by Rhythmean at the guarter pole, he rebuffed that bid and kicked for home when set down for the drive. The final time of 1:47 equaled the stakes-record time shared by The Vid (1995 & 1996) and Devil's Cup (1997). "When the horses came to me around the turn, he picked them up and just took off," said winning jockey Edgar Prado. Though the headstrong Shamrock City has come from off the pace, his best races have been on the front end. "It goes against him to rate him," noted winning trainer Mohammed Moubarak. "(His next start will be) the next one here that suits him. The Fort Lauderdale H. (GIII, Mar. 11, \$100,000, 8.5fT), I think that's it." Favored Charge d'Affaires (GB) (Kendor {Fr}) made a move at the head of the lane, but flattened out to be fifth.

"I think he is a cold weather kind of guy," said trainer Pat Kelly of Sky Approval as he welcomed the six-yearold to the winner's circle after the Aqueduct H. The chestnut spent the better part of last winter in Florida where he was once third from three tries, but thrived in four races back in the Big Apple with a pair of victories and two runner-up finishes before getting a rest. Subpar efforts in August and October preceded a third-place result in a one-turn mile allowance Nov. 27, but Sky rebounded to take a one mile and 70 yard event Dec. 27 by two lengths. Longshot Parental Pressure established the early pace as Talk's Cheap (Corporate Report), odds-on Badge (Air Forbes Won), rank into the first turn, and Black Cash (Deposit Ticket) chased. Parental Pressure still led into the lane as Badge and Talk's Cheap dropped out and the former looked the winner, but Sky Approval, last a half mile out, was gobbling up ground and caught the front runner late. Phone The King steadied between horses late and settled for the show spot. "He had a good spring. We gave him a little time off during the summer because he doesn't train as well," Kelly added. Of fifth-place finisher Badge, trainer Joe Aquilino commented, "It looked like he was in a good spot. He may have been a little closer than I would have liked, though." The winner is likely to stay in the New York cold for the GIII Stymie H. Mar. 4.

Cash Run broke her maiden by 15 1/2 lengths at Belmont and was a winner in Turfway sprint allowance company two starts later before stretching out to finish third in the GII Alcibiades at Keeneland. Ignored at 32-1 in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, the dark bay took advantage of a speed-favoring Gulfstream main track and outlasted two-year-old filly champion Chilukki to win by 1 1/4 lengths. Favored at 4-5 in her last, the GIII Golden Rod at Churchill, she was bumped at the start and was caught late finishing second by 1 3/4 lengths. Jerry Bailey is in from Florida for the mount. Classic Olympio graduated by seven lengths before stringing together consecutive stakes victories in the Anoakia S. Oct. 20 and the Nov. 14 Moccasin S. at today's trip. Tried around two turns in her most recent effort, she tired to fifth in the GI Hollywood Starlet S. Mean Imogene could hardly have been more impressive in her racetrack debut, when scoring by four lengths Jan. 1, getting her 6 1/2 furlongs in 1:16 2/5.

HORSE CHESTNUT INJURED Horse Chestnut (SAf) (Fort Wood), winner of eight straight races, including the GIII Broward H. at Gulfstream Park Jan. 8, was injured during a workout at Calder yesterday morning and has been ruled out of the GI Donn H. Feb. 5. With jockey Mike Smith in the irons, the five-year-old completed a five-furlong drill in 1:00 2/5, but was noticeably off upon his return to the barn. "He has a fracture of the splint bone and suspensory damage," said trainer Michael deKock, "He will recover," No information was released on the South African Triple Crown winner's racing future.

BIANCONE TO TRAIN IN U.S. The Florida Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering has given French trainer Patrick Biancone a trainer's licenses. In mid-December Biancone took on the job of racing manager for Frank Stronach's stable. Stronach also owns Gulfstream Park. Biancone is currently serving a nine-month suspension for drug infractions in Hong Kong. Paul Boroff, chief inspector for the state said, "He applied for a licenses last week and we gave him a temporary one. It's good for 90 days. If we don't hear from the state that he been denied a license we'll know it's been granted." State offices in Tallahassee were closed for the weekend.

FIVE STAR DAY OUT UNTIL MIDSUMMER

The GIII V.O. Underwood winner and GI King's Bishop S. runner up **Five Star Day** (Carson City) returned from a routine gallop Wednesday morning with a slight fracture in his left hind leg and will be sidelined until August, the *Daily Racing Form* reports. Trainer Beau Greely told the Form, "When he came back from galloping, he cooled out a little lame. He had surgery Thursday. Two screws were inserted. It's safer to do that than not."

Ecton Park Has Large Shoes to Fill:

It wasn't that long ago that four-year-old Ecton Park (Forty Niner) was third on the Elliott Walden depth chart, but in the course of just six months, in light of the departures of Victory Gallop and now Menifee, he has become the first stringer. The winner at three of the GI Super Derby and GII Jim Dandy, the chestnut was last seen when a disappointing 12th finish in the Breeders' Cup Classic, but will look to rebound from the effort very soon, according to Walden. "We're looking at the Gulfstream Park H. (GI, Feb. 26) for him now," he said. "That would serve as an excellent prep for Dubai." This year's World Cup is scheduled for Sat., Mar. 25 in the desert. The Mark Stanley-owned charge worked four furlongs at his Payson Park base last Monday in :53 4/5.
