LAHAN TAKES 1000 GUINEAS

Putting the final touches on a weekend of classic races in Europe and America, Lahan (GB) (Unfuwain) charged from the back of the pack to win yesterday's Saggita 1000 Guineas at Newmarket. Having broken her maiden early in October last year, Lahan made a quick reappearance two weeks later to take the G2 Rockfel S. at Newmarket Oct. 16. She entered winter quarters on the fringes of the ante-post lists for the first fillies Classic, but disappointed when only fourth in the G3 Fred Darling S. at Newbury Apr. 14. With the benefit of a seriously good workout four days before the race, it took a tactically astute ride from Richard Hills to get her settled in behind horses and when asked the question, she guickened in majestic style to seize the race by the scruff of the neck and ran on gamely to give her trainer his first succes in the Classic. Velvet Lady (GB) (Nashwan) held a marginal lead approaching the quartermile marker, but Lahan, like a hot knife through butter, cut through the field with ease and showed an excellent turn of foot to quicken into the lead with 11/2 furlongs to run. The contest was over in a matter of strides as Lahan ran on in great style to secure the win. Princess Ellen (GB) (Tirol {Ire}) emerged from the pack against the rail and became the closest pursuer without getting on terms. The favourite Petrushka (Ire) (Unfuwain) ran on in determined fashion to claim third place inside the final 50 yards. Of the winning ride, Hills said, "I was banking that the speed, with Bintalreef, would be towards the middle but when we jumped out it didn't really happen that way. I desperately needed cover for her so I switched her (to the inside) straight away. She wasn't really overdoing herself and I was able to save that turn of foot for the last bit." Trainer John Gosden added, "It's a sense of relief. It's not been easy getting a filly ready this spring. I am really thrilled for the staff as it has been such a tough winter for us all. I was depressed after she was beaten in the Fred Darling, she didn't get covered up that day and the ground was heavy. She won the Rockfel well last year so I had no doubt about the trip, I just had a doubt about her getting settled. I would like to just freshen her up and go for the (G1) Coronation S. at Royal Ascot (June 23). I don't really feel that she'll go much further than a mile or a mile and a guarter and the French Oaks may be a possibilty but that will be the owner's decision." (Chart p. 2)

FRANKLY FAST

Brutally Frank (Groovy) came into vesterday's GI Carter H. at Aqueduct off a three-race win streak, with his most recent victory over Kelly Kip in the GIII Bold Ruler H. Apr. 15 being the most impressive of his career, both visually and from a speed figure standpoint. The six-year-old gelding was sent off as the second choice behind GII General George H. winner Affirmed Success. Racing in third as Unreal Madness (Unreal Zeal) and Affirmed Success contested the pace, Brutally Frank sat between horses until late in the stretch drive where he got up with one final surge to get his first Grade I victory. Jockey Shaun Bridgmohan said, "He was right there the whole way around. He fought hard and put in everything he had. He's just an extra game horse." This was also Bridgmohan's first Grade I win. Richard Schosberg, trainer of Affirmed Success, said, "He was boxed in all the way around and the rail was not the place to be. He had no chance to get out. I don't know where he'll run next."

GERMAN 1000 GUINEAS-G2 results cont.

Having had her juvenile campaign highlighted with a commendable third place in the G1 Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket last September, Crimplene began her sophomore term with a fine third to Iftiraas in the G3 Fred Darling S. at Newbury Apr. 14. The form of that race was franked earlier in the day when Lahan was an impressive winner of the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket and Crimplene herself confirmed the promise of her third-place effort in the G2 Premio Regina Elena at Rome last weekend by drawing clear inside the final furlong for a comfortable win. Crimplene broke fast from stall 14 to snatch the lead before reaching the crucial tight first turn, closely followed by Margay with 5-2 favourite Mosquera (Ger) (Acatenango {Ger}) racing prominently in fourth. Going uphill, Crimplene increased the pace and began to draw the field apart. Racing inside the final quarter mile she ran on in determined style drawing clear from over a furlong out without coming under serious threat. Margay stayed on gamely to finish a safe second with Turning Leaf emerging from the pack to gain third place in the closing stages.

Riboletta won the Mar. 5 GI Santa Margarita H. over a sloppy track before taking to the turf for a third-place effort in the Apr. 9 Miss America H. at Golden Gate Fields last time out. The Brazilian mare pressed the pace while racing three wide around the second turn. She took a short lead nearing the stretch, was clear on the front end at midstretch and continued to draw off to the wire. Excellent Meeting, unraced since last August, was floated wide into the stretch as Riboletta drifted out but couldn't match strides with the winner. "She obviously was the best horse," jockey Chris McCarron said of the winner. "She had a dynamite stalking trip, and when I asked her to run, she just sailed out." Winning trainer Eduardo Inda added, "This was an impressive race today--a very, very good win." Next up for Riboletta could be the May 28 GI Milady Breeders' Cup H.

Following a third-place finish in the Chou Croute H. at Fair Grounds in her first start of the year, Lu Ravi ran huge races at Oaklawn Park in the Mar. 19 GIII Oaklawn Breeders' Cup H. and the GI Apple Blossom H. Unfortunately for Lu Ravi, a mare named Heritage Of Gold also ran huge those days, and Lu Ravi had to settle for second place in both races. The even-money favorite versus seven others here, Lu Ravi broke sharply and made the lead without urging, set the pace and shrugged off the challenge of Tap To Music with ease to draw away to victory. "She did all the work," said jockey Pat Day. "I just guided her around. Coming down the long stretch, I didn't want to put her to the task too soon. I was confident I had something left." The filly could start next in the GIII Fleur De Lis H. at Churchill June 3.

Perfect Sting won the GI Garden City Breeders' Cup H. at Belmont Sept. 12 and the GI Queen Elizabeth II S. at Keeneland Oct. 9 before finishing her three-year-old season with a close sixth-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf at Gulfstream Nov. 6. Despite a six-month layoff, bettors made her the even-money favorite. Guided by Jerry Bailey to a perfect stalking position behind pacesetting License Fee, Perfect Sting ranged up three wide on the far turn, dug in gamely in midstretch and won easier than the margin of victory indicated. "I had her ready and she was training great," said trainer Joe Orseno. "She can get a little better off this race. If everything goes according to plan, she will not leave New York until it's time to go to Kentucky for the Breeders' Cup. Her next start will be in June (GII Sheepshead Bay H. going 11 furlongs) June 3)."

A competitive field has assembled for this traditional trial for the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby). The experienced Lord Flasheart boasts one of the best single formlines in France this season, namely his second-place finish behind Kutub in the G2 Prix Noailles at Longchamp Apr. 9. Crimson Quest is undefeated after two starts and was impressive when winning the Listed Prix de Courcelles at Longchamp Mar. 30 on his most recent outing. Hesiode is a supplementary entry and was also impressive when winning his last start, albeit a conditions event at Longchamp Apr. 2. Liniriso will be a lively outsider based on his win in a conditions race at Longchamp Apr. 9, his only start to date. He takes a big step in class and is an interesting contender.

FUSAICHI PEGASUS FINE AFTER DERBY WIN

Trainer Neil Drysdale reported Sunday that Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr. Prospector) looked fine after Saturday's race, but the Hall of Fame conditioner wasn't rushing into a Preakness start for the colt. "We have to see how he comes out of this race first before we go on to the next," said Drysdale. "As you well know, they're fragile animals and sometimes things look easy and sometimes something shows up in the wash, whatever it might be. So, literally, we'll just go one step at a time." Drysdale added that his other Derby runner, War Chant (Danzig), who finished ninth, also appeared fine after the race. No decision has been made about his next start. Neither of the Godolphin Derby runners, China Visit (Red Ransom) (6th) and Curule (Go for Gin) (7th) are being aimed for the Preakness. China Visit will be shipped to England, while Curule will go to New York. Chief Seattle (Seattle Slew), knocked out of Derby consideration with a fever, galloped at Churchill Downs Sunday morning and will join Curule in New York, Derby eighth-place finisher Captain Steve (Fly So Free) suffered a small cut on his leg in an upper stretch collision. The colt will likely start in the Preakness. Hal's Hope (Jolie's Halo) also was cut in the race. "He cut himself coming out of the gate on the right front between the ankle and the heel," trainer Harold Rose reported. "It was a pretty good gash, but it didn't need any stitches." Rose hasn't made a decision on his colt's Preakness status. D. Wayne Lukas said High Yield (Storm Cat) would most likely go on to the Preakness.
