DIN'S A SAN FRANCISCO TREAT

Unable to recreate the form which had him as one of the top turf three-year-olds in 1998, Ladies Din (Din's Dancer) was winless, though competitive in seven starts last year, missing by a nose in the Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile and a neck in the GI Eddie Read H. Fourth in the GII San Gabriel H. to begin the new year, the bay came into this race with only five weeks of rest off his fifth-place finish in the Mar. 25 G3 Dubai Duty Free on the World Cup undercard. Spitting directly in the face of the conventional wisdom that the trip to the Middle East knocks horses out for a long time, 'Din' was made the 2-1 favorite. Settled in the back of the pack early on behind a sluggish pace, he was shifted to the outside down the backstretch, responded when called up with a quick burst of speed to take the lead four wide entering the stretch and fought off all challengers late to win by a head. "When he got off the plane from Dubai, he acted like a three-year-old," commented winning trainer Julio Canani. "I told the owners you may think I am crazy, but I'm going to run him right back." Jockey Kent Desormeaux added, "This guy can give anyone hell going a mile. This horse doesn't like to lose. There's no doubt about that." The winner will try to improve on last year's result when he contests this year's GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile at Hollywood June 18.

GANAY DRAWS COMPETITIVE QUARTET

A disappointingly low turnout fro France's first Group 1 of the season, but all four runners are worthy contenders. Indian Danehill (Danehill) confirmed the promise of last year by winning the G2 Prix d'Harcourt at this track Apr. 2 in good style and will be strongly fancied to follow up for his first Group 1 win. The globetrotting Kabool (Groom Dancer) has not won since taking the G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano at Deauville in 1998, but has run consistently in defeat in eight group races since. He will be Godolphin's first runner in Europe this year. Chelsea Manor (Grand Lodge) finished second to Indian Danehill in the Prix d'Harcourt and the placings should be confirmed. One-time G1 Epsom Derby favourite Greek Dance (Sadler's Wells) will get his favoured cut in the ground, but will need his best to be successful.

GUINEAS DOUBLE DIP AT ROME

For the first time, both Italian Guineas are run on the same day and the first leg of the Classic double, the 1000 Guineas, sees a particularly strong challenge from Britain. John Dunlop, no stranger to winning top Italian races, is represented by the smart Eurolink Raindance (Alzao) who confirmed she had progressed from two to three when finishing third to Cape Town in the Listed European Free Handicap at Newmarket Apr. 20. She was giving weight away to some well regarded individuals that day and will be in top shape to justify likely favouritism here. Clive Brittain has always held Crimplene (Lion Cavern) in the highest regard and it is interesting that she lines up for this rather than the G1 English version. Queen's Bench (Wolfhound) will be an interesting outsider and has won two of her four starts to date. The home defence is headed by the classy G3 Premio Dormellowinner Sonda (Dolphin Street {Fr}). She has run just the once this year, winning the Listed Premio Torricola at Rome Apr. 2. (Previews cont. p7)

All-Aged S. cont.

Sunline avenged her Doncaster defeat last week when she returned to weight-for-age and sprinted several lengths ahead of her rivals in the straight to make the All-Aged S. her fifth Group 1 win, bringing her earnings to A\$4,701,166. Challenged early for the lead, Sunline relaxed outside Georgie Boy before sprinting at the top of the straight to win as the odds-on choice. "Sydney has taken her to their hearts, it's a great honour," said co-trainer Steve McKee said after the Randwick victory. He said the plan was for Sunline to head back to New Zealand on Tuesday and she would not start in next Saturday's \$750,000 Group 1 Queen Elizabeth S. (2000m). "Usually we stick pretty much to the program and that was to go home on Tuesday," McKee said, adding that his father, part-owner of the mare, may issue new instructions. Eight-time G1 winner Intergaze (Integra {Aus}) settled last and, despite making a short-lived move at the top of the straight, languished 12 lengths last. "I'm bewildered," said trainer Rod Craig. "He'll have a full veterinary check this week to decide whether we push on to the Queen Elizabeth. If I'm not happy, I'll pull the plug altogether," Craig said.

Gai Waterhouse declared tough gelding Assertive Lad would back up in next week's G1 Champagne S. at Randwick after the gallant chestnut made up for his last start when third behind Belle du Jour (Dehere) in the Golden Slipper with an impressive win here. Assertive Lad pounced on the leaders and staged a duel with a tiring Belle du Jour approaching the post, before notching a head win from fast-finishing Reenact with early leader Surfboard a further two lengths away third. "He's such an athletic good horse and as far as the mile (1600m) goes next Saturday, he'll run 2000 metres on his ear," she said. "He's certainly the best male two-year-old in Australasia. He showed that today," Waterhouse said. "There is little between he and Belle du Jour. The filly gets weight off Assertive Lad and on level weights it might be a different story, but you've got to respect Belle du Jour, she's very good." Assertive Lad beat Belle du Jour in the Magic Millions in January before finishing third to the filly in her memorable Golden Slipper win on April 15.

Take Note Of Me prospered, as usual, at his New Orleans base this past winter, scoring a 3 3/4-length victory in the Tenacious H. before losing the Louisiana H. by a neck. Last of five in the sloppy Diplomat Way H., the gelding won the Whirlaway H. Feb. 13 prior to a bang-up, one-length second at 30-1 in the Mar. 12 GIII New Orleans H. The chestnut shipped over from Arlington to show good zip in a local morning trial Apr. 16 and ran to that drill, teaming up with Glacial to dispute the early pace. The six-year-old advanced on the final turn, overtook Glacial in upper stretch and strided away to his first graded-stakes success. Nite Dreamer raced forwardly and closed for third. "This is no one-dimensional horse," commented winning jockey Robbie Albarado. "He's the kind of horse who, if he could talk would say 'Where are they at? Bring 'em on.' He'll fight with the best of them every step of the way." The winner could go next in the GII Washington Park H. at Arlington July 22.

Lager was claimed by his current owners for \$45,000 out of a winning effort at Monmouth Park in September of 1998, but was not able to win again until dropped in for a \$25,000 tag at The Meadowlands last Oct. 1. Switched to the barn of Jimmy Jerkens, the gelding scored for a \$35,000 sticker Mar. 12, was second in starter allowance company two back before scoring impressively last out by three lengths going 11 panels Apr. 6. Lager was rated towards the back of the pack in the early stages as the field was guided through slow fractions. Jockey Alex Solis aboard favored Chester House made an early move leaving the half-mile pole to assume command, but was joined at the head of the lane by Lager and Best of Luck, who raced closer than is his custom to the slow pace. Chester House began to fade while the latter two fought it out to the line, with Lager getting the photo. Best of Luck was vanned off after the race with a medial left-front sesamoid injury, according to veterinarian Neil Cleary. Of the winner, trainer Jimmy Jerkens said, "He's really turned into a top horse over the last few weeks. He just keeps getting better with each race."

The traditional opening-day feature at Churchill Downs was supposed to be a tour de force for Caller One (Phone Trick), who had won his last two starts by a combined 14 lengths. Instead, it was a breakout performance for The Thoroughbred Corp.'s Performing Magic, a horse who's form perked up when he was moved to the main track in the GIII Baldwin S. at Santa Anita two starts back.
