BEHRENS IS BACK

Behrens (Pleasant Colony) launched himself to national prominence with a victory in last year's Gulfstream Park H., and returned with a vengeance to take this year's renewal. It also marked his first visit to the winner's circle since the GII Suburban H. at Belmont in July. Freshened up following a dull seventh in the Breeders' Cup, he rallied for third in the GI Donn H. Feb. 5. As the only Grade I winner in the field, he went to post as the overwhelming 1-5 public choice. Breaking in stride, he used his tactical speed as With Anticipation (Relaunch) cut out fractions of :23 1/5 and :47 3/5. The pair quickly opened up on the field, leading the pack by six lengths heading into the far turn. Behrens swallowed the gallant gray pacesetter turning for home and extended his advantage under a hand ride. "When I asked my horse, he really gave me a lot," said winning jockey Jorge Chavez. "He just took off." Behrens may have punched his ticket for Dubai with this effort. "We decided to run him as a six-year-old because we want him to become the winningest horse in money won to never have won an Eclipse Award. His next race will be the Dubai World Cup (G1, 10f, \$6 million, 3/25)." Adonis (Kris S.) launched his bid in the stretch and got up for second. Isaypete (Peteski) broke down in the stretch and was vanned off the track.

Lines of Beauty, last out fifth in the GI Spinster S. at Keeneland Oct. 16, will be going straight to the front out of the gate. The winner of the GIII Gardenia H. runs well fresh and may have enough to outlast these. GI Test S. winner Marley Vale, usually at her best sprinting, will try two turns for the first time since she finished fifth in the Kentucky Oaks. She was second in the GIII First Lady H. Jan. 12 and most recently won the GIII Shirley Jones H. Feb. 2.

Having gained her first U.S. victory in the 10-furlong Reloy H. last out, Lexa's connections might have been a bit apprehensive facing 2-5 Tuzla over a flat mile. All worries were for naught as the French-bred chestnut settled off the pace along the inside, angled out in the straight and kicked on gamely past the pacesetting Here's to You. Tuzla, in perfect position, flattened out in deep stretch. "I wasn't concerned [about the short distance] because she had run second at a mile before." said winning jockey Brice Blanc. "I was also confident because the turf was deep. It seemed like she handled the soft ground in France." Lexa's breeding career may be on hold. "The March Santa Ana H. (GII, \$150K, 9f, 3/26) is a definite if she comes out OK," said trainer Ron Ellis. "The increase in distance should help her, and the way she won today, maybe we'll wait to breed her after all."
