MISSILE IS GOOD AS GOLD

Kentucky Derby winning jockey Kent Desormeaux went back to his Maryland roots to guide Stronach Stable's **Golden Missile** (A.P. Indy) to an impressive two-length victory in the GI Pimlico Special yesterday afternoon. Second by a nose in the GII Hawthorne Gold Cup last October, horse and jockey teamed to be a threat deep into the stretch of the Breeders' Cup Classic before weakening to finish third by just 1 1/2 lengths at 75-1. A monster second in the GI Donn H. at Gulfstream Feb. 5 was followed by a lackluster fifth as the odds-on choice in the GIII New Orleans H. at the Fair Grounds Mar. 5. Second in the Apr. 5 GIII Westchester H. at Aqueduct at a flat mile, Golden Missile was made a 9-2 chance to snag his first Grade I. **Cat Thief** (Storm Cat), drawn just inside Golden Missile, broke through the gate at the start, causing the Joe Orseno trainee to become unruly. Three wide stalking leaders Cat Thief and **Budroyale** (Cee's Tizzy) down the backstretch. Desormeaux cut the chestnut loose with a little more than two furlongs to run, took over at the eighth pole and drew clear. "I've been on a roll lately and I hope it continues," Desormeaux said. "It's always special to win these prestigious races at Old Hilltop, because that's where I started as a little kid." The winner could go next in the GII Masscap June 3 or the GII Stephen Foster at Churchill June 17.

CONQUERING MONASHEE MOUNTAIN

Monashee Mountain (Danzig) is the choice of Aidan O'Brien's five entries and will dispute favouritism for this afternoon's French 2000 Guineas at Longchamp. He was successful on his only start this year when a high impressive winner of the G3 Tetrarch S. at The Curragh May 1. A powerful looking individual, he remains unbeaten after four starts and is without doubt a worthy contender. **Berine's Son** (Irish River {Fr}) heads the home defence and will seek to confirm the form of the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau at Longchamp Apr. 23, where he had **Premier Pas** (Sillery), **Slipstream King** (Linamix {Fr}) and **Blu Air Force** (Sri Pekan) in arrears. The Italian trained Blu Air Force patently didn't handle the heavy conditions on that occasion and can be given another chance to redeem his reputation. **Ekraar** (Red Ransom) is the head of the British delegation and was a fine third to Umisitim and G1 2000 Guineas winner Kings Best in the G3 Craven S. at Newmarket Apr. 20, on his seasonal debut. He boasts juvenile form of the highest order and holds a solid chance.

A CLASSIC LADY?

A more solid looking home defence than the colts' equivalent is headed by the hitherto unbeaten **Lady Of Chad** (Last Tycoon {Ire}) in the French 1000 Guineas. On the second of her two juvenile starts, she was a most impressive winner of the G1 Prix Marcel Bousac at Longchamp Oct. 3 and she started her sophomore campaign with a comfortable win in the G3 Prix de la Grotte at Longchamp Apr. 23. She will go postward a deserved favourite. **Zarkiya** (Catrail) won her sole two-year-old start and caught the eye in defeat when second to the classy Devon Heights in the Listed Prix d'Angerville at Chantilly Apr. 28 on her first start this season. She possesses a high cruising speed and will not be inconvenienced by a strong pace. **Iftiraas** (Distant Relative {Ire}) has strong claims based on her comfortable win in the G3 Fred Darling S. at Newbury Apr. 14. The form of that race has since been franked with wins for third-placed Crimplene in the G2 Henkel-Rennen (German 1000 Guineas) and fourth-placed Lahan in the G1 1000 Guineas. The Italian trained **Xua** (Fairy King) beat Crimplene into third in the G2 Premio Regina Elena (Italian 1000 Guineas) at Rome Apr. 30, and has place claims at least. (Previews cont. p4)

Jockey Aaron Spiteri performed a truly spectacular backflip dismount from G1 Goodwood H. winner Marstic at Adelaide's Morphetville Racetrack yesterday while Melbourne-based trainer Tony Vasil fought back tears. Following a course plotted by Vasil on the rain affected track early in the morning, jockey Aaron Spiteri eased the 35-10 favourite out to the centre of the track to win running away, three quarters of a length ahead of the Russell Cameron trained pair Czar Hero and Strident, who went to the line together. Vasil finally won a Group 1 event after 15 years of trying. Marstic cost just \$7,000 as a yearling and has earned more than \$650,000 to date. "He is a great horse to train and a fantastic money spinner for the stable," Vasil said. "Sooner or later I knew he would win a top-class race and with conditions to suit I was pretty confident today was the day." After Group 1 placings with Lisa's Gain in last year's Caulfield Cup and a second to Redoute's Choice in the Manikato S., Vasil was clearly relieved to have finally broken the drought. "It's been a long time coming and I have been oh so close, but it's such a relief to have finally done it," Vasil said. "Horses like this are the ones that keep the racing dream alive." The four-year-old will now head to Brisbane to contest the Winter Carnival.

Performing Magic, a maiden and allowance winner in Britain, had failed to make the step up to Listed stakes company, finishing off the board in two such attempts. Eleventh and last in the Listed Autumn S. at Ascot in his British finale last October, he took nearly five months off before making his U.S. bow in the off-the-turf Feb. 27 Gill Baldwin S. and finishing second. Encouraged by that main-track effort, his connections next sent him to New York, where he was third to Preakness hopeful Red Bullet in the Mar. 19 Gill Gotham S. He broke through with his first dirt score in the Apr. 29 Gill Derby Trial last time out and was sent off the 2-1 second choice to make it two in a row. Rated in fourth as favored Country Only led through a half in :48 3/5 and six furlongs in 1:12, the chestnut angled outside to go after the pacesetter at the head of the lane and just got up in the final strides to take the photo. "Under the wire the first time, I had a decision to make to either take him back or go into the first turn head and head," jockey Shane Sellers said. "I didn't think I was going to give my horse a chance if I went head and head, so I took him back. He dropped the bit on me up the backstretch and I was a little concerned. I thought I took his race away from him, fighting him so much. But I called on my horse in the middle of the turn and he put up a great race all through the stretch." Still, Sellers was unsure who had hit the wire first. "I didn't know if I had won it," he admitted. "In fact, I leaned over and congratulated [jockey Herbie Castillo Jr., on Country Only]."

"Go East, young California horses!" Such has been the battle cry of trainer Bobby Frankel, who sent Honest Lady to Aqueduct to win the GII Distaff Breeders' Cup H. Mar. 25 and also conditioned Kentucky Derby second Aptitude to board finishes in the GIII Gotham and GII Wood Memorial. The winner of the G3 Prix du Bois in July 1998, Imperfect World was sent to the U.S. towards the end of last season to run second in a pair of turf sprints at Santa Anita before earning a brief rest. Sixth down the hill Mar. 30, the chestnut was anything but imperfect in a two-length main-track allowance success at Keeneland Apr. 20. Stepping up in class, the four-year-old was taken in hand to race on the outside as New Heaven (Southern Halo) and defending champ Foil (Darn That Alarm) scrimmaged for the lead. Turning for home while still wide, jockey Robbie Davis guided his mount towards the rail to take advantage of a gaping hole, hit the front inside the final sixteenth and held Gold Princess safe for the victory. "It was a hot pace up front and my goal was to get a clear path," Davis commented. "Turning for home I found an opening and cut the corner. She was full of run in the lane."

Out Of Mind, another South American import out of the Richard Mandella barn, was the champion two-year-old and a Group winner on the grass in his native country, but tried on turf in four of his first five attempts in the U.S., the dark bay was off the board every time. He was given a two-month break after running fourth on the Santa Anita grass Feb. 25 and showed his appreciation for the vacation with a win in an optional claiming allowance over the Arcadia oval's main strip Apr. 16. Set up for his first North American stakes foray, the five-year-old was away from the gate slowly and trailed through a half in :46 2/5, but bulled his way between horses on the far turn and rallied strongly to catch Early Pioneer in the shadow of the wire. "The key is not to hurry this horse and let him finish," Mandella said. "It's taken a while for this horse to come around, but thank God I've got patient owners. He came here as a nice horse, but he has had some problems and we've had to be patient...now it's paying off." As for the future, Mandella said, "We'll look at the Californian (GII, June 11), but we also might take a look at the Mass Cap (GII, at Suffolk Downs June 3)." He added, "I was sure of going to the Mass Cap with Puerto Madero (Gallantsky), but now I don't know what to do." Puerto Madero, winless since taking the GI Donn H. in February of 1999, was coming off a fourth-place finish in the Mar. 25 G1 Dubai World Cup. Never in the hunt as the even-money favorite, he finished last. "I'm devastated that Puerto Madero didn't run at all today," said Mandella. "How can a horse train that well and then not run at all?" Added jockey Laffit Pincay Jr., "He looks so good; he's sound. I don't know what's wrong with him."

The Lingfield Derby Trial has a fine record for producing G1 Epsom Derby S. winners. Now Saddler's Quest will attempt to add his name to those of High-Rise (Ire) and Kahyasi (Ire) in recent history after a game success here, stepping up on his impressive conditions win at Kempton Apr. 22 to put himself in the Derby picture. Settled in behind the early pace set by Eternal Spring (Ire) (Persian Bold {Ire}), jockey Kevin Darley was happy to let him coast along until the pace started to quicken four furlongs out, where Frankie Dettori committed Dubai Two Thousand (GB) (Nashwan). As the Godolphin horse found little, Darley switched his mount from the rail, but was left with the gap to close on Going Global, who looked to have flown. With King O'The Mana breathing down his neck in third, Darley found the required extra reserves from his mount, who kept staying on to get up on the line. Trainer Gerard Butler said, "This has always been the plan, to come here today and then go straight to the Derby. He's a very nice horse, and he has every chance." Bookmaker reaction was mixed, with Corals quoting him as low as 14-1, while Ladbrokes offer 40-1 for the Epsom Classic.

MARSCAY DEAD

A wonderful chapter in Australian breeding closed with the death of champion sire **Marscay (Aus)** (Biscay {Aus}), aged 20, as a result of complications following surgery for colic on Saturday. "After developing severe colic at Widden Stud on Saturday morning, Marscay underwent emergency surgery at the Scone Veterinary Hospital and although the surgery was successful, post-operative complications resulted in his death," said Widden Stud general manager Derek Field. He will be buried at Widden Stud alongside such greats as Heroic, Maltster, Lunchtime, Vain and Bletchingly. Purchased for A\$50,000 at the Inglis Easter sale in 1981, the personable chestnut won five from six outings en route to the 1982 Golden Slipper and went on to beat the likes of Strawberry Road (Aus) in the Hobartville S. as a three-year-old before retiring to Widden Stud in 1983 with earnings of A\$237,000. Syndicated at A\$30,000 a share, Marscay quickly demonstrated the true qualities of a champion stallion as leading first crop sire in 1986-87 and as champion Australian sire in 1990-91 and again in 1992-93. By 1989, shares were changing hands at A\$600,000. To date, Marscay has sired 11 individual Group 1 winners and 100 individual stakes performers. He is the sire of Group 1 winners such as 1993 Golden Slipper winner Bint Marscay (Aus), AJC Oaks winner Circles Of Gold (Aus), Metropolitan winner Heart Ruler (NZ), Galaxy winner Jetball (Aus), weight-for-age star March Hare (Aus), evergreen dual Group 1 winner Sharscay (NZ), and champion filly Triscay (Aus), who won five Group 1 races and almost A\$2 million. Marscay's legacy as leading broodmare sire is pervasive--he is broodmare sire of yesterday's G1 Goodwood H. winner Marstic (Aus) as well as Catbird (Aus), Camarena (NZ), Yippyio (Aus), La Baraka (Aus) and countless others.

MOSSE MAY MISS SENDAWAR

Gerald Mosse, suspended for two days after a careless ride at Longchamp on Friday, could miss the ride on **Sendawar (Ire)** (Priolo {USA}) if he runs in the G1 Prix d'Ispahan Longchamp May 21. The four-year-old colt, last year's champion miler, also holds an engagement in the G1 Lockinge S. Newbury May 20, and if he goes there, it will fall before the suspension period, allowing Mosse the opportunity to ride the Aga Khan colorbearer.

GUILLOT INJURED

Sylvan Guillot suffered a cracked pelvis in a horrific fall at Longchamp Friday and will be unable to ride for a month. He was thrown into the air after his filly clipped the heels of the horse in front. It was originally thought that he had suffered no serious injuries, but he was later found to have a cracked pelvis which will sideline him for the Classic period.

ZABEEL'S FEE ON THE RISE

Champion sire Zabeel (NZ)'s fee has risen from NZ\$85,000 to NZ\$110,000. *Sir Tristram, Zabeel's sire, is the only other stallion to have stood at \$100,000 or more in New Zealand. "We have had something like 280 applications for Zabeel, but he's only likely to serve about 140 mares," said Cambridge Stud's Patrick Hogan. "All of the mares for which there are applications are worthy of being served by Zabeel, and it will be difficult deciding which ones get in. I'm not looking forward to writing the letters to unsuccessful candidates." Hogan said Zabeel would not do a third season to Northern Hemisphere time this year. "I only wanted a couple of crops by Zabeel to see how they would shape up in Europe," he told the *Sydney Morning Herald*, "and from 42 matings he has 38 foals with his progeny in France, Japan and England as well as in Australia and New Zealand. It would be really exciting if they measured up overseas, but the fact is he is rising 16 and I felt it was in his best interests overall to give him the Northern Season off because, after all, he's going to be pretty busy from September to December this year."

Springsteen (Aus) (Danehill {USA}), one of Australia's top juveniles, could fetch a record price at tomorrow's Magic Millions Adelaide Cup Yearling and Mixed Thoroughbred Sale. Bastion's company Gideon Investments had been placed into liquidation following his death as a result of a fall from a balcony in Hong Kong on March 17. Springsteen has established himself as one of Australia's most promising youngsters with Listed wins in the Oaklands Plate at Cheltenham and Alcohol Go Easy S. at Morphettville.
