GODOLPHIN BACK ON SONG WITH BACHIR

Striking the front approaching the final furlong, Bachir (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}) showed gritty determination to keep his foes at bay and record Godolphin's first European Group 1 win of the season with a 1½-length defeat of leading French hope Berine's Son (Irish River (Fr)). Having suffered a reverse earlier in the day when River's Curtain (Theatrical {Ire}) finished out of the money in the G1 Prix Lupin, the Godolphin team were glad to get back on track with another Classic winner to add to their ever-increasing portfolio. Winning rider Frankie Dettori said, "This is a Classic and any Classic is important. I'm delighted for the team because River's Curtain didn't run too well. We were a little depressed after that but this has put a smile back on our faces." Bachir was under the care of John Gosden as a juvenile and was impressive when winning a Chepstow maiden on his debut in July. He confirmed the promise of that first run with a solid display to take the G2 Richmond S. at Goodwood later that month. His final two freshman starts came in the highest company and he was not disgraced in either, finishing third to Fasliyev in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville in August and occupying the same berth behind Giant's Causeway in the G1 Prix de la Salamandre at Longchamp in September. Having been seconded by Godolphin, he wintered in Dubai and reappered to take the Khor Dubai at Nad Al Sheba and followed up in the UAE Derby with a second to China Visit. Making his first European start of the year in a field reduced by four, he was well supported in the betting and started at odds of just over 3-1. Ekraar (Red Ransom) was rushed straight into the lead and gradually built up a healthy lead in advance of Bachir, Mon Pote Le Gitan (Thunder Gulch) and Berine's Son as Valentino and the favourite Monashee Mountain (Danzig) were afforded patient rides in the rear. Ekraar still enjoyed a clear lead turning for home, but Bachir made steady headway to challenge with 1½ furlongs to go and went to the front at the distance. Quickly putting a race-winning lead between himself and his opponents, Bachir kept on in good style all the way to the line for a welldeserved win. Berine's Son had made progress from the quarter- mile marker without troubling the winner with Valentino running on to be nearest at the finish. Monashee Mountain tried to make his bid on the wide outside and although keeping on for Michael Kinane's urgings, he didn't threaten the principals.

Starting at odds of over 18-1, Bluemamba (Kingmambo) caused a major upset when winning in battling style as the first five home were covered by less than a length. There were legitimate excuses for some of those beaten with traffic problems cited as the main reason for defeat. Such excuses did not matter as far as Thierry Jarnet was concerned; he was fortunate to get the ride for his first win in the race after scheduled pilot Sylvain Guillot was sidelined with a cracked pelvis. The triumph was also a first success in the race for the owner/trainer combination. Said winning trainer Pascal Bary, "I am very honoured to win this race for Mrs. O'Reilly, who has entrusted me with her horses for 20 years. She has been very patient and it is always special to win such races, especially this race, for the first time." Bluemamba started her career with a third in the Listed Prix Yacowlef at Deauville last August and broke her maiden on her second and final start in a conditions event at Chantilly Sept. 8. She made her first start this year when third to Peony (GB) (Lion Cavern) in the Listed Prix Imprudence but turned the form of that race on its head by beating that rival into second, with the British challenger Alshakr (GB) (Bahri) holding on for third as the unlucky Zarkiya (Ire) (Catrail) finished with a surging late rattle. The favourite, Lady Of Chad (Ire) (Last Tycoon {Ire}), was the disappointment of the race, fading out of contention in the last quarter-mile. Pacemaker Saone Et Loire (Fr) (Always Fair) was rushed from the gate to take the lead from her hard-pulling stablemate Lady Of Chad, Bluemamba, Iftiraas (GB) (Distant Relative {|re}) and Alshakr as Peony and Zarkiya raced towards the rear. Iftiraas and Lady Of Chad disputed the lead from the quarter-mile marker but the latter's earlier exertions began to tell and she soon faded out of contention. Iftiraas took the field into the final furlong but was tackled and passed by Bluemamba, who battled gamely all the way to the wire for a famous win. Peony weaved through traffic and finished strongly to take second from Alshakr on the line with the unlucky-inrunning Zarkiya finishing fast on the outside to no avail. Excusing Zarkiya's defeat, Alain de Royer-Dupre explained, "She was most unlucky, but you have to expect encountering traffic problems with horses that need to be held up in their races." On future plans for the winner, Pascal Bary said, "She is in the (G1) Irish 1000 Guineas (at the Curragh May 28) but that race will come too soon as it is only two weeks away. She will most probably head for the G1 Prix de Diane (at Chantilly June 11) as I believe she is a filly who will stay."

Awarded the G1 Grand Criterium by the Longchamp stewards last October on the last of his three juvenile starts, Ciro reappeared in the G2 Prix Noailles over 11 furlongs at Longchamp Apr. 9, and made a brave bid to lead all the way before being collared in the closing stages and finishing third to Kutub and Lord Flasheart. Over a slightly shorter trip here, he was given a most enterprising ride by Michael Kinane and turned down all challenges in the final furlong to record a game win. Alyzig went into the lead at the start but was relegated to third when River's Curtain (Theatrical {Ire}) and Ciro went by after a quarter-mile. The odds-on favourite. Kutub, was positioned in the rear and tracked G2 Prix Greffulhe winner Rhenium. Ciro came under pressure entering the final two furlongs and led with 1½ furlongs to run, but he was soon under threat as Kutub was produced on the outside to make his challenge. Michael Kinane continued to get a game response from Ciro and the pair kept on in tremendous style to hold the vain bid of Kutub. Rhenium ran on well from midfield and was far from disgraced in third. Winning part-owner Michael Tabor said, "I'm very happy and naturally pleased with that run. We think a lot of this horse and we like the French! I would think, although I am not sure, his next race will be the (G1) French Derby (at Chantilly June 4). I think he will be more suited to the French Derby rather than (the G1) Epsom but, having said that, we could change our mind and go for Epsom."

You could have heard reputations being punctured, like trees being felled, all the way back to the Coliseum here in Rome today. Unlucky loser of both the G2 Premio Parioli (Italian 2000 Guineas) and the Listed Gran Premio D'Italia last year, Timboroa had to wait until early September to score his first stakes victory when taking the Listed Premio Villa Borghese here. After two wins out of three starts in condition races here during March and April, he was making a huge step up in class in taking on a classy field of Group winners, including Godolphin's last year's G1 Derby Italiano winner Mukhalif. Always handily placed behind the lead set by Forest Buck (USA) (Green Forest {USA}), Timboroa quickened well early in the straight and grabbed the lead a furlong and a half out and stayed on well to hold off the fast-closing Crisos II Monaco, who had come from the rear of the field. German invader Sumitas, who had always been close to the pace, beat his compatriot Caitano for third spot, but, in trying to find room to make his challenge, squeezed out Rio Napo. After the race, he lost his place in the stewards' room and was demoted to sixth, with Rio Napo promoted to fifth. Mukhalif was never a factor in the race. Winning trainer Roberto Brogi said, "Timboroa will probably go to Deauville for a Group race in July or August."

Undefeated in three starts at two, including a two-length victory in the G1 Sansai Himba S. at Hanshin, Stinger could manage only one win in all of 1999 and closed her sophomore campaign with a 14th-place finish in the Japan Cup over this course. The bay got back into the win column in the Jan. 30 G3 Kyoto Himba Tokubetsu, her last start to date. The four-year-old broke slowly and was kept at the back of the pack to the top of the stretch. Switched to the outside for run, the filly exploded through the final furlongs to win going away. Diktat (GB) (Warning {GB}), the only foreign entrant in the race, was forwardly placed throughout, but lacked the needed response in the final 100 meters and finished an even sixth, beaten about three lengths.

He raced twice on the sand at Nad Al Sheba, the latter behind China Visit (USA) in the UAE Derby Mar. 25. Returning to Europe for this Classic, Pacino put up a smart performance to win, breaking his maiden in the process. Grabbing the lead early from Global Dancer (Ger) (Shareef Dancer), he remorselessly galloped his rivals into the ground, putting safe distance between himself and the runner-up, who was making good progress on the rail, and the fast-finishing Siamo.

Black Cash continued owner Frank Stronach's good run with this victory one day after Golden Missile ran off with the GI Pimlico Special. The multiple graded stakes winner, fourth behind Affirmed Success in the GII General George H. at Laurel in February, romped by five in an optional claimer at Delaware Apr. 8. Unhurried in the early stages, the blinkered bay quickly reached contention on the far turn, took over at the head of the lane and asserted his superiority down the stretch.

The winner of the GI Del Mar Oaks last August, Tout Charmant had made just three starts since then, finishing second in the GI Queen Elizabeth at Keeneland Oct. 9, fifth in Gulfstream's Pebbles S, over Breeders' Cup weekend, and eighth in Hollywood's GI Matriarch to close out the year. Purchased privately by Stonerside before this race and transferred from the barn of Bob Baffert to that of Ron McAnally, she was the most accomplished runner in this field and the only Grade I winner in the group. Penny Marie, who came off two straight wins, including the Miss America H. at Golden Gate last out April 9, set the pace with Tout Charmant just off her lead. Penny Marie led the way home, but the winner proved best in a tough stretch drive, giving trainer Ron McAnally his 100th career stakes win at Hollywood.

Having not won in eight attempts since successful in the G3 Duke Of York S. at York last May, Sampower Star was still the subject of a deal taking him under the Godolphin banner. He was unplaced on his seasonal debut at Nad AI Sheba Mar. 3, but returned to his best form to record his second Group 3 win. Watching took the outright lead at halfway and was ridden to make his effort from the quarter-mile marker but was soon stalked by the smooth-travelling Sampower Star with Seltitude also making good progress through the pack. Sampower Star was ridden from the furlong maker and grabbed the lead in the last 50 yards for a cozy win.




