HIGH-YIELDING FOUNTAIN

Ponce de Leon may have never found the long-sought Fountain of Youth, but the connections of High Yield (Storm Cat) have all stood in the winner's circle with a blanket of roses. Robert and Beverly Lewis teamed with trainer D. Wayne Lukas in last year's Derby with Charismatic, while co-owner Michael Tabor watched Thunder Gulch come home first at Churchill in 1995. Having gone in with Sue Magnier on the handsome High Yield as a yearling, they watched him capture the GI Hopeful at two. Third in the GI Breeders' Cup over this surface in November, he concluded his juvenile campaign with a second in the GI Hollywood Futurity. Adding blinkers for his three-year-old bow. High Yield was a game second in the GII Santa Catalina S. at Santa Anita Jan. 20 and shipped eastward to continue his Triple Crown preparations. Breaking alertly from post four with new pilot Pat Day, he dueled with Hal's Hope (Jolie's Halo) to the stretch, getting six furlongs in a sharp 1:09 4/5. Shaking free, he came home under a strong hand ride. "I was a little concerned with the 1:09 and change," said Lukas. "I thought it might set it up for a horse coming off of it. He'll go in the Florida Derby. We know where we want to go, we just have to pull it off."

WHO WANTS TO BE A MILLIONAIRE?

Tap To Music (Pleasant Tap), winner of the 1998 GI Gazelle H. at Belmont Park, struggled a bit during her four-year-old campaign, with a single victory from seven outings, a 1 3/4-length success in the 10-furlong GIII Delaware H. Fourth in the GI Ruffian in her penultimate start of 1999, the bay was fifth in the Breeders' Cup Distaff before getting a breather. She resurfaced to try the grass for the first time in Tampa Bay's Endeavour S. Jan. 4, but could manage only an eighth of 11 finish. The third choice in the full field, she was void of early speed, but began to advance a bit leaving the half mile pole. Jockey Joe Brayo sent the five-year-old between horses three wide on the turn, collared Her She Kisses (Dehere) at the eighth pole and prevailed over that one after a hard drive. Said Bravo, "This filly is doing really well. Class just prevailed. Joe (trainer Orseno) put me on the best horse. All I had to do was steer her today." Assistant trainer Russ Derderian added, "She has never trained really well, but when we brought her back from Florida, she was like a different horse. We'd like to ship her around a bit to see if we can make her a millionaire."

Last year, trainer Bob Baffert chose this spot for his returning two-year-old filly champion Silverbulletday and she responded with a victory. Baffert was hoping for a similar result with his newest Eclipse winner Chilukki, who was making her first start since suffering the first defeat of her career when second in the Breeders' Cup. Instead, Shawnee Country spoiled the party with a come-from-behind upset. Chilukki broke alertly, but was outfooted to the clubhouse turn by the Lukas-trained November Slew (Seattle Slew) and took up a stalking position outside that rival. Chilukki put away November Slew and came wide into the stretch, but was able to established a clear, three-length lead with a furlong to run. Shawnee Country, wide early, was closing relentlessly and was able to run down the champ in the waning strides to spring the surprise. "I was concerned I didn't save enough ground at the top of the stretch," said winning rider Donnie Meche. "She really responded well when I asked her to run at the top of the stretch." Baffert was satisfied with his filly's performance. "She ran her guts out," he said. "This race will tighten her up. (Jockey) Daivd (Flores) said that he went wide in the stretch because he thought the rail was dull," he added.

NYRA ANNOUNCES WOOD, DERBY BONUS

The New York Racing Association vesterday announced a total of \$250,000 in bonus money for the owner and trainer of any horse that wins the Apr. 15 GII Wood Memorial at Aqueduct and the Kentucky Derby three weeks later. The money is to be divided \$100,000 to the trainer and \$150,000 to the owner of the winner. "The Wood Memorial has, historically, been one of racing's most important races," commented NYRA racing secretary and handicapper Mike Lakow. "The purse increase to \$750,000 and now this total \$250,000 bonus shows how much NYRA thinks of this race and that sweeping both the Wood Memorial and the Kentucky Derby would rank as a major accomplishment by anyone's standards." Ten horses have completed the Wood/Derby double, most recently Pleasant Colony in 1981. Four horses, including Seattle Slew in 1977, have gone on to win the Triple Crown.

KEN MADDY PASSES AWAY A champion of legislation favorable to Thoroughbred racing while a member of the California state senate, Ken Maddy passed away Friday night after a lengthy bout with cancer. He was 64 years old. A Republican who represented his Fresno. California, district for over 25 years until being forced to leave the Senate due to term limitations, Maddy helped pass Senate Bill 27 in California, called at the time by Oak Tree Racing Association President Clement Hirsch, "the most significant horse-related legislation in the past 65 years." The traditional opening day stakes of the fall Oak Tree meeting, the GIII Autumn Days H., was renamed this year the Sen. Ken Maddy H. to honor his accomplishments and contributions to the Thoroughbred industry. Maddy, a co-owner of crack female sprinter Soviet Problem, was remembered with a statewide moment of silence prior to yesterday's first race at Santa Anita. Funeral arrangements are pending.

GOLDEN SNAKE RETURNS TO TRAINING G1

Prix Jean Prat Emirates Airlines winner Golden Snake (USA) (Danzig {USA}), who had been retired and advertised to stand at the National Stud for £6,500 this year, has returned to training, reported the *Racing Post*. Previously trained by Barry Hills for Mohamed Obaida, the four-year-old is now in the care of John Dunlop and will be the first horse to race in the colors of the National Stud. Miles Littleworth, the National Stud's Chief Executive, told the *Racing Post* that there is "no problem" with the horse's fertility and the decision to put him back into training was "to see if he can fulfill his potential as a four-year-old." Golden Snake, who most recently finished out of the money in the G1 Dubai Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 16, is expected to contest Europe's top middle-distance events.

BRITAIN'S FIRST INTERNET RACE A SUCCESS

The first Internet broadcast of British racing was called a success by the organisers, with a peak audience of 23,000 logging on for Ascot's Mitsubishi Shogun Ascot Chase yesterday. Ascot's chief executive Douglas Erskine-Crum said, "We are very pleased with the broadcast, though I would stress that it was only a trial designed mainly so that we could assess the limitations of current technology. While the picture quality was variable at times and suffered when the peak audience was reached, the people I have spoken to were impressed overall. I think it bodes very well for the future." British racing hopes to generate significant sums of money in the future from Internet broadcasts.
