#### ROYAL ANTHEM UP FOR SALE?

The Thoroughbred Corporation's Royal Anthem (Theatrical {Ire}--In Neon, by Ack Ack), second to Daylami (Ire) in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Gulfstream Park and the winner of the GI Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. in his only start this year, may be up for sale. The price tag for the five-year-old is reportedly over \$10 million. Trainer Bill Mott was pointing Royal Anthem towards the Mar. 25 \$2 million Dubai Sheema Classic when the bay was sidelined indefinitely with a tendon injury. According to Richard Mulhall, racing manager for The Thoroughbred Corporation, the stallion is being offered to selected individuals. "We've has some serious conversations," Mulhall said yesterday, although he wouldn't name any prospective buyers. When asked if a rumored sales price of \$6-\$7 million was correct, he said "No." When he was asked if it is in double digits he said, "Yes." Royal Anthem has won six of his 12 career starts, including the 1998 GI Canadian International at Woodbine and the 1999 G1 Juddmonte International at York. His career earnings total \$1,875,417.

#### DANSILI POWERS TO VICTORY

Dansili (Danehill) bided his time to the stretch, then motored away late to win the G3 Prix Edmond Blanc at Longchamp yesterday. Overmatched against a pair of miling giants last year in Sendawar (Ire) twice and Dubai Millennium (GB), the four-year-old was nevertheless a good runner-up in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains and third in the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp behind the former. Third behind the Godolphin horse in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois in August, he found some relief from those two in winning the G3 Prix Messidor at Deauville in July and here he looked a cut above his opponents on known form. Settled on the rail in second early behind Double Heart (Akarad {Fr}), jockey Olivier Peslier played a waiting game until after the final bend, at which point he started to ask questions of his mount. Although the favourite took a while to get into top gear, as soon as he was there he picked up and closed the gap between himself and the leader in a matter of strides. Inside the final furlong, it was a case of keeping Dansili up to his work to comfortably hold the late flourish of the runnerup. "He is more relaxed than last year," said Peslier of the winner. "He travelled very smoothly in second and quickened brilliantly when I asked him. He is also much stronger than last year."

#### Gran Premio Saturnino J Unzué cont.

The unbeaten Serenita captured the first Group 1 race for two-year-old fillies of the season. After breaking her maiden in the Especial Potrancas at San Isidro over five furlongs in January, she took the G2 Premio Carlos Casares over the Palermo dirt one month later. Making her third start, the bay filly took the lead soon after the start and never relinquished it, winning by five widening lengths in good time. Serenita is the 28th Group 1 winner to represent her sire Southern Halo, the leading stallion in Argentina for the last seven years. She is yet another Southern Halo runner to carry Buckpasser, in her case through Buckpasser's son Logical.

#### Nakatani To England?:

Racing Post is reporting that America's leading rider, Corey Nakatani, is considering riding in England later this year. While the 29-year-old jockey was in Dubai for the World Cup, he had conversations with trainers Clive Brittain and John Gosden about his options. It would not be Nakatani's first trans-Atlantic voyage, as he piloted Cool Jazz to win the 1995 G3 Diadem S. for Brittain, who told Racing Post, "Corey asked me if I could find him another Cool Jazz and I told him I would do my damnedest." Nakatani told Racing Post's Graham Green, "I have heard all about Royal Ascot and would love to check it out. I have spoken to John Gosden and Clive Brittain and told them I would be available for rides. I know there are a lot of great horses over in Britain and it would be terrific to ride at what everybody says is such a great meeting."

#### **Blue Grass Notes:**

The dead-heat winner of the GII Hutcheson, More Than Ready (Southern Halo) is acclimating nicely to his new, but familiar environs at Keeneland where he is set to contest the GI Blue Grass S. Apr. 15. "He's really been doing well. He's training very, very well," said trainer Todd Pletcher of the Louisiana Derby runner up. "He's really showing all the right signs right now. We just hope he can continue to get better and better." The Jim Scatuorchio owned charge broke his maiden over 4 1/2 furlongs last April at Keeneland. Dual Gulfstream allowance winner Bare Outline (Broad Brush) is on the fence for the \$750,000 event, according to conditioner Nick Zito. "I want to talk to (owner) Mr. (William) Condren and see what he thinks and discuss what he wants to do." Trainer Aidan O'Brien had toyed with the idea of sending G2 Gimcrack S. winner Mull of Kintyre (Danzig) for the Blue Grass, but those plans have changed. The \$1 million Keeneland July yearling, fourth in his main track debut in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile, is expected in this weekend's G2 Gladness S, at seven furlongs at The Curragh, Racing Post reports.

#### Surfside To Add Shades for Derby:

GI Santa Anita Oaks winner Surfside (Seattle Slew), who will take on the boys in Saturday's GI Santa Anita Derby, will be equipped with blinkers for the first time in her career. "It helps them focus," trainer D. Wayne Lukas told the Daily Racing Form. "I like to run some horses in blinkers and she's one I want to try. She's worn them for her last (several) works." The elegant bay worked well her last three times, including four furlongs Apr. 2 in :47 1/5.

#### Elite Mercedes to Hot Springs:

Elite Mercedes (Mercedes Won), a solid second behind Globalize in the GII Spiral S. Mar. 25, will run in the GII Arkansas Derby at Oaklawn Park Apr. 15. Walden has had his fair share of success prepping in Arkansas, having won the 1998 Rebel S. and Arkansas Derby with eventual Kentucky Derby second-place finisher Victory Gallop.

#### Fusaichi Safe and Sound in the Big Apple:

A most valuable flight touched down safely yesterday carrying \$4 million of racehorse in the form of GII San Felipe S. winner and likely GII Wood Memorial favorite Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr. Prospector). The colt, trained by Neil Drysdale, arrived without incident at Aqueduct at 4:30 p.m EST.
