STORM CAT BACK IN BREEDING SHED

Superstar stallion **Storm Cat** (Storm Bird), who spent three days at Hagyard-Davidson-McGee equine hospital with a slight case of colic and a mild fever, returned to the breeding shed at Overbrook Farm in Lexington yesterday afternoon. The 17-year-old stallion was bred to Song of Syria (Damascus), the dam of Eclipse Awardwinner Chilukki, and is scheduled to cover two more mares today. The leading sire in 1999 with more than \$10.3 million in progeny earnings, Storm Cat stands for a fee of \$300,000.

DUBAI WORLD CUP DAY FIELDS TAKE SHAPE

The early confirmations for the five stakes on the Dubai World Cup program, to be run Mar. 25 at Nad Al Sheba, include winners of the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, G1 Epsom Derby and G1 English 2000 Guineas. A total of 11 Grade I or Group 1 winners have already accepted invitations, prompting Les Benton, chairman of the Dubai World Cup Committee, to say, "The confirmations we have received, with more to come, are justification for the alterations made to the meeting from 1999 to 2000. It is the result of a worldwide marketing and promotional campaign to lift the Dubai World Cup meeting to the peak of international racing, and these early confirmations have proven that." The \$6 million Dubai World Cup has drawn MGISW Behrens (Pleasant Colony) and Hong Kong champion Indigenous (Ire) (Marju {Ire}) as well as graded-stakes winners Lear Spear (Lear Fan), Public Purse (Private Account) and Running Stag (Cozzene). Pointing for the \$2 million GIII Dubai Duty Free are MG1SW Aljabr (Storm Cat), 1999 G1 English 2000 Guineas hero Island Sands (Ire) (Turtle Island {Ire}), MGSW Ladies Din (Din's Dancer) and South African champion Resfa (SAf) (Fitzcarraldo {Arg}). New Zealand Group 1 winner Able Master (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}), '98 G1 Epsom Derby winner High-Rise (Ire) (High Estate {Ire}), South American Group 1 winner Potrizaris (Arg) (Potrillazo {Arg}), MGISW Royal Anthem (Theatrical {Ire}) and '98 G1 Arc victor Sagamix (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}) have confirmed for the \$2 million GIII Dubai Sheema Classic. "But we still have more to do--these are just the early confirmations and we are looking to turn those that are currently 75 percent to come to Dubai to 100 percent," Benton said.

GENERAL SUCCESS

Considered one of the top sprinters in the country, Affirmed Success (Affirmed) seemingly ran into bad luck at every turn in 1999, but he finally found the winner's circle after a rousing five-length victory in the GI Cigar Mile Nov. 27. He started the new year right where he left off, driving to a half-length score in yesterday's GII General George H. at Laurel Park. First or second in seven of his eights starts in 1998, the six-year-old was up against track-record setter and champion-to-be Artax in his first try of '99, the GI Carter H., and was second, then finished off the board in the GI Met Mile. Next he ran into Crafty Friend just as that one was at the very top of his game and finished second to that rival in the GII Tom Fool H. and GII Forego. Ninth over the speedfavoring Gulfstream Park surface in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, Affirmed Success bounced back in the final start of his five-year-old campaign and, back at what may be his best distance in his 2000 debut, was hammered down to 1-2. Away smartly, he pressed the pace while four deep, swept to the lead turning for home and dug in gamely to hold off Young At Heart (Ferdinand) and Badge (Air Forbes Won), and move past \$1 million in earnings. "We're pleased that he came out so well today, because he had such a tough time last year," trainer Rick Schosberg said. "He always runs against the best sprinters--we've never ducked anyone." The winner takes another shot at the May 7 Carter H. next.

Wing Arrow, Japan's champion dirt horse at three, was fifth in his 2000 debut in the Jan. 23 G3 Heian S. in his last outing. Near the back of the 16-horse field early, the five-year-old delivered a powerful stretch run to take the lead nearing the wire. "I was worried because he didn't move up as I expected on the final turn," said winning rider Olivier Peslier, only the third foreign jockey to win a Japanese Group 1 race. "He tried to lug in, but he showed good fighting spirit in the stretch."

Dark Moondancer ended his European campaign with back-to-back wins in the G1 Prix Ganay and G1 Gran Premio di Milano, but showed little in his U.S. bow, running ninth in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. Freshened after that effort, the bay came back in the Jan. 22 GII San Marcos H. and finished second, missing by only a head after a wide trip. Odds-on to get back to his winning ways this time, he settled in second through soft early fractions, put a head in front after 10 furlongs and pulled away. "That is what we thought we had from the beginning," trainer Ron McAnally said. "When he came over for the Breeders' Cup, he just wasn't fit...he looks so much better now than he did a few months ago. In my opinion, as of today, he's one of the best we've seen in the country." The winner goes next in the GII San Luis Rey S. Mar. 18.

The winner of an inner-track allowance to begin her 1999 campaign, New York-bred Biogio's Rose was a head second in the GIII Next Move H., third in Keeneland's Doubledogdare S. and second in the Monmouth Beach S., but went to the shelf after a sixth-place allowance finish at Belmont July 2. Third in her Dec. 31 return, the chestnut was fifth in the GIII Affectionately H. Jan. 15, but rebounded with a 5 1/2-length victory in money-allowance company Feb. 5. Moving back up the ladder, she settled along the rail in fifth position, circled three wide into the lane, collared Roaring Twenties inside the final eighth of a mile and drew clear to her first graded-stakes success. The win was also the first in stakes company for apprentice jockey Norberto Arroyo Jr.

W.T. Young had every reason to be pleased with the results of both of last Saturday's important three-year-old tests. The owner of Overbrook Farm saw the Fountain of Youth S. provide yet another Grade I success for his star stallion Storm Cat when High Yield improved his Triple Crown hopes with a decisive victory. Even more pleasing, though, was Shawnee Country's display in the Overbrook colors in the GIII Davona Dale S., when this tough Chief's Crown filly wore down Chilukki to record her second graded success.

Coincidentally, the sires of both these winners are bred along parallel lines, both being the result of matings between a fast son of Northern Dancer and a stakes-winning daughter of Secretariat. There, though, the similarities between Storm Cat and Chief's Crown end. Whereas Storm Cat's exploits as a stallion have exceeded all expectations, Chief's Crown generally did not fulfill the very high hopes generated by his truly admirable racing career and his magnificent pedigree. Indeed, I think it is fair to say that his premature death at the age of 15 in 1997 was not widely mourned by the American industry, apart from those associated with him at Three Chimneys.

The bare facts are that, from a total of over 480 foals of racing age, Chief's Crown has so far sired just two GI winners in the U.S.--Breeders' Cup Turf hero Chief Bearhart and Brooklyn H. winner Chief Honcho. Perhaps Shawnee Country will soon become his third.

These three rank alongside Concerto, Crowned, Ampulla, Regal Thunder, Three Fanfares, Provins and Coronation Cup as the 10 graded-stakes winners by Chief's Crown in the U.S, but this statistic reveals nothing like the full story.

The reality is that Chief's Crown's talents were much more appreciated in Europe than in his native land. European demand for his stock was fueled by the 1989 group successes of his first-crop sons Be My Chief and Dr Somerville, and further Group success came his way via the champion juvenile Grand Lodge and the Derby winner Erhaab, as well as with Halesia, Ski Chief, Key of Luck and Siddharta. Chief's Crown's stock have also gone well on the turf in Australia, where Istidaad and Azzaam both became Group 1 winners.

Bearing in mind that Chief Bearhart, Ampulla and Coronation Cup also gained their major wins on turf, the graded-stakes winners on dirt are in the minority. Just why turf has featured so prominently in Chief's Crown's record as a stallion isn't easy to explain. Chief's Crown made only a fleeting venture onto the turf (when he won a mile handicap at Belmont) and the same applied to both his grandsires, Northern Dancer and Secretariat. Although both won on turf, they made their names primarily through their efforts in the Triple Crown races on dirt. Chris Evert, another of the four horses in the second generation of Chief's Crown's pedigree, was another star on the main track.

Northern Dancer's sire Nearctic also appears in Shawnee Country's pedigree as the grandsire of her dam, Mi Lucia. This daughter of Icecapade inherited some of her sire's speed, as she showed by winning five minor stakes at around six furlongs and another over 8 1/2 furlongs in California. The next dam, Not A Flaw, won the San Jose H. over 8 1/2 furlongs and was a half-sister to Polite Rebuff, a dual Grade III winner at up to nine furlongs. However, the most notable member of Shawnee Country's female line is her fourth dam, Politely. This daughter of Amerigo retired as a winner of 21 of her 49 starts and was the highest-rated mare on the *Daily Racing Form* Free Handicap in 1968. And now the family seems to have produced another filly capable of competing at the highest level.

Ultimate Warrior entered the ranks of the stakes winners when powering to a front-running 2 1/4-length victory in the Hoosier Juvenile Dec. 5. The gray was second best behind Personal First in the Turfway Park Prevue S. two back, but faltered most recently to be a distant fourth at odds-on in the Florence S. at Turfway Jan. 15. Shipped south for this effort and favorably drawn for his running style, Ultimate Warrior left no doubt about this result, speeding to the early lead and extending his margin to the wire. "He's about as fast as any horse I've got in the barn and I've got some fast ones," commented assistant trainer Steve Flint, who added that the GIII Swale S. Mar. 11 is under consideration for the winner.
