SEVEN BLACK-EYED SUSANS

A field of seven three-year-old fillies will line up for today's GII Black-Eyed Susan S. at Pimlico. The most accomplished filly in the group is last year's Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies winner **Cash Run** (Seeking the Gold). After back-to-back graded wins at Gulfstream this past winter, the D. Wayne Lukas trainee ran a dull fourth in the Apr. 8 GI Ashland S. and an even duller 13th in the May 5 GI Kentucky Oaks. **Rings a Chime** (Metfield) narrowly won the Ashland before finishing a distant second in the Oaks. The unbeaten **Impending Bear** (Farma Way) won her first two starts over Fair Grounds main track and switched to the turf to capture her stakes debut in the Apr. 9 Appalachian S. at Keeneland. Trainer Shug McGaughey's **Search Party** (Seeking the Gold) brings a three-race win streak into her stakes debut. The filly won a pair of one-mile Aqueduct allowance contests in April. Local entrant **Case of the Blues** (In Case) has won four straight Maryland stakes.

KAYF TARA BACK ON TOP

Despite **Kayf Tara** (GB) (Sadler's Wells)'s success last year in the G1 Irish St Leger and in three Group 2 events, there were doubts that Europe's leading stayer would be at his best after injuring his suspensory ligament in the build-up to the Melbourne Cup last year. But those doubts were lifted after the veteran's imperious display in yesterday's G2 Merewood Homes Yorkshire Cup at York. Settled prominently on the outside as **Kahtan** (GB) (Nashwan) took them along early, the winner was still full of run when the field got it into top gear as they turned for home. Jockey Frankie Dettori turned him loose three furlongs out and he stretched away in a few strides to shoot clear of the chasing pack. Said a delighted Dettori, "He is unbelievable--this is his 10th Group race victory and horses like that do not come along very often. He is so consistent and is a jockey's dream to ride, and this proves that he is as good as ever." Kayf Tara is now on target for the G1 Ascot Gold Cup June 22 (which he won in 1998), followed by the G1 Irish St Leger Sept. 16, which he bids to win for the third consecutive year. He will also be given another tilt at the Melbourne Cup.

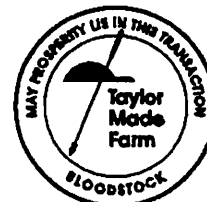

Holding Court (GB) broke his maiden in his third attempt at Haydock Oct. 13, and reappeared 10 days later to finish eighth to Aristotle in the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster. He has moved since his last juvenile run and made his first sophomore start a winning one for new trainer Michael Jarvis when successful in a rated handicap on Haydock's heavy ground April 22. Showing he is not just a soft ground horse, he led all the way here and simply galloped his rivals into submission for a highly impressive first group race success. Winning trainer Michael Jarvis said, "I have only trained this horse since February and he shows more every time he runs. He is a real galloper and would not like it any firmer than good. He is in the (G1) Epsom Derby (at Epsom June 10) but is not in the French equivalent. We have the option of supplementing him for Chantilly if necessary, but a decision will be made in time."

Making his first appearance outside Spain, Suances advanced on his domestic four-for-five record to add a first group race to an already impressive resume. He was positioned in third from the outset as the favourite Boutron led from market rival Beriskaio at a not too exacting pace. Boutron upped the tempo along the false straight, but came under pressure soon after entering the straight proper. Suances was produced on the outside to make his effort from the quarter-mile marker, quickened into the lead approaching the final furlong and ran on strongly for an impressive win. A delighted winning trainer, Mauricio Delcher-Sanchez, said, "We sent this horse to this race to test him as there is nothing to run against him in Spain, and we loved what we saw. We had established his programme until today and we now have to see what could be next. The G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly (June 4) is a possibility but he has to return to Spain first and we will have to see how he recovers before making a decision."

Lend A Hand is better known as a miler, with his best performances at the top level coming when runner-up to King Of Kings (Ire) in the 1998 G1 2000 Guineas, and when a close fourth in last year's G1 Breeders' Cup Mile. His connections have obviously seen speed in his homework, however, as they have decided to return him to six furlongs. Although this strategy failed first time at Nad Al Sheba, when he was sixth behind Big Jag in the Listed Golden Shaheen Mar. 25, it certainly worked here on the Knavesmire. Rated just in behind the trail-blazing Bold Edge early, he was asked to quicken on the outside just past halfway. The response was instant, as he soon put daylight between himself and the pacesetter and, ridden with hand and heels in the closing stages, he had too many guns for the game Pipalong. Winning trainer Simon Crisford said, "He is such a talented horse and we always fancy him in whatever race we run him in. Seven furlongs is really his trip, but there are no suitable races for him over that distance until later on. He'll go for the G2 Cork & Orrery S. at Royal Ascot (June 22), as the conditions of the race will really suit him--the race is tailor-made for the horse with it being a stiff six. I would think he will be one of our bankers at the meeting."

NTRA BOARD APPROVES BREEDERS' CUP

MERGER The National Thoroughbred Racing Association's board of directors tentatively approved a measure to merge the organization with the Breeders' Cup Ltd. at a board meeting yesterday in Baltimore, Maryland. The move, which still must be approved by the board of the Breeders' Cup, would consolidate the operations, property rights, marketing and administrative functions of the two groups. Plans also call for a one-time cash transfer from the Breeders' Cup reserves to the NTRA. The Breeders' Cup will be able to elect two directors to the board of the NTRA and will retain certain responsibilities, including the selection of the site for the Breeders' Cup championship and approval of any proposed changes to purse structure and format. This new proposal further formalizes a plan unveiled late last year.

MAGNA TO CLOSE BAY MEADOWS Frank Stronach's Magna Entertainment Corp. has signed a letter of intent to buy Bay Meadows Racecourse, according to published reports. The Northern California track is expected to continue to run through the 2002 season, at which time it will be closed to make way for a newly built track. Paine Webber Realty Partners will continue to own the 100-acre property on which the track stands. Magna already owns six tracks, including Golden Gate Fields in Albany, California. The terms of the sale are subject to the approval of the California Horse Racing Board.

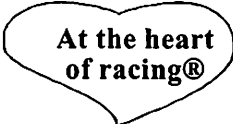

DANEHILL FILLY TOPS AUSSIE DISPERSAL

High profile advertising guru John Singleton gave A\$1 million for a full sister to Golden Slipper runner-up Shovhog (Aus), the sales topper at yesterday's Bellerive Stud Dispersal Sale in Scone, Australia. Singleton, part-owner of this year's Golden Slipper winner Belle Du Jour (Aus), snapped up the weanling filly by Danehill (USA) out of Startling Lass (Aus) (Luskin Star {Aus}) at a sale where the average was A\$195,115 and the gross was A\$11,902,000. There were 61 lots offered and 61 sold. The sale underscored the popularity of Shovhog, who covered around 100 mares at A\$6,000 last season and saw his fee rise to A\$8,000 this year although his first foals have not yet arrived. The second highest price was A\$825,000 for the three-year-old filly **Countess Christie (Aus)** (Marscaj {Aus}), in foal to Hennessy (USA). Purchased by S. F. Perrin, Countess Christie won last season's G2 Magic Night S. and G3 Sweet Embrace S. Listed stakes-winning filly **Tennessee Midnight (Aus)** (Danehill {Aus}), a three-year-old racing prospect, fetched A\$675,000 from Kilty Park, while another runner, the four-year-old filly **St. Kate (Aus)** (Danehill {USA}), was purchased for A\$600,000 by Jack Denham. Denham was leading buyer with three for A\$1,575,000, ahead of Fred Sarina Bloodstock with five for A\$860,000. Active buyers also included Coolmore, Vinery, Baramul, Glenlogan, Segenhoe and Noble Park Studs, and trainers Gai Waterhouse and Graeme Rogerson. Bellerive owner Roy Thompson's property in the Segenhoe Valley was not offered for sale as Arrowfield Stud has leased it, a spokesman said.
