MILLENNIUM MAGIC IN DUBAI WORLD CUP

They'll be talking about him a thousand years from now. Performing under the glare of the international spotlight, Dubai Millennium (GB) (Seeking the Gold) left racing fans around the globe gasping with an awesome six-length victory over Behrens (Pleasant Colony) in vesterday's G1 Dubai World Cup at Nad Al Sheba. "I saw the gap [back to the runner-up] and I nearly started crying," jockey Frankie Dettori said. "I heard the crowd clapping a furlong out, looked around and I couldn't believe how far ahead he was. He's unbelievable. I think he's the best horse I've ridden." The eye-catching bay got off to a flying start that found him right on the front end and he never stopped running, leaving the field far behind as he raced to his second consecutive track record. "The natural speed and talent he's got is frightening," Dettori said. "You can't stop him. He jumped [out of the gate] and ran and he didn't want to come back to me. He wanted to go and I didn't want to disappoint him." The four-year-old has now won eight of his nine career starts, all by daylight. After running a lackluster ninth as the lukewarm favorite in last year's G1 Epsom Derby, the Godolphin colorbearer won the July 18 G2 Prix Eugene Adam by three lengths, the Aug. 15 G1 Prix Jacques le Marois by 2 1/2 and the Sept. 26 G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. by six. He stepped onto to the dirt for the first time in the Listed Maktoum Challenge-Round 3 at Nad Al Sheba Mar. 2 and cruised to a 4 1/2length victory, setting a track record in the process, but broke that mark by one tick yesterday. Sheikh Mohammed, who changed his World Cup champion's name from Yaazer when he showed promise at two, told Racing Post, "He is the best horse I have ever seen or had anything to do with. He will now go for all the best races in Europe and North America in the Emirates World Racing Championship." Added Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford, "The Breeders' Cup Classic is obviously the ultimate goal and it looks like we'll start at Royal Ascot with the Prince of Wales's S." Behrens was clearly second best while no match for the winner. His trainer, Jim Bond, told Racing Post, "I would love to have a rematch in the Breeders' Cup. The Sheikh has got himself a great horse and I would love to meet him again at Churchill Downs. I'm up for the challenge." Corals is quoting Dubai Millennium at 6-1 to win the GI Breeders' Cup Classic in November. (World Cup chart, p2)

"GLOBAL" WARMING UP FOR DERBY

Catching a fast track for the first time this year, Globalize (Summer Squall) was overlooked at 11-1 in yesterday's GII Spiral S. at Turfway Park, but put himself into the Kentucky Derby picture with a game 1 1/2-length score over Elite Mercedes (Mercedes Won). Three-forfour as a two-year-old, the chestnut had beaten Spiral favorite Archer City Slew (Slew City Slew) by a nose when second in the '99 San Mateo S. and by 1 1/2 lengths in a Bay Meadows allowance next time out. But the colt had finished off the board in two of his three tries this year, sandwiching a win in the Feb. 12 Golden State Mile between a fifth in the Jan. 15 GIII Golden Gate Derby and a fourth in the Mar. 11 GIII El Camino Real Derby. An outsider on his first trip away from Northern California, he was sent right to the lead and dueled the crowd's 2-1 choice through a half in :45.83, dropped back a bit after six furlongs in 1:10.09, but came back at 'em in the final furlong to take over late in the lane and draw clear. Why did trainer Jerry Hollendorfer decide to leave home with his Derby hopeful? "I wanted to get the horse back on a fast track, and I also wanted to see if he could do the mile and an eighth, which is a critical distance for him to get right now," he said. And is he thinking about that first Saturday in May? "Every trainer's always thinking about it and I'm no different than anybody else," he admitted. "I'm going to take this horse back to California, though, and train him. I think that's a better plan instead of keeping him in Kentucky if we're going to consider the Derby--and I haven't decided that yet. But it's tempting." Hollendorfer added that, if his three-year-old does run for the roses, the Kentucky bred could have one more start before the big event. Archer City Slew tired to be seventh. "By the time we hit the top of the stretch, he was a little wobbly," jockey Garrett Gomez said. "It wasn't his best race, but it wasn't his worst, considering it was his first around two turns." Honest Lady remained perfect at seven furlongs with another late-running score. After the removal of blinkers for her last start, the GI Santa Monica H. Jan. 22, the homebred filly lagged behind the field before launching an explosive rally in the stretch for a one-length score. Favored to repeat, she settled into rhythm 10 lengths off the pace and circled the field five wide, closing stoutly up the middle of the track for a clear success. "We took the blinkers off her last time and it really helped her relax off the pace," said winning jockey Brice Blanc. "That was the plan today. She really ran huge, and I had full confidence in the stretch. She's a great filly and a pleasure to ride."

Rhythm Band started his career in the U.S., breaking his maiden for trainer Jim Bond at Belmont Park in October of 1998, then was sold to Sheikh Rashid bin Mohammed al Maktoum and headed to Europe. He started just once last year, winning a conditions event at Doncaster in July, and resurfaced after a 6 1/2-month layoff to be third over this track Feb. 3. He took the lead with a quarter mile to run in his latest attempt, a 1 1/16-mile test Mar. 5, but was caught in the final furlong and finished second. Rated behind a solid pace this time, the gray finished full of run to catch stablemate Easaar in the final strides.

The long-striding Big Jag has been known to have his problems handling turns, losing ground as he floats wide on his way to the stretch, but he found the straight six furlongs of this event right up his alley. The well-traveled veteran was third in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Gulfstream Park last November, third again in the Dec. 12 Hong Kong Sprint at Sha Tin and most recently second in the Jan. 29 GII Palos Verdes H. at Santa Anita. Closer to the pace than is usual as he raced with the pack on the inside, the dark bay gunned to the lead with a quarter mile to go and dashed away to a track record-setting victory.

China Visit had started just once before, cruising to an eight-length victory in an Aug. 14 maiden race going 6 1/2 furlongs at Deauville as the 4-5 favorite. The dark bay was overlooked at the windows by U.S. bettors, but caught all eyes at the finish, closing from fourth to defeat stablemate and Triple Crown nominee Bachir. "He is a very nice horse, a real man of a horse," jockey Richard Hills said. "He traveled good and then strode away. He is only going to improve and has a lot of class. There is everything to look forward to." The colt is not yet nominated to the GI Kentucky Derby, but owner Sheikh Mohammed said, "He may go to the Kentucky Derby, he may go for the [May 6 G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas at Newmarket]...the door is open." Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford commented, "He was so impressive when he won at Deauville last year, we knew he was a good horse." But he added, "If he was to go for the Kentucky Derby, the extra furlong would be a concern because his dam side is all speed." The Kentucky-bred last week was backed from 66-1 to 10-1 for the 2000 Guineas.

Conflict had failed to distinguish himself during his European campaign, winning once in two starts at two and managing just one conditions event win--and six off-the-board finishes--from seven tries last year. But he came into this race undefeated in Dubai this year and added his first stakes win to his resume, rallying to catch Godolphin's Iftitah in the last jump.
