## THE DEPUTY'S DERBY

Barber and Team Valor's **The Deputy (Ire)** (Petardia {GB}) stalked the pace and staved off a game **War Chant** (Danzig) to place himself squarely in the Kentucky Derby picture. After outbattling High Yield in the GII Santa Catalina in his dirt debut, the dark bay colt returned seven weeks later to run a game second to Fusaichi Pegasus in the GII San Felipe. Having worked a smart five furlongs in 1:00 1/5 Tuesday, the Irish-bred was sent off as the slight second choice to War Chant. Breaking alertly, he settled outside that rival as **Surfside** (Seattle Slew) set the pace and ranged up three wide on the far turn, gaining the lead at the top of the stretch. War Chant fought back bravely, but could not get by the winner. With her charge's score, Jenine Sahadi became the first woman to train a Santa Anita Derby winner. "I've never been so proud of a horse before," she exclaimed. "I just feel really lucky to have a horse like this." Hall of Fame rider Chris McCarron timed his move perfectly. "I felt I had every bit as much horse as Jerry [Bailey, aboard War Chant] did," he said. "War Chant and our horse had ideal trips. It was a matter of who was faster from the quarter pole to the wire." The Deputy will leave for Kentucky next week. The connections of War Chant, Captain Steve and Anees will also head for Louisville.

## AN AMERICAN AT AINTREE

Visiting Aintree for the very first time, Betty Moran watched as her 10-1 chance **Papillon (Ire)** (Lafontaine {USA}) showed true grit to prevail after a 4 1/2-mile slog over the 30 fences of the G1 Martell Grand National in Liverpool, England yesterday afternoon. "I feel just like I did on Belmont Day [1985], when my horse Creme Fraiche won, and I'm a bit pink in the cheeks from cheering," the mistress of America's Brushwood Stable said. "Last year I was nervous about running him because I didn't want anyone hurt, but I've thoroughly enjoyed my National experience. I was so nervous during the race as I just wanted [jockey Ruby Walsh] and the horse to come back okay. It's great for [trainer Ted Walsh] and Ruby." Ted Walsh, a former top amateur rider turned broadcaster-cum-journalist-cum-trainer, and his son Ruby gave Ireland its second straight victory in the Grand National. The Emerald Isle had to wait 25 years for success in steeplechasing's greatest race before the father-and-son team of Paul and Tommy Carberry were victorious with **Bobbyjo (Ire)** (Bustino {Ire}) last year, but Papillon added another Irish win hot on the heels of the last. For the first time since 1992, a maximum field of 40 lined up at the start. Taking the brave inside route throughout, Papillon was always well placed in the front rank and outbattled **Mely Moss (Fr)** (Tip Moss {Fr}) on the run-in to lead home the 17 finishers. Ironically, the nine-year-old had finished second to 1999 winner Bobbyjo in a thrilling finish to the 1998 Irish Grand National at Fairyhouse. As Papillon was led in to the winner's enclosure, to the chorus of a Celtic Ole Ole Ole, an overcome Ted Walsh declared: "It is a wonderful feeling. We have had him (Papillon) since he was a five-year-old and he jumped super today; Ruby gave him a lovely ride. I'm proud of the horse, I'm proud of the whole family and I'm proud of [Ruby]. It's a grand day to be alive. I've been a very lucky person in racing, I've had many good days and this is one of the best of them." An enthusiastic Ruby Walsh added: "That was unbelievable. He jumped from fence to fence and made just the one mistake. I've had a bad year, I broke my leg and have missed eight months of the season. This makes up for it, this is great." The favorite, 9-1 **Dark Stranger (Fr)**, fell at the third fence, while last year's hero Bobbyjo finished 11th. None of the horses which fell suffered serious injury.

K One King, purchased privately after a runaway  
 victory in the John Battaglia Memorial S. at Turfway last  
 March, finished second in the GII GalleryFurniture.com  
 S. at Turfway and eighth in the GI Kentucky Derby  
 before being laid off for ten months with chips in his  
 knee. He came back at Gulfstream Park Feb. 24 with a  
 3 3/4-length allowance win to prepare for this event.  
 After stumbling at the start, the 6-1 shot raced last of  
 six for the first six furlongs, made a sweeping move five  
 wide on the far turn and rolled home to a 1 3/4 length  
 score. Trainer Akiko Gothard said, "I was very confi-  
 dent, although (6-5 favorite) Budroyale scared me. We  
 missed a race in Florida with him, but we came on to  
 Oaklawn anyway." Gothard's fear of Budroyale (Cee's  
 Tizzy) was unnecessary, as the favorite didn't really  
 ever get into the race. Trainer Ted West said, "I don't  
 want to say something against the track, but our horse  
 just didn't handle it. He never picked up the bit today."

Rings A Chime left the friendly environs of California  
 and became a Grade I winner. Having taken the Bay  
 Meadows Lassie at two, the dark bay filly found  
 Surfside a bit tough for her at Santa Anita, finishing  
 third in the GI Las Virgenes in February before getting  
 trapped on the rail when fourth in the GI Santa Anita  
 Oaks Mar. 12. Drifting out slightly and bumping with  
 favored Deed I Do (Alydeed), the Washington-bred miss  
 showed the way through fair fractions and gave the  
 field the slip on the far turn, entering the stretch with a  
 three-length lead. She needed every bit of that advan-  
 tage to hold off the onrushing Zoftig, who rallied five  
 wide off the turn. "I just let her do her thing and run  
 on," said winning jockey Shane Sellers. "She made a  
 nice, easy lead and she just settled into a nice run."  
 Rings A Chime will most likely head next to the Twin  
 Spires. "She's nominated for the [Kentucky] Oaks (May  
 5)," remarked trainer Lonnie Arterburn. "We've had a  
 game plan all along and I guess that we'll be looking to  
 go in that direction." Favored Deed I Do tired in the  
 stretch, while second-choice Cash Run (Seeking the  
 Gold) failed to be a factor after going six wide into the  
 first turn.

**George Ryder S.-G1 result cont.**

As the crowd chanted in vain for Testa Rossa (Aus) (Perugino), young trainer John Size claimed his first Group 1 win with outsider Al Mansour in this event. The five-year-old won the G1 Castlemaine S. in Brisbane at two, but endured a frustrating 24-race losing streak--although with seven stakes placings--over the past two years before yesterday's overdue victory. "He's very game and to fight on the way he did was just fantastic. He's really deserved this," Size said. But the connections of Testa Rossa appear to be leaning toward retiring the four-time Group 1 winner to stud this season. Trainer Dean Lawson said the colt would undergo a thorough veterinary check after his second lacklustre effort to finish second last. Heavily backed as the 7-4 favourite, he settled just off the speed, but when Damien Oliver asked him to quicken after turning for home, he faded out of the picture. "He is 10 lengths below his best; there is definitely something not right," said Oliver. "That was the worst run of his life." Lawson was hoping Testa Rossa, whose campaign was interrupted by a virus, would rebound after finishing unplaced in the Phar Lap S. last week. "He raced like an ordinary horse and he is not an ordinary horse," he said. "Whether the virus took more out of him than I thought, I'm just not sure. We'll take him straight back to Melbourne and give him a good looking over. He's too valuable to keep him going if he's obviously not at his top, so going to stud is a genuine option." Testa Rossa has 10 wins from 17 starts and more than A\$2.3 million. There was a protest by the rider of Hire against Bonanova for alleged interference over the last 100 metres, but it was dismissed.

Kona Gold, who finished second in last year's Breeders' Cup Sprint, came back to win the GII Palos Verdes H. at Santa Anita Jan. 29, then finished second by a nose to stablemate Son of a Pistol in the GII San Carlos H. Mar. 4. Lexicon opened a clear lead and looked to be going easily down the backstretch and into the turn, but Alex Solis had the favorite breathing down the leader's neck. About halfway around the turn, Solis asked for more and his mount responded with vigor, firing through along the rail and putting away Lexicon in an instant. From there, he was ridden home to an easy victory. "My horse just went on, and it was over," said winning jockey Alex Solis. "I believe Kona Gold is twice as good now as he was a year ago, and he's really getting tougher and tougher."

The colt will make his next start at Churchill Downs on the first Saturday in May. "Trippi will leave in the morning for Kentucky," Cot Campbell, president of Dogwood Stable, said after the race. "We have the Derby on our minds."

A winner of a Gulfstream allowance two back and second behind Dancing Guy in the GIII Creme Fraiche H. at Gulfstream Mar. 11, Yankee Victor came into this looking for his first graded victory. The controlling speed in the race, Yankee Victor broke on top, shrugged off Western Expression (Gone West) after six furlongs and was well clear in midstretch so as not to be challenged by the late run of Golden Missile. "He's a horse that has a lot of speed to begin with," said trainer Carlos Morales. "So, with the wind in his favor and the track playing toward speed, that helped his chances even more. Falcon Flight unleashed a powerful late burst to nip Bonapartiste at the wire.
