NUREYEV RESUMES STUD DUTIES Nureyev (Northern Dancer) successfully covered a mare yesterday, Walmac veterinarian J. D. Howard reported. The stallion's breeding season was in jeopardy just two weeks ago when he began suffering from a circulatory disorder. "We remain optimistic that no setbacks will be encountered as we proceed cautiously with the mares in his book," Howard said. "He will continue undergoing treatment to prevent any recurrence of his circulatory disorder."

STRAVINSKY TO NEW ZEALAND European champion sprinter Stravinsky (Nureyev--Fire the Groom, by Blushing Groom {Fr}) will shuttle to Sir Patrick Hogan's Cambridge Stud in New Zealand for the southern hemisphere breeding season. The four-year-old ended his European campaign with impressive victories in the G1 July Cup and the G1 Nunthorpe S. After finishing off the board in last year's Breeders' Cup Sprint, Stravinsky was retired to Ashford Stud in Versailles, Kentucky where he is currently standing his first season at stud. He will stand in the southern hemisphere for NZ\$30,000. Cambridge Stud is also the home of leading New Zealand sire Zabeel (NZ).

Multiple graded stakes winner Mil Kilates (Gold Alert) worked four furlongs at Calder Thursday in :50 3/5. "I plan to breed her (this year), but then put her back on the track for another six months," owner John Franks said of the seven-year-old mare. Mil Kilates made the first two starts of her career in Panama in 1995. She was ridden in Central America by Camilo Pitty who has been turning heads at Gulfstream in his first foray in the United States. Pitty was asked if he remembered Mil Kilates. "Yes, because I worked the horse several times and one time when I rode her she won by 30 lengths," the jockey responded. Mil Kilates has been off since finishing fifth in the GIII Gardenia H. at Ellis Park in August.

Up We Go (Waquoit) worked five furlongs Wednesday at Gulfstream in 1:00. It was the third best of 38 horses that worked that distance Wednesday. The four-year-old Allen Jerkens trainee is coming off three straight allowance wins.

LAMINITIS CUTS NOTE'S BOOK Notebook (Well Decorated--Mobcap, by Tom Rolfe), the sire of graded stakes winners Three Ring and Summer Note, has had his book of mares cut in half for the 2000 breeding season, according to *The Blood-Horse*. The 15-year-old stallion is suffering complications from laminitis in his front feet. "We reduced his book from 100 mares to 50 mares, but expect him to improve," Ocala Stud Farm owner J. Michael O'Farrell told *The Blood-Horse*. "He began covering mares before the Feb. 15 start and is covering them now." Notebook is the sire of 18 stakes winners.

Heritage of Gold Eyes Oaklawn for 2000 Debut:

Heritage of Gold (Gold Legend), third in the Breeders' Cup Distaff last November, is in training with Tom Amoss at Fair Grounds. The filly is being pointed towards the Mar. 19 Gill Oaklawn Breeders' Cup S. with an eye towards the Apr. 9 GI Apple Blossom. The multiple graded stakes winner, owned by Jack Garey of Georgetown, Texas, has won 10 of 18 races, with earnings of \$929,480.

Churchill Reports Net Earnings Gain:

Churchill Downs, Inc. reported net revenues for 1999 totaling \$258.4 million, a 75-percent increase over 1998. Net earnings were \$15 million, a 42-percent increase. Earnings per share for the year were \$1.72 diluted on 8.7 million average diluted shares outstanding. The results represented the seventh consecutive year of record earnings for the company. "The gains for the fourth quarter and full year exceed analysts' estimates and further validated the strength of our ongoing growth strategy," said Thomas Meeker, Churchill's president and chief executive officer. "The results for the fourth quarter reflected the initial contribution from Hollywood Park, which we acquired in September 1999, and the impact of Calder Race Course, which we acquired in April 1999."

Go West, Young Man:

Joe Bravo, perennial leading rider at Monmouth Park and currently second in the standings at Aqueduct, will shift his tack to Santa Anita starting Mar. 8. California jockey agent Nick Cosato, former agent for Pat Valenzuela, made the announcement during an interview with The Racing Network. "I contacted Joe four years ago about coming to California, and at time he was not interested," said Cosato. "The timing is perfect now with Stevens [Gary] retired, Antley on the shelf, and Pat Valenzuela is out. Joe intends to ride in California for one year." Bravo will ride on the East coast through Sunday, Mar. 5. "I've been out there [Santa Anita] for the last two days, and have gotten a good reception from everyone, including the Lukas barn," commented Bravo. "I feel confident with my agent, and I'm going to give it 110 percent."

HARRINGTON GUILTY OF EXTORSION

Private investigator Robert Harrington was found guilty in an Old Bailey, London case of trying to extort money from former leading jump jockey Jamie Osborne. Harrington, 58, a former detective sergeant in the police, was found guilty by a 10-2 majority verdict, of obtaining £500 from Osborne by deception and corruptly soliciting £2,000 claiming it was a police bribe. He was warned that he faces jail when Judge David Paget remanded him in custody until March 31. Afterwards, Detective Constable Shaun McLeary said, "The verdict completely vindicates Jamie Osborne. Since his arrest, Harrington has tried to destroy him." Osborne, now a trainer, proclaimed his relief after the verdict. "I am very pleased that this unwelcome chapter in my life has ended," he said. "Many innocent people have been damaged by this case but thankfully after two years, it is now over and I am free to concentrate on my new career."

HILTON GROUP REPORTS PROFITS

The Hilton Group, which owns Britain's largest bookmaker Ladbroke, yesterday reported increased operating profits for its betting business which also takes in casinos. Operating profit in 1999 was £139.2 million for the betting side on a turnover of £3,140.4 million compared with a like-for-like profit of £137.1 million in 1998 on turnover of £2,894.6 million. Hilton is continuing to dispose of Ladbroke's non-European ventures while at the same time strongly investing in Internet betting sites.

HIGH COURT RULES AGAINST AGA KHAN

A High Court judge has decided that a former secretary at the Aga Khan's Irish stud farm is entitled to her regular salary and court costs she has incurred as a result of her lawsuit against the Aga Khan's bloodstock holding company, *Thoroughbred Times Online* reports. Mary Charlton, a secretary at the stud for 27 years, was an assistant to former stud manager Ghislain Drion, who resigned his position in 1998 amidst allegations that he had unauthorized horses at the stud. Charlton is suing to retain her job and to discontinue an internal review of alleged misconduct on her part. In addition, Justice Declan Budd was critical of Frank Faughnan, personnel manager at the stud, for making contact with Charlton when he was expressly forbidden by a restraining order to do so.
