SOUTH AMERICANS STAR AT SANTA ANITA

Leading every step of the way, Riboletta (Brz) (Roi Normand) became the 10th South American-bred mare since 1974 to take the GI Santa Margarita H., splashing home by three lengths over Bordelaise (Arg) (Espacial {Arg}) at Santa Anita yesterday afternoon. The 5-1 fourth choice in the five-horse field, Riboletta had won just once in eight previous U.S. starts, taking a Santa Anita allowance on the grass last October, but she had been knocking on the door in stakes company lately, running third in the Jan. 17 GII San Gorgonio H. and fourth in the Feb. 13 GI Santa Maria H. Sent right to the lead over the sloppy track, the bay raced with Gourmet Girl (Cee's Tizzy) through six furlongs in 1:11 2/5, opened up as they headed into the stretch and drove home a decisive winner. "She has won in South America on a track like this and I thought she'd love it," said trainer Eduardo Inda, who was saddling his first winner for owners Aaron and Marie Jones after taking over their string Jan. 9. Added jockey Corey Nakatani, who was taking this race for the fourth time in the past eight runnings, "She was comfortable out there all the way around. She never took a bad step." A Grade I winner on the turf in her native country, the Brazilian-bred will look to add to her main-track resume in the near future. "I want to keep her on the dirt now," Inda said. "The Apple Blossom (GI, Oaklawn Park, Apr. 9) is possible."

"OOP" DREAMS IN NEW ORLEANS

The 45-1 outsider in yesterday's GIII New Orleans H. at the Fair Grounds, Allen's Oop (Nines Wild) shocked the crowd, outfinishing 30-1 Take Note of Me (Notebook) to win by a length and pay \$93.60. The exacta paid \$726. Shipping in off a pair of stakes wins at Sam Houston Park, the five-year-old gelding chased Wild Imagination (Wild Again) through reasonable early fractions, drove past the pacesetter as they raced into the stretch and found an extra gear as fellow longshot Take Note of Me charged up the rail to post his first gradedstakes victory. "He was the pilot and I was the passenger today," winning jockey Willie Martinez said. "He made his move around the turn and I pulled the trigger and it was all over from there." The bay almost pulled off the upset last year, grabbing the lead late in the '99 New Orleans H. before losing it in the final strides to Precocity and Real Quiet to finish third, beaten less than a length at 38-1. The 9-10 favorite Golden Missile (A.P. Indy) came with a mild bid on the far turn, but hung in the stretch and finished fifth.

The winner of the G2 Blanford S. at The Curragh in the fall of 1998. Lisieux Rose was 0-for-five last season, ending her European campaign with a third-place finish in the '99 edition of the Blanford on Sept. 19. Making her American bow after getting a 5 1/2-month break, the homebred chestnut mare tracked 9-10 Idle Rich (Sky Classic) as the favorite set a steady pace, finally drove past that rival in deep stretch and had just enough left to hold off the late surge of Champagne Royal for the victory. "She came to me in November," trainer Christophe Clement said. "She took quite a while to get 'Americanized,' which is why it took me so long to get her ready. It might have been a bit ambitious to run her here at a mile and a half, but it worked." As for the future, Clement, who also saddled third-place finisher Fly for Avie, said, "I will have to check with (Michael Cosgrove, manager of Moyglare Stud Farm). He might want to breed her, but the way she ran today might be a good incentive to go on...maybe to the San Juan Capistrano H. (GI, Santa Anita, Apr. 22)."

Although he often gets lost in the superstar shadows cast by other Mike Pegram-owned horses such as Silverbulletday and Real Quiet, Commitisize has quietly amassed a bankroll of over \$600,000 over the last three vears on the Southern California circuit. The dark bay came into this event off an even sixth in the Rebs Policy H. going down the hill at Santa Anita Feb. 6. Though he spent most of his sophomore season and all of his fouryear-old year on turf, Commitisize did win the GIII Hollywood Prevue S. over the dirt as a two-year-old, a fact overlooked by the betting public, who let him go at 4-1 after this race was taken off the turf. Sent straight to the lead. Commitisize dictated the pace and had enough left to fend off the challenge of 1997 G1 Gran Premio Carlos Pellegrini S. winner Chullo, who's erratic running down the lane may have cost him the race.

HIGH YIELD SHARP FOR FLORIDA DERBY

GI Fountain of Youth S. winner High Yield (Storm Cat), the likely favorite for next Saturday's \$750,000 GI Florida Derby at Gulfstream Park, worked five furlongs in 1:00 flat over that track yesterday morning. "It was an excellent work and he's really doing well," Barry Knight, assistant to trainer D. Wayne Lukas, said. The three-year-old was in front nearly every step in the Fountain of Youth, but Knight insists the colt doesn't need the lead. "High Yield can either run on the lead or come from off the pace and we really think his best race is coming from off the pace," he said. "He's very versatile and he seems to be better now than ever."



Trio Added to Gulfstream Hall of Fame:

Banshee Breeze (Unbridled), Parka (*Arctic Prince) and Silver Charm (Silver Buck) were inducted into Gulfstream Park's Garden of Champions during a winner's circle ceremony at the track Saturday. Banshee Breeze, the champion three-year-old filly of 1998, was four-for-five at Gulfstream and ended her career with a second-place finish in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Distaff over the track; Parka was claimed for \$10,000 and went on to win 11 stakes and the 1965 turf championship; and Eclipse winner Silver Charm took the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness in 1997 and the G1 Dubai World Cup in '98. A total of 98 horses are now enshrined in the Garden of Champions.
