DANCING IN THE SAN LUIS REY Dark Moondancer (GB) (Anshan {GB}) was bet down to 2-5 off the strength of his impressive score in the GII San Luis Obispo H. over this course Feb. 21, but had to summon all of his class for a desperate victory over defending champ Single Empire (Ire) (Kris {GB}) in yesterday's GII San Luis Rey. The crowd's choice stalked pacesetter Foggy Day (Fr) (Pistolet Bleu {Ire}) to the straight, where he kicked into gear. Briefly clear, he bravely held off the late charge of Single Empire in the shadow of the wire. "He fought some kind of hard today. Single Empire made a great run at him, but this horse just pinned his ears and showed a lot of determination," said winning jockey Chris McCarron. "He's an awful nice horse. He was on a little bit of a loose rein [early], and I love that." The top two finishers will head on to the premier U.S. turf marathon at this course Apr. 22, the GI San Juan Capistrano over 1 3/4 miles. "I can't say enough about him [Dark Moondancer]," said winning trainer Ron McAnally. "We'll run next in the San Juan Capistrano."

MARCH MADNESS IN THE SAN FELIPE

With less than two months remaining to the Kentucky Derby, a deep field of seven will go postward in Southern California's toughest prep yet. Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr. Prospector), the \$4 million-dollar wonder horse, makes his stakes debut. The handsome bay, easy winner of a Santa Anita allowance a month ago, tuned up for this with a bullet six furlongs in 1:14 3/5 at Hollywood Wednesday, "We'll just see how he matches up with the others," said trainer Neil Drysdale, who also trains the undefeated War Chant. "He's athletic. He's talented. Everything is very straightforward." The Thoroughbred Corp's Anees (Unbridled), the object of much speculation this past week, will be attempting to buck trends as he makes his three-year-old bow with new pilot Jerry Bailey. With no two-year-old champions/Breeder's Cup Juvenile winners having yet worn the blanket of roses, last year's Eclipse winner will be pointing for Kentucky off just two starts. The Hassinger trainee worked a handy three-quarters in 1:12 4/5 at Santa Anita last Monday. The Deputy (Ire) (Petardia {GB}) went wire-towire when defeating High Yield and Captain Steve in the GII Santa Catalina Jan. 30, a race which marked his dirt debut. Trained by Jenine Sahadi, he may be looking to rate off the pace this time around. "I think we should be right in the middle early in the race Sunday," said coowner Jeff Siegel. "He should get a good chance to sit and get some dirt in his face, and we need to see that."

Off a bit slowly, the longshot circled the field and finished well up the middle of the track, two lengths behind 3-5 chalk Lemon Drop Kid. His wide trip enabled him to steer clear as the favorite ducked in at the eighth pole, causing Karly's Harly to take up sharply.

A stakes winner at two, the Florida bred was claimed for \$75,000 by his current connections last August at Sarataog and closed out his 1999 campaign with a win in a \$75,000 Churchill claimer. Fourth to Blazing Sword in his 2000 bow, he weakened late when third to K One King in a Gulfstream allowance Feb. 24. Breaking smartly from the rail, he quickly assumed command through moderate fractions and was able to hold off favored Crimson Classic.

A registered Canadian-bred, he sells on Tuesday from the consignment of H.T. Stables, Inc. A pair of fillies shared the fastest time of :21 1/5 for a quarter-mile breeze. Hip 13, a bay filly by Diablo--B L's Girl (Master Derby), is a half sister to graded stakes winner B L's Appeal and stakes winner B L's Sweep, and will be offered by Mark Casse, agent. The other, Hip 153, is a registered New-York bred by Belong to Me consigned by James Layden, agent. The session's fastest three-eighths breeze was recorded by Hip 169, who stopped the clock in :34 3/5. By Take Me Out, he was produced from the multiple Grade I-placed Island Kiss (*Hawaii) and sells from the consignment of Tony Bowling and Bobby Dodd, agent. The second Under Tack Show continues today at 9 a.m., while Monday will feature the OBS Day of Champions race card. Entering the straight Zanay went into the lead ahead of Widar and drew progressively clear inside the final furlong to record an impressive win. Aljaarif stayed on well from the rear and grabbed second from his compatriot Widar in the dying strides.

GERMAN FORAY TO LINGFIELD A SUCCESS

With three runners yielding second and third placings in the £55,000 Listed Bet Direct Winter Derby at Lingfield, the German challenge can be considered a resounding success. Roymillon (Ger) (Milesius {USA}), Widar (GB) (Soviet Star {USA}) and Aljaarif (GB) (Rainbow Quest {USA}) finished first, second and fifth respectively in the Listed Sandbahn Grand Prix der Deutschen Buchmacher at Neuss Feb. 27, and became the first German-trained horses to appear at the Surrey track. It was 25-1 chance Aljaarif who emerged the best of the three when running on strongly to deny 20-1 Widar second place in the lateclosing stages of a fast run race which was won by the 5-4 favourite Zanay (GB) (Forzando {GB}).
