PLAYING FAVORITES IN DERBY 126

It has been 21 years since the last favorite donned the blanket of roses. When Spectacular Bid raced to victory at 3-5 on the first Saturday in May back in 1979, he became the 48th winning favorite in 105 editions of the Kentucky Derby--an eye-catching success rate of 45.7 percent. Since then, the bettors' choice has been blanked. So it may come as welcome news to his connections that GII Wood Memorial hero Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr. Prospector), installed as the 9-5 morning-line favorite after post positions were drawn Wednesday, drifted to 6-1 after early Derby betting closed Friday afternoon. Currently favored at 7-2 is the four-horse entry led by GI Toyota Blue Grass winner High Yield (Storm Cat), who could give trainer D. Wavne Lukas a second consecutive Derby triumph, and his fifth overall. Lukas also saddles Commendable (Gone West) (part of the entry) and Exchange Rate (Danzig) (a separate betting interest). "We've got a legitimate chance," Lukas said. "We are going over with a pretty good little arsenal. I'm optimistic." The Hall of Fame trainer doesn't see any point in looking at the down side. "If you are a doom-and-gloom guy, you'd better get another profession," he said. "If they kick our teeth in, we'll come back next year." Lukas saddled his first Derby starter in 1981 and had to wait until Winning Colors came along in 1988 to get his first winner. Former assistant Todd Pletcher makes his Derby debut this afternoon and he does it in style, saddling no less than four starters. Trippi (End Sweep) and Impeachment (Deputy Minister) fill out the favored quartet; GII Arkansas Derby winner Graeme Hall (Dehere) is at 30-1 in the early wagering. Pletcher's best shot is with Blue Grass runner-up More Than Ready (Southern Halo), who showed he could handle the hoopla last year when he took the WHAS-TV S. on the Derby undercard. Also new to the Derby scene is jockey Frankie Dettori, who gets his first ride in the race aboard Godolphin's China Visit (Red Ransom). "It's nice to be here," Dettori said. "It hasn't hit me yet, but the atmosphere is going to electric." As for his mount's long odds, the Italian-born rider said, "The American bookmakers have him at 50-1, but we're not 50-1. We are going to give it a big shot. I think they are underestimating the colt." (Derby field, p2)

"MUSIC" IN TUNE FOR 2000 GUINEAS

Distant Music (Distant View) has come through his final paces and is ready for the test in today's G1 2000 Sagitta 2000 Guineas. The colt walked Thursday and cantered Friday and all is well with the current 11-2 second favorite (with William Hill). The ground at Newmarket is officially good at present, which is welcome news for his connections. Teddy Beckett, racing manager to Prince Khalid Abdullah, said, "He's fine, and it looks like the ground is drying out, which will suit him." Joe Mercer, racing manager for owner Saeed Suhail, is also pleased with the condition of the course. Suhail's King's Best (Kingmambo), runner-up behind Umistim (GB) (Inchinor {GB}) in the Apr. 20 G3 Craven S., currently sits at 9-1. "He's very well, and he's got a very good draw (12)," Mercer said. "His work has been very satisfactory, and Sir Michael [Stoute] is very happy with him. The ground will suit him fine." Primo Valentino (Ire) (Primo Dominie {GB}), making his threeyear-old debut, ended his juvenile season with five straight victories, capped by the G1 Middle Park S. over this course. Trainer Peter Harris, interviewed on Channel 4 Racing, said, "On the breeding side of things, there is a lot of stamina on the dam's side, and by the way he races and the way he goes at home we're absolutely confident he'll stay." "SECRET" REVEALED IN KENTUCKY OAKS

A winner in three of her last four starts, Secret Status (A.P. Indy) was nevertheless an unknown quantity coming into yesterday's GI Kentucky Oaks at Churchill Downs. But testing Grade I waters for the first time at 9-2, the chestnut swept past the field on the far turn, ran down 20-1 pacesetter Rings a Chime (Metfield) and ran away to a 6 3/4-length victory. Trained by Neil Howard, the filly took back-to-back Gulfstream allowance races to start the season. She was seven lengths behind Cash Run (Seeking the Gold) (13th in the Oaks) in the Feb. 20 GII Davona Dale S., but came back to get her first graded win in the GIII Florida Oaks last time out Mar. 19. "You never get tired of winning races of this magnitude," jockey Pat Day, who also took the 1988 edition with Goodbye Halo, said. "To win the showcase race for fillies at Churchill Downs, well, you can't describe it." A record Oaks Day crowd of 106,156 turned out for the race. (Oaks chart, p3)

What will he do for an encore? Trainer Henry Cecil who saddled Wince (GB) to a half-length victory in last year's G1 Sagitta 1000 Guineas for his sixth score in the race, will be back at Newmarket Sunday with High Walden (El Gran Senor). The runner-up behind Agrippina (GB) (Timeless Times) in the Oh So Sharp S. to end 1999, the filly hasn't been out since that October effort and she will have to be at her best to beat the unbeaten Petrushka (Ire) (Unfuwain), but her recent gallops have led many to think she can do so. She shortened yesterday from 8-1 to 6-1 with William Hill. Teddy Beckett, racing manager to owner Prince Khalid Abdullah, said, "She's fine, and she's worked well this week, but you can never be confident of winning a Classic."

Third in the GIII Golden Rod S. over this track last year, Secret Status had picked up three wins in four starts since, most recently battling on the front end all the way before prevailing by a neck in the Mar. 19 GIII Florida Oaks at Tampa Bay Downs. Nearly left at the gate this time after a start which was delayed when Vivid Sunset (Mt. Livermore) threw a tantrum, the Kentucky bred had just one horse behind her after a quarter, sat 11th after a half and was still well back in eighth after six furlongs in 1:11 1/5, but she charged into contention while being racing wide around the final turn and flew past the front-running longshot Rings a Chime to win going away. "She overcame a bad start and the other fractious fillies in the gate," jockey Pat Day said. "She settled in nicely and took the turn well, got into contention at the three eighths and it was over at the quarter pole. I put her to the task and she was just striding out." Looking ahead, trainer Neil Howard said, "You're always thinking about the Alabama (GI, at Saratoga Aug. 19) and those appropriate races for three-year-old fillies. She's bred to go a mile and a quarter. It's important now just to keep her healthy. We've got to be patient with her--she's an A.P. Indy, and you've got to have patience with them."

Heritage of Gold maintained her perfect 2000 record while defeating an Eclipse Award winner for the second straight time. The bay closed out 1999 with a good third in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff and opened her 2000 account with a win in the Mar. 19 GIII Oaklawn Breeders' Cup H. before beating champion Beautiful Pleasure in the GI Apple Blossom H. Apr. 9. The second choice rated as Bella Chiarra cut out the early fractions and went up to challenge on the far turn. Rallying six wide, she took command in the stretch and drove clear. "She ran such a great race," said trainer Tom Amoss. "All the credit goes to the mare." The 4-5 favorite Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy) lacked a late punch and finished fourth. "She was just flat today," said trainer Bob Baffert. "We'll regroup and try to figure out why."

Ramruma (Diesis {GB}) was looking to change a drastic record for Classic winners, who have always been beaten in this event, but it proved a different story as The Queen's Blueprint stepped up on his form last season to record his most important success yet. Formerly a handicapper, he showed progressive form last year to win the Listed Fred Archer S. here in June before being beaten just over two lengths in fourth behind Silver Patriarch (Ire) in the G2 Geoffrey Freer S. in August and then finishing runner-up in the G3 September S. Settled in fifth behind a fast pace early, he quickened to the leaders with two furlongs remaining and battled on over rising ground to win comfortably. Ramruma finished tailed off and was apparently slightly lame after.

King Cugat, off since November, rallied strongly in the stretch for his first graded victory. A winner at first asking last August at Saratoga, he finished second in both the GII Summer S. and the GIII Pilgim S. before concluding his juvenile campaign triumphantly in the Prized S. at Gulfstream Nov. 5. Getting Lasix for his three-year-old bow, the 2-1 favorite was unhurried early while five wide. Ranging up on the far turn, the bay colt overtook stablemate Lendell Ray and kicked clear powerfully.

He was always travelling nicely, and quickened and he's just had a look at the stands and got a bit tired up the hill." His price now ranges from 7-2 to 7-1 for the Epsom Derby.
