FEE BUZZES BY 'EM ALL IN CICADA

Finder's Fee (Storm Cat) led home a Storm Cat exacta, driving through an opening along the rail to best Apollo Cat (Storm Cat) in vesterday's GIII Cicada at Aqueduct. The winner of the Astoria S. in her third career start, the Phipps homebred scored her most important victory when she took last year's GI Matron. but was off the board in the GI Frizette and GII Demoiselle to close out the year. The dark bay made her return in the Mar. 10 Jeano S. at Gulfstream Park and ran on well late to secure the place spot. The odds-on favorite was settled in midpack by jockey Jerry Bailey, but trailed by no more than two lengths for the opening four furlongs. Turning for home, Bailey took advantage of some clear sailing along the rail and his filly responded to overtake Apollo Cat just inside the eighth pole and dug in gamely to prevail. Southern Sandra (Dixie Brass) finished with good energy to just miss the place spot. "The race set up pretty much as we figured," said Buzz Tenney, assistant trainer to Shug McGaughey. "There were a couple of fillies in front of her down the backstretch; that's the way she likes to run." The winner is likely to run next in the GIII Comely at Aqueduct Apr. 21 and then will be pointed towards the Triple Tiara at Belmont this summer, according to Tenney.

A LONGCHAMP POW-WOW

Indian Danehill (Danehill) makes his seasonal bow in this first European Group 2 race of the season after a highly creditable 1999. He won the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau at first asking last year, but ran his best races in defeat on his other three starts. Fifth in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas), he was third in the G1 Prix Jean Prat, both at Longchamp, and ended his season in June when second to Slickly (Fr) in the G1 Grand Prix de Paris at Saint-Cloud. He is certainly high class and can confidently be expected to give a bold showing. The globetrotting Barbola (Diesis (GB)) returns from a fruitless Singaporean foray where he finished ninth in the valuable Singapore Airlines International Cup. The five-year-old won the G3 Prix Exbury on his seasonal debut last year, defeating the likes of Borgia and Jim and Tonic and finished second in this event, 1 1/2 lengths behind Dark Moondancer. He falls a notch below top class, but is a consistent performer who will expose any fitness doubts of the likely favourite. Chelsea Manor (Grand Lodge) closed his sophomore campaign with a one-length success over Agol Lack (Gulch) in the G3 La Coupe de Maisons-Laffitte, but was a disappointing eighth in the G3 Prix Exbury at Saint-Cloud Mar. 11. The latter is lightly raced, with one victory from five career starts.

Commendable (Gone West), fourth in the GII San Felipe last out, worked five furlongs in 1:00 2/5 and is scheduled to run in Keeneland's GII Coolmore Lexington S. Apr. 22. The same race produced last year's Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner Charismatic. Gll Gotham S. winner Red Bullet (Unbridled) sprinted through four furlongs in :46 Friday morning and came out of the work in good order, according to trainer Joe Orseno. "He is feeling so good that I was thinking about sending him back to the track this morning," Orseno said. The drill, fastest of 34 at the distance went in fractions of :11 2/5 and :22 2/5, out five furlongs in :59. He remains on track for the GII Wood Memorial at Agueduct Apr. 15. Trainer John Kimmel could be represented by a pair of runners in the Wood. Kimmel confirmed yesterday that Country Only (Carson City), a disappointing ninth in the Louisiana Derby Mar. 12, will make his next start in the Wood. With jockey Herbie Castillo in the saddle, Country Only worked five furlongs over the Belmont training track in :59 3/5 yesterday. Tampa Bay Derby winner Wheelaway (Unbridled) worked five furlongs at Payson Park in 1:05 and is deemed a possibility for the Wood.

BEAUTIFUL PLEASURE TO APPLE BLOSSOM

Trainer John T. Ward has advised officials at Oaklawn Park that his 1999 champion older mare Beautiful Pleasure (Maudlin) will ship to Hot Springs this coming Wednesday for next Sunday's Gl Apple Blossom H., her first start since her Breeders' Cup Distaff triumph. Ward said, "I've seen the weights and our filly is giving up only three pounds to (GIII Oaklawn Breeders' Cup winner) Heritage of Gold (Gold Legend)." Beautiful Pleasure has been assigned 121 pounds for her seasonal debut while Heritage of Gold gets in at 118.

BROOKSIDE SOUTH SOLD Allen and Madeleine Paulson's Brookside Farms South has reportedly been sold to Middleburg, Virginia based Roy Lerman for \$4.1 million. Lerman, a Washington D.C. attorney, is also the owner of Lamb Holm Farm in Middleburg and plans to keep the Florida farm as a Thoroughbred operation. The farm was formerly known as Wooden Horse Farm and was purchased by the Paulsons in 1992.
