A SPECIAL KING?

The handicap ranks were shaken up a month ago as K One King (Apalachee) made a rousing five-wide move to take the GI Oaklawn H. Apr. 8, leaving him unbeaten in two 2000 starts. Purchased by Madeleine Paulson as a Derby prospect last year, K One King went to the sidelines with a knee chip following an eighth-place finish in the Run for the Roses, the only unplaced effort of his career. He returned with a 3 3/4-length allowance score at Gulfstream Feb. 24 before leaving his rivals flatfooted at Oaklawn. However, all five of his opponents that day have returned to face the four-year-old colt, who tuned up for this outing with a sharp five panels in :59 at Churchill. Golden Missile (A.P. Indy), flying the banner for Frank Stronach, has been pointing for this race since the winter when he finished second in the GI Donn H. at Gulfstream. The big chestnut then ran fifth in the GIII New Orleans H. behind Allen's Oop (Nines Wild), but returned with a game second behind the wind-aided, front-running Yankee Victor in the GIII Westchester H. at Aqueduct Apr. 8. The hard-knocking Budroyale (Cee's Tizzy), still in search of his first Grade I score, came up empty when fifth in the Oaklawn H., but has been working well since that effort, getting a bullet for seven furlongs in 1:25 3/5 at Santa Anita May 8. The seven-year-old had finished first or second in his six previous starts prior to Oaklawn.

GOLDEN CLEOPATRE

Having won two of her six juvenile starts, Gold Round (Ire) (Caerleon) showed enough maturity to finish third to Lady Of Chad in the G3 Prix de la Grotte at Longchamp Apr. 24 on her first sophomore start. Afforded a patient ride in yesterday's G3 Prix Cleopatre from Olivier Doleuze, she challenged wide in the straight to take her first group race in comfortable style. Green Image (Fr) (Green Tune), acting as the pacesetter, was ridden to take the lead soon after the start, followed by Seattle Bay (Opening Verse) and Gold Round as Darakiyla (Ire) (Last Tycoon {Ire}) settled last of the nine runners. By halfway Gold Round had been shuffled back through the field as Green Image continued to set the pace. As the field was taken into the straight, Green Image began to fade and Seattle Bay took over the leader's mantle entering the final quarter mile whilst Gold Round was taken to the outside and began to make her move. Gold Round's persistent run took her to the lead approaching the final furlong as Darakiyla's sharp maneuver toward the rail impeded the fading Green Image. Gold Round drew clear inside the last half furlong for a comfortable win as Seattle Bay kept on for a safe second. Darakiyla was somewhat fortunate to survive a stewards enquiry and stayed on at one pace to retain third without managing to mount a serious threat.

In recent times, a race with both Godolphin and Ballydoyle entries has been perceived as a straight match. Thus, the promise of Dubai Two Thousand's Longchamp maiden success last October, together with the smart form Aidan O'Brien's Apollo Victoria showed at Gowran Park when narrowly beaten by subsequent Listed scorer Grand Finale (Ire), does nothing to dissuade the observer of this belief.
