#### **UNYIELDING IN BLUE GRASS**

High Yield (Storm Cat) couldn't get past Hal's Hope (Jolie's Halo) in the GI Florida Derby, but he wasn't about to let yesterday's GI Toyota Blue Grass get away. Dogged by his Florida Derby nemesis as he set a lively pace from along a golden rail at Keeneland, he left that one behind after six furlongs, then outgamed 9-2 More Than Ready (Southern Halo) down the lane to win it by head. "High Yield took control going into the [first] turn and I was able to secure room down inside," jockey Pat Day said. "He was very relaxed at that point...then turning for home he fought back very gamely. It was a heroic effort." The chestnut runs for the partnership of two-time Kentucky Derby winners Bob and Beverly Lewis, one-time winner Michael Tabor and for Mrs. John Magnier, and he will make his next appearance at Churchill Downs. "We're going to go over there with great optimism," trainer D. Wayne Lukas said. "But we know it's going to be a tough year--there's just so many good three-year-olds out there." More Than Ready is one of them. Making only his second two-turn attempt, he sat third until they hit the stretch and gave High Yield everything he could handle in the final furlong. #### WINGING TO VICTORY IN THE WOOD

He's no myth. Sent off the 9-10 choice in yesterday's GII Wood Memorial at Aqueduct, Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr. Prospector) soared past 3-1 Red Bullet (Unbridled) in the stretch to win by a widening 4 1/4 lengths. "He was very fluid all the way around," said jockey Kent Desormeaux, who rated the colt in third through six furlongs in 1:10 2/5 before pulling the trigger. "On the turn, he just reached forward and went after the targets. At that point, I was really confident...he did everything I asked in fine fashion." The \$4 million baby, who beat GI Santa Anita Derby hero The Deputy (Ire) in the Mar. 19 GII San Felipe S., has now put together a fourrace winning streak and is sure to be the choice to make it five in a row in the May 6 GI Kentucky Derby. "He's certainly got a world of talent," Desormeaux, who won the 1998 Derby aboard Real Quiet, said. "The only question now is can he get the mile and a quarter. I think so, but it's a question we'll have to answer on the first Saturday in May." The only difficulties Fusaichi Pegasus faced yesterday were when he got a little balky going to the gate and then wending his way back to the winner's circle. "He's got a bit of a mind of his own and he loves to look and stare at things," trainer Neil Drvsdale explained. "He should have gone with his own pony. Next race, we'll send him with the pony he's accustomed to. He doesn't get excited--he just gets to looking around. It's like he's saying, 'I'll come when I'm ready." Previously undefeated Red Bullet, winner of the GIII Gotham S. last out, stalked the pace set by 18-1 Country Only (Carson City), got to the lead as they raced into the stretch and continued on well to hold second. Trainer Joe Orseno said, "He was up closer than I would have preferred him to be, but that really was no one's fault. If [Alex Solis] had taken him back, he most probably would have gotten into traffic trouble. It was his first time around two turns and I didn't want to cause too many problems for him. Will he move up from this race? I think he will, but the question is, how much? The winner ran a very big race." Aptitude (A.P. Indy), second in the Gotham, closed well to be third. "He was a little fussy in the gate--we'll have to work on that," trainer Bobby Frankel said. "Otherwise, he ran a good race. We'll ship to Kentucky on Monday and go from there." #### ON TO THE DERBY FOR BLUE GRASS

RUNNERS "My horse ran as good as anyone could run against the grain of the track," trainer Todd Pletcher, a former D. Wayne Lukas assistant, said of his Blue Grass runner-up More Than Ready. "If we could have switched post positions with High Yield, we would have won today." Trainer John Kimmel was also pleased with his third-place finisher, the lightly raced Tampa Bay Derby winner Wheelaway (Unbridled). "He really ran a huge race, especially when you consider that the track was playing to all the speed," Kimmel said. "I think this horse really proved himself today to be a legitimate contender. I think my horse ran his way into contention, but we might not have the earnings to get into the Derby. I think we have the horse, but we may not qualify and that would be a shame." GII Louisiana Derby winner Mighty (Lord At War {Arg}) bumped the side of the gate at the break and never got into the hunt, finishing seventh as the 2-1 second choice. "He didn't really care for the racetrack," jockey Shane Sellers said. "He didn't move like he did at the Fair Grounds or at Churchill. The main thing is that, mentally, he is good. We'll go on to the next city and see what happens." GI Florida Derby hero Hal's Hope tired after pressing the pace and ended up eighth and last. "I don't know why he ran the race he did today," owner/breeder/trainer Harold Rose said. "I'll have to make up my mind about going [to the Derby]. I'll throw this race out if I go." Jockey Roger Velez added, "He pulled up OK. He kind of propped on the first turn at the sight of a camera--he's never done that before. We'll just have to go back to the drawing board."

GREENHAM S. RESCHEDULED Following yester-day's abandonment of Britain's Newbury meeting, it was announced that Newmarket racecourse has rescheduled the G3 Lane's End Greenham S. as the first race on the Tuesday card next week. The race has been re-opened, giving trainers a choice of the traditional 2000 Guineas trials. The delay also will allow connections of Distant Music (Distant View) to go in the event race, which was their initial target before the heavy rains came. The G3 Watership Down Stud John Porter S., also lost yesterday, will be run at Haydock Saturday.

Belle De Jour has overcome grave obstacles before, such as the career-threatening gash in her tendon she suffered soon after being purchased as a yearling for A\$200,000. Another setback occurred at the start of vesterday's Golden Slipper, when she almost fell and spotted the field four lengths. However, under a masterful ride by Lenny Beasley, the remarkable filly weaved her way through traffic and got up late to win the race by a half head. Part-owner John Singleton offered the 23,000 racegoers free beer for the remainder of the afternoon in the wake of the win. "I was so disappointed when she stumbled, I thought I had lost all chance, "said jockey Len Beasley. "I almost fell off." Trainer Clarry Conners showered bystanders with champagne. "She's a freak--this just doesn't happen. I pulled my hair out when she missed the start, I just couldn't believe it. You just can't believe a horse can win like that. I sold out, I'm a realist, but what a super, super filly," he told the Australian Associated Press. The win gave Conners his fourth victory in the world's richest race for juveniles.

Endearing stayer Tie The Knot snared his 10th Group 1 win and became the third highest Australasian stakes earner with his second consecutive Mercedes Classic score. The favorite appeared to be blocked as place getters Arena and Showella fought out the finish. But Shane Dye, collecting his fifth Mercedes trophy, urged the gallant gelding through a momentary gap on the fence and the lengthy chestnut exploded to win by a long neck. "I went to come out and I changed my mind and that is what won me the race," Dye said. "He is such a big bulldog of a horse, he really wants to win."

Backed in from 10-9 to 9-10 favouritism, Hill Of Grace was always up near the lead and held on to win by three-quarters of a length over the fast-finishing 150-1 outsider Kirkstall Lane. Trainer Robert Priscott said Hill Of Grace would not start in the AJC Australian Derby next week, but would be saved for the Oaks a week later. "The owner Terry Jarvis had thought about the Derby," Priscott said, "but we've decided to run her in the Oaks against the fillies. There's a lot of improvement left in her and the two-week break is a better option." The winner of the Mar. 25 G2 Moonee Valley Oaks, she takes her record to four wins from just eight starts and gives supersire Zabeel yet another individual Group 1 winner.

Graeme Hall secured the lead heading into the first turn and was never seriously threatened while giving trainer Todd Pletcher a one-three finish in this Kentucky Derby prep. Multiple graded-stakes placed at two, he finished 12th in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, a race which marked the only unplaced effort his career. The consistent colt opened his sophomore season with an allowance score sprinting at Gulfstream before finishing a game second in the Mar. 25 Rushaway S. to Ronton (Cryptoclearance) last time out. The longshot settled in front on a long rein for jockey Robby Albarado, getting a half in :46 4/5. He gave the field the slip approaching the stretch and drew clear in the final furlong. "I didn't have to do much to get in front going into the first turn and after that he relaxed completely," said Albarado. "We really didn't feel any pressure down the backside...he was really strong through the stretch run." The winner will join barnmate More Than Ready at Churchill Downs, but will need a new pilot as Albarado is booked on Captain Steve. Favored Snuck In held on for second. "He leaves for Kentucky in the morning," said trainer Steve Asmussen. "The Kentucky Derby is a possibility, but so is the Illinois Derby (May 13)." Second choice Elite Mercedes (Mercedes Won) loomed at the top of the stretch, but failed to sustain his bid and was fourth.

Third in last year's GII Cowdin S., Precise End had not been out since leading every step en route to a one-length win in the Display S. at Woodbine Nov. 14. Sent right to the lead by jockey Jorge Chavez, the dark bay had opened up by seven lengths by the time they hit the top of the stretch and cruised home to an impressive victory--not bad for a colt who only narrowly survived an accident as a yearling. "I was away in Ocala in May of his yearling year and I got a call at 5 a.m. that they would have to put the horse down," trainer Mark Casse revealed. "He had cut his leg real bad. But I went there and said, 'Let's try and stitch it up,' and it healed well." The Florida bred now points for the May 6 GIII Withers S. at Belmont Park.

Off alertly from the rail, he stalked Kelly Kip to the stretch, came wide for the drive and narrowly prevailed. "My horse wasn't comfortable running on the inside," said winning jockey Shaun Bridgmohan. "As soon as I took him outside, he jumped in the bridle and took off. Kelly Kip had a lot of fight in him, but my horse was double game."

He's certainly justified a run in the 2000 Guineas, and I don't know whether he'll win it but he'd have a chance."
