#### **NEW MILLENNIUM IN DUBAI?**

Godolphin's Dubai Millennium (GB) (Seeking the Gold) will attempt to live up to his name as an international field of thirteen goes postward in the fifth running of the Dubai World Cup. With only a ninth in the Epsom Derby marring an otherwise perfect record, the bay colt proved himself comfortable on dirt with a track-record setting performance at Nad al Sheba Mar. 2, getting 10 furlongs in a sprightly 1:59 3/5 in Round Three of the Maktoum Challenge. "Dubai Millennium is the best horse I have ever had anything to do with," stated Sheikh Mohammed, "I am not saying he will win, but he will give us a good run on Saturday." The five-horse American contingent, spearheaded by Behrens (Pleasant Colony) and Puerto Madero (Chi) (Gallantsky), is the main opposition to Godolphin's second-straight World Cup, won by Almutawakel (GB) last year. Behrens, fifth in the 1998 World Cup, ships in off a five-length romp in the GI Gulfstream Park H. a month ago. His tactical speed should serve him well over the atypical course. Public Purse (Private Account), a multiple graded stakes winner on the turf, makes his dirt debut for owner Juddmonte Farms. The six-year-old bay has been working strongly on the dirt. GI Super Derby winner Ecton Park (Forty Niner) had been less than impressive when third in each of his 2000 starts, but recorded the guickest time of 1:01 for a five-panel breeze at Nad al Sheba last Saturday.

#### **DERBY HOPES SPIRALING**

Morning-line favorite Archer City Slew (Slew City Slew), one of only two graded stakes winners in the field, travels outside of California for the first time. Winner of the GII San Vicente Feb. 5, the bay colt was a game second to War Chant in the GII San Rafael S. Mar. 4 at Santa Anita, his first start around two turns. Globalize (Summer Squall), hero of the GIII California Juvenile in his final start at two, finished fourth after a three-wide trip in the GIII El Camino Derby Mar. 11. He should secure a better trip from his rail post. Several lightly-raced colts will be venturing into stakes company for the first time, including Runspastum (Woodman), a 10-length allowance winner at Gulfstream Feb. 26. Rollin With Nolan (Summer Squall) is also making his stakes debut off an impressive allowance score. The chestnut colt defeated subsequent Tampa Bay Derby winner Wheelaway in a Gufstream allowance Feb. 19. He is trained by Nick Zito, who captured this event last year with Stephen Got Even. Nature (Valiant Nature), unbeaten in three starts at Turfway, will be seeking his first graded triumph. In his most recent outing, the bay colt made a five-wide move when capturing the Battaglia Memorial S. over this strip Mar. 11.

OMINOUS NEWS FOR SEATTLE SLEW Three Chimneys informed syndicate members and season holders of Seattle Slew (Bold Reasoning) that the 26-year-old stallion's fertility has been severely compromised, and that his breeding schedule will be significantly reduced. "While seven of the first nine mares checked were found to be pregnant, none of the next eight mares conceived," the memo stated. Seattle Slew, sire of such champions as A.P. Indy, Landaluce, and Slew O'Gold, has three-year-old filly Surfside currently pointing for the Kentucky Derby.

MALEK INJURED Seven-year-old Malek (Chi) (Mocito Guapo {Arg) injured a suspensory in his right fore and has been scratched from the Dubai World Cup. He will likely be retired. Second in the 1997 World Cup and winner of the 1998 GI Santa Anita H., Malek has earned \$2,382,468 for his connections.

#### EMIRATES DERBY PURSE UPPED FOR NEXT

YEAR The United Arab Emirates Derby, inaugurated this year with a \$500,000 purse, will have its purse boosted for 2001 to \$2 million, making it the richest Derby in the world. Conceived as a prep for the American and English classics, the nine-furlong event may draw a more cosmopolitan field for next year's running. "Our aim is to make the meeting better each year," said Sheikh Mohammed. "By increasing the prize-money for the Emirates Derby, we expect to have an even stronger field for the race in 2001."

#### WORLD-WIDE COVERAGE FOR DUBAI WORLD

CUP Today's Dubai World Cup meeting will have unprecedented coverage over Europe, with Germany, Italy, France and Britain showing the racing. While viewers will be able to watch the card in betting shops in Italy and Germany, France has dedicated coverage on their racing channel, 'Equidia', and the BBC is showing the G3 Dubai Duty Free and G1 Dubai World Cup live, as well as all other races, either live or as recordings.

Sagamix captured the 1998 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in just his fourth career start, but could only manage fourth in each of his 1999 outings. He now races under the Godolphin banner.

In Embraced, he has a quality filly with a future, hinted at by her place among the latest acceptors for the G1 Epsom Oaks. "She is in good form at the moment, but I've not asked her any questions so far and she won't be ready until early April," Fanshawe reports. "The family traits, seen in the sire, are that the progeny go in soft ground and I think she will too, but she's a good mover and not heavy-topped, so hopefully she might go on most. She is a scopey filly, and her entry in the G1 Epsom Oaks S. is a tentative one."
