PREAKNESS 125: CHILD'S PLAY FOR PEGASUS?

From the morning-line oddsmaker to the man on the street, people are already conceding today's Preakness to Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr. Prospector). But trainer Neil Drysdale is not about to predict a victory. "I'm never confident," Drysdale said. "I might be optimistic, but not confident." And despite the fact that High Yield (Storm Cat) crossed the finish line 24 lengths behind the flying horse in the Kentucky Derby, his trainer, D. Wayne Lukas, isn't ready to surrender the second jewel in the Triple Crown. "I don't think horsemen and some of the public are as ready to concede the Preakness and Belmont to him as the press has," Lukas said. "You win one or two and you think, or hope, that you can go all the way. But you've got to remember that he has to run in these races. That's why the Triple Crown is here and why it's so tough." The forecast for rain could make the task even tougher. Fusaichi Pegasus has been tested over an off track once, winning the GII Wood Memorial over a strip labeled wet-fast, but has yet to run over a truly muddy track. "The track in the Wood was off and he has trained on an off track," Drysdale said. "Mr. Prospectors generally handle an off track." But he added, "It always makes you a little bit apprehensive. Off tracks can change by the minute. Every time you go into new territory, it's a concern." Captain Steve (Fly So Free) was at his best when he tried the slop, leading every step in the GII Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland last October. "I think he moves up on a wet track," trainer Bob Baffert said. Eighth in the Derby and winless in four starts this year, the chestnut colt will have to improve to get a third Preakness trophy for Baffert. Red Bullet (Unbridled), runner-up in the Wood, joins the Triple Crown fray. But trainer Joe Orseno has his eye on more than the Preakness prize. "I we were able to win the Preakness and beat [Fusaichi Pegasus] in another good race later in the year, we might have a chance to be three-year-old champion," he said. (Preakness field, p2)

HERE'S MUD IN YOUR EYE

She had to wrestle both a muddy track and arch rival March Magic (Evansville Slew) at Pimlico yesterday afternoon, but Jostle (Brocco) just wouldn't be beaten, drawing off to take the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. by 2 1/2 lengths. The performance confirmed her status as a mudlark; the dark bay filly also captured the GII Demoiselle S. in the mud at Aqueduct last November--besting March Magic by a head--and finished just a length behind that foe over a sloppy Big A strip in the Apr. 21 GII Comley S. last time out. Let go at 5-1 off that effort, Jostle tracked 9-2 Cash Run (Seeking the Gold) through six furlongs, swung to the outside to grab the lead on the far turn and held 2-1 March Magic at bay down the lane for her fifth win from nine starts. "She took me to the lead and I grew concerned because she started idling once she got there," jockey Kent Desormeaux, who will try to score the second leg of the Black-Eyed Susan/Preakness double with Fusaichi Pegasus this afternoon, said. "I got even more concerned when March Magic came up on the outside of me, but...she just took off at that point without me even asking her. I knew it was going to take something miraculous to beat her." The filly will be pointed for the 1 1/2-mile GI Coaching Club American Oaks at Belmont Park July 22.

With Sendawar (Ire) rerouted to tomorrow's G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp, Aliabr can take full advantage of his old rival's absence. Godolphin's colt was second behind Sendawar in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot last June and fourth to him in the G1 Prix du Moulin at Longchamp last September. In between he produced a sterling effort to win the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood, with Almushtarak six lengths back in third. With the Godolphin bandwagon starting to get into gear, he will be expected to justify favouritism. The boys in blue have won the two latest renewals of this race with supposed second strings and their Wordly Manner is the number two choice this time. It would be folly to expect him to line up as pacemaker and, although his recent official form is not spectacular, he was third of eight to Aljabr in a private trial in April. Indian Lodge has progressed with each run this season, following up his impressive win in the Apr. 19 G3 Earl Of Sefton S. at Newmarket, with another success in the Apr. 28 G2 KLM Mile at Sandown.

MONTJEU TO RETURN AT THE CURRAGH

Montjeu (Ire) (Sadler's Wells {USA}), winner of the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, G1 Irish Derby and G1 Prix du Jockey Club last season, is expected to make his 2000 debut in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 28, according to published reports. Trainer John Hammond told the *Racing Post*, "Montjeu was worked at Chantilly [Thursday] morning with two lead horses. He's really well and is pleasing me. The colt appears to be on top of his game." Away since running fourth in the Nov. 28 G1 Japan Cup, the four-year-old has won seven of his nine career starts.
