INDIAN TAKES GANAY; SALE RUMOURED

Having at last begun to fulfill his true potential, Indian Danehill (Danehill) followed his win in the G2 Prix d'Harcourt at Longchamp Apr. 2, where he was a comfortable winner over Chelsea Manor (Grand Lodge) with his first Group 1 win in yesterday's Prix Ganay at Longchamp in even more convincing fashion, running out an impressive winner. There was a strong racecourse rumour beforehand that the Irish National Stud had purchased a half-interest in Indian Danehill in the days leading up to the race, and confirmation of those reports are pending. He was settled in third initially, ahead of Greek Dance as Kabool (Groom Dancer) led at a steady pace from Chelsea Manor, but was relegated to last place when Greek Dance (Sadler's Wells) pulled his way into second at halfway. The order remained the same as the field swung into the straight and it was Olivier Peslier aboard Indian Danehill who was first to get after his mount. The four runners were almost line abreast entering the final furlong where Greek Dance briefly held the lead with Chelsea Manor travelling best of all. Indian Danehill got into top gear on the outside and his relentless momentum carried into the lead with 150 yards as he drew clear in the closing stages to record an impressive win. Greek Dance, perhaps inconvenienced by the trip, stayed on at the same pace to safely hold second and Chelsea Manor moved into third inside the final furlong as Kabool faded to be fourth. Winning owner Edouard de Rothschild said, "We have always thought a lot of this horse and that is why we did not hesitate to supplement him for the (G1) Dewhurst S. as a two-year-old. For various reasons he didn't run his race that day but he has made up for lost time since. A few years ago, in similar conditions, his full-brother, Indian Jones, broke his leg as he was about to win the G1 Grand Criterium. It has taken some time, but we have left that behind us now and Indian Danehill has avenged his brother today. As far is the future is concerned, he will not go to the G1 Coronation Cup (at Epsom) or the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup (at The Curragh), but will probably go for the G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp May 21.

ITALIAN GUINEAS SURPRISE FROM XUA

Owing much to a very powerful ride from Max Tellini, Xua (Ire) (Fairy King) gained her first stakes victory in yesterday's Italian 1000 Guineas in Rome. Second in the Listed Premio Novella at Milan Sept. 12 and third in the G3 Premio Dormello at Milan Oct. 10 as a juvenile, she showed her readiness with a win in a conditions event here Mar. 24. Tellini settled Xua in midfield alongside Timi (GB) (Alzao) as Masaniella (Ity) (Masad {Ire}) set a good pace, with English raiders Eurolink Raindance (Ire) (Alzao) and Crimplene (Ire) (Lion Cavern) close behind. On the turn, Crimplene and Timi were switched to the wide outside and this pair were soon clear of the field and looked to have the race between them. Xua, who had been under pressure early in the straight, was switched even wider than the two leaders and, once in the clear, sprouted wings and flew home for what had looked an improbable victory.

TDN Dark Horse Davide Umbro, the top-priced yearling at the ANAC yearling sales in 1998, sprang an 86-1 surprise here, but won deservedly in impressive style in conditions he relishes, giving his young Rome-based trainer Emanuele Russo only his second Group race victory. His chances were not advertised, however, with two poor efforts previously this season, including a lowly finish in the Listed Premio Daumier here Apr. 9. Dauno (Ity) (Mukaddamah) set a fast pace, followed by In The Wait (GB) (Midyan), with Davide Umbro racing in midfield. Around the turn, the whole field spread across the track, but with two furlongs to run Davide Umbro quickened brilliantly on the wide outside and went clear to score by a clear margin, with Golden Indigo staying on strongly for second. Davide Umbro now looks set for the G1 Derby Italiano here May 28.

Having broken her maiden at the second attempt over nine furlongs at Maisons-Laffitte last November, America was put away for the winter. She reappeared at Longchamp to easily win a 10-furlong conditions event Apr. 2. She was made favourite for this and, with the aid of a pacemaker, won her first Group race in authoritative manner. Hannabarbera (Fr) (Darshaan {GB}) went straight to the lead followed at a respectable distance by stable companion America with Hidalguia settled well in third. Hannabarbera's pacemaking duties were soon to finish when America swept into the lead approaching the final furlong and scurried away to a winning lead at that point as Hidalguia went in vain pursuit. Surrendering her hitherto unbeaten record, Hidalguia couldn't catch the impressive America and had to settle for a respectable second. Beyond The Waves ran on well to finish a safe third without managing to mount a serious challenge to the front two. Winning trainer Criquette Head explained, "She is a very light filly and you can't abuse her, so she will go straight for the G1 Prix de Diane (French Oaks) at Chantilly June 11."

Having raced over inadequate trips on his two starts this year, Amilynx returned to the form of his win in last season's G1 Prix Royal Oak with a commanding display of stamina. This season he had previously run with distinction in both the G3 Prix Exbury at Saint-Cloud Mar. 11, and the G3 Sheema Classic at Nad Al Sheba Mar. 25. The field raced in single file headed by Vertimi (Green Dancer), acting as pacemaker, as the 6-5 favourite Tajoun (General Holme) settled towards the rear. Magnus led into the straight, as Vertimi dropped away, but was challenged at the two pole by Amilynx who had made stealthy progress from the home turn. Amilynx swept to the front approaching the final furlong and drew progressively clear for an easy win. Katun, reproducing his finest form, kept on resolutely in the closing stages to take second from the brave Magnus as the line approached. Neither had an answer to the winner's finishing burst but were safely clear of a disappointing Tajoun. Roland de Longevialle, racing manager to the winning owner, said, "Providing that the ground is soft, Amilynx is almost unbeatable at this level. He might have a tilt at the G1 Ascot Gold Cup (Ascot, June 22) if the ground conditions are suitable." Alain de Royer Dupre merely reported, "Tajoun was on an off day."

Dansili, rated below only Sendawar in France's mile division last year, easily landed the odds when giving weight to both Iridanos and Double Heart in the G3 Prix Edmond Blanc over course and distance Apr. 5. He can confidently be expected to confirm that form now that he is four pounds better off with both rivals and will start as favourite. Kingsalsa, third in last year's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas) and fifth in the G1 Grand Prix de Paris, won on his return in a minor event at Complegne before finishing a fine third in the G3 Dubai Duty Free at Nad Al Sheba. He has a good chance to give his stable the exacta. Jashin, the German-trained challenger, looks to be thrown in at the deep end and will attempt to at least pay for his cross border journey.

X-RAYS NEGATIVE FOR BEST OF LUCK An initial set of X-rays on Best of Luck (Broad Brush)'s left front leg, taken late Saturday after he was vanned off the track after a second-place finish in the GIII Excelsior Breeders' Cup H. at Aqueduct, revealed no fracture to a medial sesamoid. "The first set of X-rays didn't show anything," said trainer Allen Jerkens, whose four-year-old colt was placed in a splint while he was still on the racetrack. "It's just swollen right now. He's got pressure bandages on and he's standing in his stall okay. They're going to take another set of X-rays (Sunday)." The Bohemia Stables runner has four wins from 23 starts, including victories in last year's GII Peter Pan S. and GIII Stuyvesant H.

DERBY WORKS ABOUND Kentucky Derby favorite Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr. Prospector) turned in his final Kentucky Derby work yesterday morning, breezing six furlongs in 1:14 3/5, galloping out the seven furlongs in 1:27. "He wasn't given his head until about 100 yards from the finish," said trainer Neil Drysdale. "His last quarter was :23 and change and then he galloped out another eighth in :12 and change. I'm very satisfied. He went well. It was exactly what we asked for; it was his standard work." The colt, who has become known for his on-track hijinks, "behaved well (yesterday) morning," continued Drysdale. "He played around a little bit with a few bucks." Drysdale's other Derby hopeful, War Chant (Danzig), is scheduled to work six furlongs this morning. Trainer D. Wayne Lukas sent his three Kentucky Derby hopefuls out for works early yesterday morning over the Churchill Downs surface. The GI Toyota Blue Grass winner High Yield (Storm Cat) went six furlongs in 1:13 3/5; Commendable (Gone West) went the same distance in 1:12 3/5; and Exchange Rate (Danzig) may have earned his way into the Derby with a five-furlong move from the gate in 1:00 in company under jockey Calvin Borel, who will be aboard Saturday. "I thought I had to do a little more with him because I don't think he got anything out of the Louisiana Derby and the Wood Memorial," said Lukas. "If he is doing as well as I think he is doing, we will go in." A fourth Lukas hopeful, True Confidence (Storm Cat), last in Saturday's Derby Trial, is now being pointed to either the May 13 GII Illinois Derby, May 20 GI Preakness or the June 10 GII Riva Ridge, Undefeated GIII Flamingo winner Trippi (End Sweep) worked five furlongs in :59 3/5. Hal's Hope (Jolie's Halo) worked four furlongs in :46 2/5, the fastest half-mile move of the day over the Churchill surface. His 88-year-old owner-trainer Harold Rose timed him galloping out five furlongs in :58 and change and out the six furlongs in 1:13 and change. "I've got to believe he's back to where he should be," said Rose.
