HORSES FOR COURSES, JOCKEYS FOR HORSES

Stephen Got Even (A.P. Indy) broke his maiden and won an allowance event at Gulfstream this time last year before scoring in the GII Galleryfurniture.com S., beneath jockey Shane Sellers, at Turfway Park in March. Fourteenth as the 5-1 second favorite in the Kentucky Derby, the bay was fourth in the Preakness and fifth in the Belmont before getting a brief rest. A 4 1/4-length winner of a Saratoga allowance Sept. 1, 'Stephen' was beaten 1 1/2 lengths in the GI Woodward and ran fourth in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup in his last start Oct. 10. Drawn on the rail for the comebacker, the Nick Zito trainee broke alertly and took up a perfect stalking position just off the flank of **Call Me Mr. Vain** (Fiery Best) for the opening six furlongs run in a solid 1:10 4/5. Turning for home, Stephen Got Even inherited the lead and was joined immediately from the outside by Breeders' Cup Classic third **Golden Missile** (A.P. Indy), and those two locked horns through the final three-sixteenths of a mile with the former gutting out the victory. **Behrens** (Pleasant Colony), making his first start since a seventh-place finish in the Classic, put in a mild bid at the top of the stretch, but could do no better than the show spot. Sellers ran his record aboard the A.P. Indy colt to a perfect two for two. "I was in a great spot all the way," he commented. "I didn't want to go that fast, but he was really pulling me along. The horse in front was backing up the pace and it turned out I was in a good spot." As late as the middle of last week, trainer Nick Zito was still trying to decide whether to run his pupil in the Donn. "Yes, it was a late decision to even run this horse in this race, but you've got to play this game every day," Zito said. The trainer was noncommittal about a next start for the winner. "This horse is coming off a long layoff and as hard as he had to run today, against all these Grade I horses, I don't know." The victory earned Stephen Got Even 20 points in the NTRA on FOX Champions Series, which continues with the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 4.

GENERALLY UNCHALLENGED IN THE STRUB

General Challenge (General Meeting) strode home impressively by 9 1/2 lengths in the Strub, making Golden Eagle Farm the first owner to take back-to-back runnings of the event, following Event of the Year's success the previous season. The chestnut, second by a neck to Budroyale in the GII Goodwood in October, was a lackluster 10th in the Breeders' Cup, but returned to take the GIII Native Diver H. at Hollywood Park against his elders Dec. 12. Sent off as the second choice in the GII San Fernando against his peers Jan. 15, he had a rough time of it on the far turn and wound up fourth. Cabooing the field early, General Challenge made a bold move nearing the stretch, quickly took over and drew off under a hand ride. "He ran right through the dirt and did everything right," said Nakatani. "It was pretty awesome. He's really strong. What a special horse he is." The Big Cap may be next on trainer Bob Baffert's agenda for General Challenge, who is not known as the best of travelers. "The odds of him going to Dubai are slim to none," reasoned Baffert. "I wish it were a five-hour trip; I don't think this colt could handle it otherwise." **Luftikus** (Meadowlake) could not match strides with the winner, but bested the others by three lengths in his stakes debut. San Vicente S. cont.

A veteran of the Northern California circuit, Archer City Slew broke his maiden at second asking at the Pleasanton meeting and was third off a four-month layoff in the San Mateo S. at Bay Meadows Oct. 3. A 1/2-length success in a Golden Gate allowance Dec. 1, after which he was purchased privately by his current connections, propelled the sophomore into Santa Anita's GIII San Miguel last out but never reached contention and after being crowded a bit at the start and finished fifth, 6 1/4 lengths behind Swept Overboard. The second longest shot in this field, Archer City Slew saved ground while stalking the pace early and moved into contention on the turn. Jockey Kent Desormeaux swung his mount three deep into the stretch and wore down Joopy Doopy, who led at the eighth pole, for the narrow success. Malabar Gold, sixth in the GI Hollywood Futurity last out, finished a lackluster fourth. Desormeaux gave all the credit to trainer Vladimir Cerin. "He instructed me that if I could find some way to keep him more contentious today, he thought this colt would possess the same punch. That he did," Desormeaux said. Cerin was optimistic about the future. "I think the added distance helped him today. We'll let him cool out and see where we go from here."

Guinevere won the Washington Breeders' Cup Oaks at Emerald Downs at three and won the King County H. over the Emerald main track last June 26. Coming into her last start, the dark bay mare had made only one other start over the infield resulting in an eighth-place finish in Golden Gate's Eyes Six H. last May, but she made amends, winning the grassy Star Ball H. at Golden Gate by 3 1/2 lengths over a yielding turf course. Getting similar conditions underfoot for her seasonal debut, Guinevere was put immediately on the lead by jockey Javier Matias, turned back a bid from Royal Terminal entering the stretch and lasted for her first graded-stakes victory. Said winning trainer Larry Ross, "I was cautiously optimistic going into the race because she had run very well on the grass last time. She's been lightly raced by plan and we hoped she would develop like this."

BHB NOT KEEN ON TRIPLE CROWN One day after France-Galop director-general Louis Romanet suggested radical changes to the current racing calendar, the *Racing Post* reported that British Horseracing Board racing director Paul Greeves said that these changes, including the 'Triple Crown' of Derbys, could damage, rather than enhance, the chief British classic. Romanet's proposal included grouping the French, English and Irish Derbys together as well as restricting the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot to older horses. "Having a Triple Crown of Derbys could mean that the first two events would become mere trials for the last race of the series, which would be the Irish Derby," Greeves told the *Racing Post*. "One has to ask if that's really what we want for the Epsom Derby. One thing that Romanet's suggestions illustrate far better than anything I could say is the complexity of the European Pattern and the difficulties of anything other than radical change. All I can say is that British racing is the strongest in the world and our task is to protect it."

RACING INTO THE FUTURE

More details emerged yesterday about the deal that Britain's Super 12 courses have done with television interests which is worth around £225 million over the next ten years. A digital interactive television channel and Internet site are to be started, both with live pictures. This means that the existing Racing Channel looks doomed, as the Super 12 want to include Britain's other 47 racecourses in the venture. Ascot chief executive Douglas Erskine-Crum revealed that the Tote is the preferred betting partner. The Super 12 courses are Aintree, Ascot, Cheltenham, Doncaster, Epsom, Goodwood, Haydock, Kempton, Newbury, Newmarket, Sandown and York.
