#### ON THE WARPATH AT LONGCHAMP

Indian Danehill (Ire) (Danehill) opened his 2000 campaign with a popular victory in yesterday's G2 Prix d'Harcourt at Longchamp. The colt was put through a light campaign of only four races last year, including a win in the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau and a fifth-place finish in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains. A close-up third in the G1 Prix Jean Prat, he closed out his season as a two-length runner-up to Slickly (Fr) in the G1 Grand Prix de Paris. Odds-on in his four-year-old debut, he was keen early, but Olivier Peslier soon had him settled and by halfway he was in a position to challenge the leader Agol Lack (Gulch). Making smooth headway, the Andre Fabre pupil was ridden with three furlongs remaining and hit the front 1 1/2 furlongs out. From there he was always holding the challenge of Chelsea Manor (GB) (Grand Lodge) on his outside and went away again before the line to win comfortably. Third-placed Barbola (Diesis {GB}) was trapped on the rail at the crucial point of the race and could be considered unlucky not to have finished closer. The owner of the winner, Baron Edouard de Rothschild, said, "Like many of Andre Fabre's horses, he had been hit by a virus last season. He proved today what a good horse he is and that he has lost none of his ability. The G1 Prix Ganay (Longchamp, Apr. 30) seems to be an obvious option for his next start." That event could certainly be a race to savour, as it is at this point the likely target of Montjeu (Ire).

#### SUCCESSFUL SURGERY FOR SLEW

Seattle Slew (Bold Reasoning) yesterday underwent successful surgery to fuse the joint between two vertebrae in his neck. The procedure was performed at Rood & Riddle Equine Hospital in Lexington by a veterinary team, headed by Dr. Barry Grant, which was flown in from the San Luis Rey Equine Hospital in California. "Placement went well and we were very happy with the post-operative films," Grant said. "The horse recovered well and got up like the great athlete that he is. Seattle Slew has made a lot of people look smart for many years, and he continues to do so." The 26-year-old stallion, a Triple Crown winner and champion sire, is expected to return to Three Chimneys Farm in Midway within several days, where he will stall rest for approximately 30 days, then have 30 days of hand-walking.

**Juvenile Champ Tops Santa Anita Derby Works:** 

Last year's champion two-year-old Anees (Unbridled) zipped six furlongs in a bullet 1:11 4/5 at Santa Anita yesterday morning, his final work for Saturday's GI Santa Anita Derby. The colt had his 2000 debut delayed by an abscessed foot, but came back to be third in the 1 1/16-mile GII San Felipe S. Mar. 19. He tries nine furlongs for the first time Saturday. "The longer distance in going to suit us," trainer Alex Hassinger said.

Surfside (Seattle Slew), who will take on the boys for the first time in Saturday's Grade I test, also breezed yesterday, going a half in :47 2/5. The filly took the GI Santa Anita Oaks last time out racing without Lasix, but will be back on the medication this time. Cocky (Valiant Nature), third in the GII San Rafael S. in his most recent try, went six furlongs in 1:15 4/5 at Hollwood Sunday.

#### Mighty Sharp in Churchill Slop:

Jetting through yet another solid workout as he gets ready for the Apr. 15 GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland, GII Louisiana Derby winner **Mighty** (Lord at War {Arg}) went five furlongs in 1:00 4/5 over a sloppy strip at Churchill Downs yesterday morning.

OAKS DAY MARCH MOVED UP? A "march of reconciliation and healing" in Louisville planned by civil rights leaders for Friday, May 5--Kentucky Oaks Day--may be moved up to Apr. 24, the Louisville Courier-Journal reports. The Reverend Jesse Jackson called for the march after spending two days in Louisville last week to look into an incident in the city where two white police officers fatally shot an African-American man who was attempting to escape arrest by fleeing in a stolen vehicle. Louisville Police Chief Gene Sherrard was subsequently fired, in part for approving medals of valor for the two officers, and his termination has caused tension between police and the community. But with more than 100,000 racing fans expected in town for the Oaks, city officials protested the timing of the march. Stephanie Gadlin, Jackson's national press spokeswoman, told the Courier-Journal that the march would be rescheduled because "local leadership in Louisville wanted [the date] changed." A final decision on a date for the march is expected today.

# "DARK HORSE" REPORT

The weekend saw some action amongst the dark horses to follow in four countries. In France on Saturday, the filly Indian Prospector (Fr) (Machiavellian {USA}) clearly didn't relish the very testing conditions in the Listed Prix Omnium at Saint-Cloud, where she finished fifth. She took a keen hold and pulled on the way down to the start and in the early stages of the race, which wouldn't have helped, and if she can learn to settle more she will hopefully show her quality later in the year. Similarly, the Irish colt Apollo Victoria (Fr) (Sadler's Wells {USA}) was just worried out of the closing stages of the Conditions race at Gowran Park on the same day, giving seven pounds to the winner. He will clearly come on a lot for the race, run on yielding ground. Yesterday, Polish Summer (GB) (Polish Precedent {USA}) contested the Prix de Ferrieres but could only finish a one-paced second to the impressive winner Hesiode (Fr) (Highest Honor {Fr}). The winner was more experienced, having already had three starts, so Polish Summer can be expected to improve. In Germany, Sinamix (Ger) (Linamix {Fr}) ran a good race to be a three-quarterof-a-length runner-up to Huambo (USA) in the Orakel der Dreijahrigen at Mulheim over a mile.

#### SUNLINE'S CONNECTIONS DRAW THE LINE

The connections of Sunline (NZ) (Desert Sun {GB}), who Saturday became the only mare since Emancipation (Aus) in 1984 to carry 132 pounds to victory in the G1 Coolmore Classic, yesterday reiterated the top mare will not run in the G1 Doncaster H. Apr. 22 if she receives a weight penalty for her latest score. Thoroughbred Racing Board chief handicapper Mark Webbey has until Friday to add to the 127 pounds Sunline already has for the Doncaster; she'll have to set a modern-day weight carrying record for a mare in the race at that impost. Webbey said, "When I framed the handicap I was very happy that Sunline's weight was fair. I've been mindful all along of the record of mares in the race, which is pretty ordinary. I've given her two kilograms above weight-for-age, but she has since taken herself to a level beyond champion mares like Emancipation."

#### KNOT INCHES EVER CLOSER TO OCTAGONAL

Tie The Knot (Aus) (Nassipour {USA}) brought his earnings to \$4.6 million with a ninth G1 win in the \$400,000 Ranvet S. (2000m) after racing forward, three from the lead on the fence, rather than dropping out last as usual. "He's just got better with age and it's certainly not going to stop here," said jockey Shane Dye. "I didn't go out there thinking I was going to trail the leader," Dye said. "But if you look at him after he's had a few runs he tends to get into his stride a bit quicker like he did in last year's Mercedes. I was always going to put him where he was comfortable. had to come back around their heels, I'm on a champion horse and he needs room to get home," he said. The win took his overall record to 15 wins and 14 placings from 42 starts. His future program, which includes the \$1 million Mercedes Classic (Apr. 15), a race he won last year, and the \$800,000 Sydney Cup (May 6), has the potential to catapult him in prize money terms close to Octagonal who is Australia's all time highest earner with \$5.8 million.

#### PLANS UNCHANGED FOR TESTA ROSSA

Dean Lawson will press on with a tilt at Saturday's G1 George Ryder S. with Testa Rossa (Aus) (Perugino {Ire}) although the colt was well-beaten odds on favourite in Saturday's G2 Phar Lap S. (1500m) won by Lord Essex (11-1). Testa Rossa was having his first run for a month after he suffered a slight virus which interrupted his Sydney campaign. "He was going to be vulnerable today but he needed the run before next week's George Ryder S.," Lawson said. "He got held up a bit and I think perhaps he would have run third if not for that. He is a great horse but until he proves himself against the likes of Sunline it is premature (to consider him favourite for horse of the year honours). He's beaten the best in Melbourne but the form up here is a lot stronger and the Sydney autumn carnival is the one that sorts out the best from the rest. I'm not unhappy with his run today and I'm confident he'll be better next week."
