THE SONG REMAINS THE SAME Royal Anthem (Theatrical {Ire}), winner of the GI Canadian International at three and the G1 Juddmonte International S. at four, opened his five-year-old campaign in the \$194,000 Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. vesterday afternoon and added yet another Grade I score. The 2-5 favorite in his first appearance since running second in the Nov. 6 GI Breeders' Cup Turf, the good-looking bay was under wraps as he sat fourth behind pacesetting 63-1 shot Atiba (Relaunch), carried jockey Jerry Bailey to the lead as they raced around the far turn and drew away at will to win as much the best. "He pretty much did it on his own," Bailey said. "He rated nicely and he went to the lead without me really asking him. The only time I did ask anything from him was when we headed for home, and he just took off. I had a lot of horse under me at the finish." Added trainer Bill Mott, "I would have been disappointed with anything less from this horse." Looking ahead, Mott said, "In this country we'll look toward the Arlington Million and the Breeders' Cup Turf, but we're going to consider a race in Dubai (\$2 million Dubai Turf Classic, Mar. 25). Then we'd bring him back here, and the Arlington race isn't until August."

SURFSIDE SURVIVES SANTA ANITA SKIRMISH

Surfside (Seattle Slew) was the 2-5 choice facing just three foes, but unlike her runaway victories in the Dec. 19 GI Hollywood Starlet and Jan. 9 GIII Santa Ysabel S., the bay had to work for her win in vesterday's GI Las Virgenes S. After breaking from the rail, the big bay filly pressed Rings a Chime (Metfield) through a quarter in :23, moved to the front after a half in :46 4/5, but could not pull away as she had in her last two starts, fighting off the rail challenge of the determined Spain (Thunder Gulch) to win by three-quarters of a length. with Rings a Chime just another half length back in third to her outside. "When we got to the turn, she started fighting the racetrack and just wasn't comfortable," jockey Pat Day said. "Then they came at her from both sides and when she was in close proximity, she was very game. I think she was just hesitant to really put her all into it because of the footing." Trainer D. Wayne Lukas said, "It helps that she got looked in the eye today. You know, she's gotten a little complacent. I was not concerned that anyone would get by her in the stretch. Now we've got another month until the next one (GI Santa Anita Oaks, Mar. 12) and then we'll get another month (before the Apr. 8 GI Santa Anita Derby). I would imagine we'll have to reach down a bit more in these next two, and we'll wake her up for them." The runner-up will also be back for the Santa Anita Oaks.

Deputy Minister Frankel 8 Keeper Hill Manistique, the highweight at 125, looks to maintain her perfect record over the Santa Anita main track. The five-year-old, four-for-four at the Arcadia oval and fivefor-seven at this distance, tired to be eighth in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, but rebounded with a threelength victory over Snowberg in the Dec. 11 GII Bayakoa H. last time out. Potrizaris, who beat the boys to win the G1 Argentine Derby on the main track in November of 1998, and Bordelaise, a Group 1 winner on the dirt in Argentina last year, both make their second starts since arriving from South America. Potrizaris returned from a 10-month layoff to be fourth in the Jan. 17 GII San Gorgonio H. on the turf, while Bordelaise, coming off a six-month vacation, captured the maintrack Run for the Roses H. Jan. 1. The two have met before; Potrizaris came out four lengths to the good in an Argentine allowance test in August of '98 and Bordelaise, trainer Ron McAnally's latest South American starlet, turned the tables with a six-length score over Group 2 company in their next start, with her rival no better than fourth.

Cosine Headed to Turf:

Cosine (Cozzene), a distant third in the Dec. 18 GI Hollywood Futurity and seventh in the Jan. 15 GIII Holy Bull S. last time out, will take to the turf for his next try, tomorrow's GIII Palm Beach S. at Gulfstream Park. "I was really disappointed in his effort in the Holy Bull," trainer Jimmy Baker said. "I put blinkers on him for the first time and thought he would be focused in the race. But he gave it up in the run down the backstretch, so I'm going to try him on the grass and see if that will do the trick." Baker added, "I'm keeping the blinkers on him. He's been working well in them since the Holy Bull. If he runs good, then maybe we can make it the old turf-to-dirt and run him back in the Florida Derby."

Forty One Carats to Sprint Championship:

Last year's GII Pegasus H. winner Forty One Carats (Tactical Advantage), runner-up in the Feb. 6 GIII Deputy Minister H., will make his next start in the Mar. 10 GII Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup Sprint Championship H. After getting bumped at the break in the Deputy Minister, the usually speedy four-year-old came from off the pace to miss by three-quarters of a length, but he will be back to his front-running tactics next time out. "He didn't like getting all that dirt kicked in his face," trainer David Fawkes said. "He'd never had that happen before. He was climbing like crazy. By the time he got straightened out, we were running out of racetrack."

Un Fino Vino Sharp at Gulfstream:

Un Fino Vino (Demidoff), runner-up in the Nov. 27 GII Remsen S. and a Gulfstream Park allowance winner Jan. 29, worked five furlongs in 1:01 1/5 at Gulfstream yesterday morning and will likely make his next start in the Feb. 19 GI Fountain of Youth S. "I like the way he worked," trainer Mitch Friedman said. "He has done everything well since he has been down here and he really likes this track. Right now I plan on running him Saturday. I'd like to find out what kind of horse I have."

Gulfstream Park Purses Raised:

Effective tomorrow, all overnight purses at Gulfstream will be increased approximately seven percent. In addition, the purse for an allowance race scheduled for the undercard of the Feb. 19 GI Fountain of Youth S., a 1 1/16-mile test for three-year-olds, has been raised from \$48,000 to \$75,000. Named the Unbridled, the race will serve as an option for Fountain of Youth candidates.

TOTE TO RACING TRUST? The British government may soon announce the sale of the Tote to a racing trust, according to Racing Post. The announcement is expected to come Tuesday in answer to a written enquiry to the Home Secretary in the House of Commons. Government ministers and officials of the racing trust are still in discussion, but it was reported that an agreement in principle, which has the approval of the Treasury, has been reached. The trust includes the British Horseracing Board, the Racecourse Association and current Tote staff, among others. But while the deal may be all but completed, the bills necessary to finalize the sale are not forecast for consideration during the current session of Parliament and, with a General Election expected in May 2001, they may not be introduced until 2002. The purchase price has not yet been set, but the racing trust has indicated a target of £50 million, a bargain compared to the Tote's current value of £200 million. But an insider told Racing Post, "The Treasury has been influenced by the fact that selling Tote to racing does not involve the sacrifice of a steady stream of tax revenue. In Treasury terms, the Tote is not worth a huge sum, and it is simpler to sell it to racing than to privatise it in some other, more politically controversial way." After the sale, the Tote would be run by an 11-member operating board representing the BHB, Industry Committee, Jockey Club, Racecourse Association, Racehorse Owners' Association, Tote staff and punters. The operating board would in turn report to an eight-member board of trustees. Peter Jones, current Tote chairman, would be named first chairman for three years.
