SPANISH FERN WINS SANTA ANA

Spanish Fern (El Gran Senor), winner of last year's GI Yellow Ribbon S., outgunned her rivals in the stretch to take yesterday's GII Santa Ana H. at Santa Anita. The five-year-old mare, off since running second in the Jan. 17 GII San Gorgonio H., settled near the back of the pack early as stablemate **Zante (GB)** (Zafonic) set slow fractions. Four wide into the stretch, Spanish Fern collared the leaders in deep stretch and was drawing off at the wire. "I've always seen this mare run and I know she's the classiest one (trainer) Bobby (Frankel) has," said winning rider Victor Espinoza. "She's got a great trainer, too. I know they went too slow up front, but I didn't have to worry about that because I knew she was much the best. As soon as I got a chance to make a run, I said, 'This is it. It's over.' She just took off. She may not have had the best rider, but I had the best horse." **Virginie (Brz)** (Legal Case {Ire}), off since winning the GI Beverly Hills H. last July, finished strongly, but couldn't match the winner.

A TOUGH ACT TO FOLLOW

Brave Act (GB) (Persian Bold {Ire}) forged to the front in deep stretch to take yesterday's GIII Explosive Bid H. at Fair Grounds by 3/4 lengths. Fifth, beaten two lengths in this event a year ago, Brave Act put together a solid 1999 campaign, following his Explosive Bid performance with a victory in the GIII Inglewood H. Off the board in his next two engagements, the dark bay was third in the Oak Tree Breeders' Cup Mile and sixth in the Breeders' Cup Mile before stretching back out. Tenth at the stretch call of the 8 1/2-furlong GII Citation H., the six-year-old was up to win by a neck and most recently he was last of six into the final furlong of the nine-furlong GII San Gabriel H. before unleashing a rally to win by a head. Scratched from the Mar. 4 GII Arcadia H. when that event came off the turf, the Ron McAnally charge broke well under jockey Cash Asmussen, who was subbing for Dubai-delayed Alex Solis, and settled towards the rear as the front runners set good fractions for this turf. Sent seven wide for home, Brave Act stormed down the middle of the track to engage **Where's Taylor** (Absent Russian) inside the final eighth and inched away to the victory. "We expected a slower pace," McAnally said, "but he gets smarter as he gets older. He put himself in a position to win the race." Asmussen added, "He's a great horse with great acceleration. It was a big race for him today."

Biogio's Rose, never worse than second in seven starts over this track, opened the year with a fifth-place showing in the Jan. 15 GIII Affectionately H. before returning to the winner's circle with a 5 1/2-length score in a Feb. 9 allowance. The chestnut mare was coming off a 1 1/4-length victory in the Feb. 21 GIII Rare Treat H. Rated in fifth early, she circled the field and closed determinedly down the stretch to get up for a narrow win. "I didn't think we were going to get there at the top of the stretch," admitted trainer Bobby Ribaud. "They went a little slower up front than I had hoped, but I've got a lot of confidence in this mare." Ribaud is undecided about a next start for Biogio's Rose.

LAUREL WINTER MEET CONCLUDES Laurel concluded its Winter Meet yesterday with in-state handle down slightly from last year's figures. Total in-state handle for the 2000 winter meet was \$128,554,658--down 3.6 percent from the 1999 total of \$133,316,609. Track officials blamed the decline on poor weather and the closing of three off-track betting facilities. "We're very optimistic about how we've been doing under the circumstances with the poor weather early in the year," said Maryland Jockey Club Chief Operations Officer Jim Mango. "Once we got through the poor weather, our numbers have been rising. We have a lot of optimism for the Pimlico Spring Meet and for the remainder of the year." The meet's leading rider was Mark Johnston. Leading trainer honors went to Dale Capuano. Pimlico opens for racing on Wednesday.

DUBAI DELAY CAUSES JOCKEY SHUFFLING Several jockeys making the return trip from the Dubai World Cup were delayed, forcing rider changes in several stakes engagements yesterday. Jockey Alex Solis might have paid the highest price when his mount for the GIII Explosive Bid H. at the Fair Grounds, Brave Act, proved 3/4 lengths the best under replacement rider Cash Asmussen in the \$600,000 event. Corey Nakatani, who was to be aboard third-place finisher Chester House, was replaced in the saddle by local jockey Curt Bourque and Majorien, slated to be ridden by Kent Desormeaux, was instead ridden by Robby Albarado. On the West Coast, David Flores picked up the mount on GII Santa Ana runner-up Virginie when regular rider Laffit Pincay Jr. was delayed. Pincay arrived at Santa Anita at 3:50 p.m, but missed his required deadline to ride the race by three minutes.
