DIRT NO DILEMMA FOR DEPUTY

The Deputy (Ire) (Petardia {GB}) won his American debut, taking the Jan. 2 Hill Rise H. by one length over the much-praised Promontory Gold. He was taking on a couple of highly accomplished main-track performers while making his dirt debut in Sunday's Gil Santa Catalina at Santa Anita and he proved up to the challenge. The Irish-bred colt dueled with High Yield (Storm Cat) before confidently putting away that rival in deep stretch for a one-length tally. "Nobody wanted to go (to the lead) and my horse broke like a rocket," explained winning rider Chris McCarron. "I inherited the lead by default. He rated himself okay, though he was a bit aggressive early. Then he settled in well about halfway through the race. From that point on, I just sat hard until I thought it was time to go and when I asked him to run, he went forward." Favored Captain Steve (Fly So Free) stalked the leaders and appeared ready to challenge in the stretch, but tired and finished third. "He just didn't kick in," explained trainer Bob Baffert. "Those things happen. I just didn't do enough with him." Plans for the top three are still undecided, but trainer D. Wayne Lukas said the Feb. 19 GI Fountain of Youth at Gulfstream was a likely next stop for runner-up High Yield.

NO QUESTION ABOUT THIS FORWARD GAL

Longshots continued to be the story of the Gulfstream meet as 91-1 outsider **Miss Inquistive** (Kipper Kelly) spoiled the perfect record of favored **Swept Away** (Mystery Storm) to win yesterday's GIII Forward Gal S. Miss Inquistive debuted with a 6 1/4-length win at Woodbine last August before running third in the Blue Hen H. at Delaware in September. After an 8 1/4-length Woodbine allowance win on Oct. 29, she finished fifth in the Dec. 29 Kattagat's Pride S. at Laurel last time out. Disregarded in her graded stakes debut, the filly dueled with Swept Away, edged clear from that rival at midstretch and was all out to hold off the heavy favorite and reward her backers with a 91-1 payday. "The only two times that she has gone to the front she has led all the way and I was hoping she would do the same thing today," explained winning trainer Frank Passero, Jr. "That was a fine field of fillies she beat today." Steve Flint, trainer of Swept Away, said, "I thought she ran her eyeballs out. I lost a week of training and had to pony her but still she ran a very good race."

Unbridled Jet (Unbridled), an impressive 12-length winner in Gulfstream allowance company Jan. 9, has been declared from Saturday's race. "He has a lesion of his right fore suspensory and will be out for some time," said trainer Bill Mott. When pressed, Mott said he thought the colt might be out at least six months.

Best of Luck (Broad Brush) worked seven furlongs yesterday in 1:28 1/5, one day after working three furlongs in :36 Saturday morning. "I got some speed in him on Saturday and stamina this morning," said Hall-of-Fame trainer Allen Jerkens. The stretch runner, winner last year of the GII Peter Pan and GIII Stuyvesant, will carry 114 pounds in the Donn.

STORM CANCELS RACING Live racing was canceled at Turfway Park in Kentucky and Laurel Park in Maryland yesterday as a winter storm moved through the midwest and up the east coast.

Summer Note Likely to Drink from Fountain:

Summer Note (Notebook), dead-heat winner of Saturday's GII Hutcheson S. at Gulfstream Park, is likely to stretch out to two turns for the first time in the GI Fountain of Youth S. Feb. 19, according to trainer Randy Morse. "He came out of his race in fine shape," Morse commented. "It's still a ways to go before the Fountain of Youth, but we're certainly going to be looking at it." The colt was the winner of a pair of allowance sprints in Chicago at the tail end of 1999, and Morse is optimistic about his ability to get the longer distance of the Fountain of Youth. "He hasn't gone two turns yet, but Shane (jockey Sellers) said after the race he thought he was rateable and would get two turns."

He showed plenty of ability on his debut when second to the impressive Vision's Flight (Ire) (Bluebird {USA}) over six furlongs at Maisons-Laffitte Oct. 12. He showed the benefit of the experienced gained with that run by seizing the initiative from the outset and making every yard of the 5½-furlong trip to win a conditions event at the same track Nov. 2 in heavy conditions. Onlyman is a half-brother to the outstanding Occupandiste (Ire) (Kaldoun {Fr}), who was most impressive when she won the seven-furlong G1 Prix de la Foret and has continued the family tradition by showing a liking for soft underfoot conditions. If his stamina fails to hold out, he is a highly promising sprinting type.

She also had to give the winner, who was ridden by the leading apprentice Christophe Soumillon, three pounds, and she finished very fast to go down by a head. Sarasota will certainly appreciate trips of a mile and beyond and should give her young and able trainer plenty to look forward to for the coming season.

He showed a touch of class when defeating the useful Onlyman (USA) over six furlongs on his debut at Maisons-Laffitte in mid-October. His only subsequent start came in the G2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte in November, but he encountered trouble in running and could only manage fifth. He may have the stamina to stay a mile, but at distances beyond that his stamina is open to question.

His Highness has owned the winner of the last three renewals of the French Oaks and Zarkiya is typical of the lightly raced sorts who show tremendous improvement from two to three. She is certainly a dark horse to keep one eye on.

BEVA WINS RULING FROM EC

The British Equine Veterinary Association, with the help of fellow associations in Ireland and Europe, has persuaded the European Commission that horses not due to enter the human food chain can be treated with drugs for which no maximum residue levels (MRL) have been produced. This will safeguard vets' ability to treat their equine patients safely, effectively and legally according to BEVA. There had been the threat that all drugs used for horses should have MRL, which would have cut down sharply on the range of treatments available to vets since testing for MRL is very expensive and would not have been worthwhile for many current drugs.
