MANISTIQUE SAILS IN SANTA MARIA

Manistique (Unbridled), who has yet to win a race outside California, continued to be a dominant force in the Golden State with a half-length tally in yesterday's GI Santa Maria H. over a sloppy Santa Anita track. The dark bay mare rebounded from an eighthplace effort in the Nov. 6 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff to take the Dec. 11 GII Bayakoa H. by three lengths last time out. Sent off the 8-5 favorite here, Manistique loomed a threatening presence while racing four wide around the final turn. She took over a furlong from home and held off Bayakoa runner-up Snowberg (Seattle Sleet) under mild urging. "I was concerned about the weight and the track condition," winning trainer John Shirreffs admitted to the Thoroughbred Times. "This was one of the best fields she has run against in California, and she was squeezed coming out of the gate. I knew she could handle an off track, but I was concerned about slipping and sliding on this surface." Last year's GI Spinster winner Keeper Hill (Deputy Minister), unraced since finishing fifth in the Breeders' Cup Distaff, was allowed to settle in the early going and moved up slightly in the stretch to finish a nonthreatening fifth.

ANEES BACK ON TRACK

Anees (Unbridled), 1999's Eclipse Champion twoyear-old returned to the work tab yesterday at Santa Anita with a half-mile drill. The colt, owned by The Thoroughbred Corp. and trained by Alex Hassinger Jr., completed the work over a muddy track in :50, according to Thoroughbred Times. Anees earned his juvenile championship by winning the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, but his return to the races has been slowed by a bruised foot. To date, the three-year-old has won two of four races and earned \$609,200. He could make his three-year-old bow in the Mar. 19 GII San Felipe.
