FASIG-TIPTON CALDER SALE STARTS TODAY

Fasig-Tipton has catalogued 331 juveniles for the Calder Selected Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale, which begins its two-day run today at 7:30 p.m. in Miami, Florida. Among the outstanding sires represented at the auction are A.P. Indy, Deputy Minister, Gone West, Gulch, Phone Trick, Seeking the Gold, Silver Deputy, Storm Cat and Woodman. The catalogue's highlights include hip number 141, a filly by Seeking the Gold out of graded stakes winner Bold Windy (Bold Tropic {SAf}). The bay, from the consignment of Sequel Bloodstock, agent, turned in a :21.4 two-furlong work as part of the sale's under tack preview last Sunday at Calder. Hip number 272, a son of Cherokee Run--Marital Spook, by Silver Ghost, raised eyebrows when he blazed a furlong in:10 flat at the same preview. The dark bay is consigned by Niall Brennan Stables, agent. One of three two-year-olds in the auction by Hennessy is hip number 105. The chestnut filly, from the consignment of Eddie Woods, agent, and out of the Crafty Prospector mare Win Crafty Lady, worked one furlong in :10.1 last Sunday at Calder. Hip number 113 is the only juvenile by leading sire Storm Cat in the sale. From the consignment of Hartley-Derenzo Thoroughbreds, agent, the colt is out of Adorable Micol (Riverman) and is a full brother to graded stakes winner Adcat. From the consignment of M. W. Miller III, agent, is hip number 237. The son of Woodman is out of the mare Jadana (Ire) (Pharly) and is a half brother to MGISW Jade Hunter (Mr. Prospector). At yesterday's second under-tack preview at Calder, two fillies shared the two-furlong bullet. Both hip number 162 (Dehere--Colony Rose, by Pleasant Colony) and 284 (Phone Trick--Misstormyweathers, by Storm Cat) worked in :21.3. Three horses shared the fastest onefurlong work of :10.2. They were: hip number 38 (c, Salt Lake--Silver Spool, by Strike Gold), 144 (c, Forest Wildcat--Cal At Short, by Ogygian) and 210 (f, Forest Wildcat--Give Me Liberty, by Give Me Strength). Among the freshman sires represented at the sale by their first juveniles are Forest Wildcat, Grindstone, Hennessy, Honour and Glory, Maria's Mon, Miesque's Son, Roar, Unbridled's Song and Wekiva Springs. The sale's second and final session begins Tuesday at 12 noon.

BELLA PULLS RAMPART SURPRISE

Bella Chiarra (Phone Trick) was second in the GIII Wilshire H. over the Hollywood turf last May, but switched to the main track two starts later to run third at boxcar odds to Manistique in the GI Vanity H. Given to trainer Pat Byrne after the death of Charlie Whittingham, the chestnut won a Turfway main track allowance and was third in the My Charmer S. at Florence before getting a breather. Jockey Shane Sellers took the reins for the first time in her most recent start and guided the mare to a one-length, front-running victory over a grassy mile Jan. 21. Lines Of Beauty (Line in the Sand) was sent for the lead but was tracked intently from the rail by Bella Chiarra. Positions were unchanged as the field turned for home and Lines Of Beauty opened a bit of daylight on Bella Chiarra, but the latter fought back very gamely and outfinished her rival for her first graded-stakes victory. "She runs as good on dirt as she does on the grass," commented Sellers. "I asked her to do something she shouldn't have to do. I certainly didn't want to go 46 and change (the half went in :46 2/5), but I didn't want her to get dirt in her face. She overcame the speed and overcame me, so I have to give her all the credit." Trainer Pat Byrne said the filly would likely start next at Keeneland.

Fortifier, who began his career with back-to-back wins in the Calder and Del Mar claiming ranks last summer, but began 2000 in graded stakes company. Claimed for \$50,000 at Del Mar in August, the grey colt ended 1999 with a Bay Meadows allowance win over subsequent GII San Vicente winner Archer City Slew. He debuted as a three-year-old with a fourth-place finish in the Jan. 8 GIII San Miguel before running fifth in the Feb. 5 GII San Vicente last time out. Putting his perfect two-for-two record on an off track to the test, Fortifier loomed six wide at the top of the lane and overtook the leaders in deep stretch for his first stakes win. "I'm going to get him his own Internet account and have him go to the Weather Channel.com because he's going to run only if it rains," owner Howell Wynne said of the winner. "That was a 14-year layoff between stakes wins for me at Santa Anita (Greinton in the 1986 Santa Anita H., co-owned with Charlie Whittingham)." Trainer Dan Hendricks added, "He moves well on a yielding or heavy track, better than on a harder sealed track. He loved the going out there." As for what is next for Fortifier, Hendricks said, "We might go back East, maybe find somewhere where it rains and there's mud." Favored Gibson County (In Excess {Ire}), third in the San Vicente, set the pace but couldn't keep up when challenged and finished fifth. Second choice Joopy Doopy, runner-up in the San Vicente, stalked Gibson County's early lead, but was overtaken down the lane to finish third.

INEXPLICABLE (h, 5, Miswaki--Mythomania {SP-Fr}, by Nureyev) switched to the infield for the first time two back and rallied to finish second, beaten just a head at 7 1/2 furlongs at Calder Dec. 13. He scored his first victory on the lawn in his last, a two-length tally over the local green Jan. 27. The 3-1 second choice rated behind the pace, circled three wide into the lane and edged away to win by a length. GIII Laurel Futurity winner Scottish Halo (Jolie's Halo), using this start as a prep for the Florida Derby, was reserved in the rear and made a mild late run to finish fifth, beaten 10 lengths. Lifetime Record: 10-4-3-1, \$104,064.

5th-GPX, \$38,000, Alw, 4yo/up, a1 3/8mT, 2:16, fm. DRAMA CRITIC (c, 4, Theatrical {Ire}--Guiza {MGSW & MGISP, \$576,585}, by Golden Act) added Lasix for his first start around two turns to run a solid second by 1 1/4 lengths Jan. 8 over the main track. The bay rallied to be a 3/4-length winner of his turf debut in his latest effort Feb. 2. Getting an extra quarter mile for this run, Drama Critic tracked the pace, swung three wide into the stretch and wore down 6-5 favorite Medievil Hero (Sea Hero) to win by three parts of a length as the 4-1 second choice. Lifetime Record: 7-3-1-1, \$68,660. O-Amerman Racing Stables. B-B Jelks Frances (KY). T-Mark Hennig.

11th-GPX, \$38,000, Alw, 3yo, a1mT, 1:36 1/5, fm. FIELD CAT (c, 3, Metfield--Sandy's Storm {SP}, by Storm Cat) entered this race having never been worse than second in five starts on turf and was most recently second in the Hopemont S. at Keeneland Oct. 29. The 2-1 favorite broke on top, made all the pace and finished well to hold off Lendell Ray (Regal Affair), a newcomer to the Mott barn who was most recently a fast-closing fourth in the Hopemont, by 3/4 of a length. 9th-GPX, \$36,000, Alw, 3yo, f, 6f, 1:10 2/5, ft. She then graduated from the maiden ranks by eight lengths Nov. 4 and came back to run second by a head in the GII Demoiselle S. at Aqueduct Nov. 27. Making her first start since that effort, the 2-1 favorite was bumped early but recovered to track the pace in fifth early on. She then advanced three wide into contention, hooked up with Lucky Livi (Mr. Greeley) at the top of the lane and came out of a furious duel with that one to the wire to win by a neck. Dropped in for a \$32,000 tag Feb. 9, the bay went wire-to-wire to win by 8 1/2 lengths when trying two turns for the first time. The 7-1 shot dueled for the lead with favored Heather Light, took a short lead along the inside turning for home and inched away late to win by 1 1/4 lengths. Lifetime Record: 9-3-0-2, \$57,755.

Multiple stakes winner Isaypete (Peteski--Isaygo, by Nijinsky II) suffered a leg injury during Saturday's GI Gulfstream Park H. and will likely be retired. "He pulled a tendon and suspensory in his right front leg in Saturday's stakes," trainer Shug McGaughey explained. "It isn't life threatening and he doesn't need surgery, but I doubt he'll ever be able to run again. We'll take it a day at a time with him now." The four-year-old won four of 14 starts and earned \$278,040. In addition to wins in the Calder Derby and Pomona Derby, he was second behind Horse Chestnut in the GIII Broward H. Jan. 8.


