BULLET SHOOTS DOWN PEGASUS

Though everyone and their mother viewed yesterday's GI Preakness S. as a foregone conclusion for Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr. Prospector), trainer Joe Orseno was confident that his charge, Red Bullet (Unbridled), could upend the apple cart for the Derby winner in the middle jewel of the Triple Crown. The lightly raced colt had seen his unbeaten record spoiled by Fusaichi Pegasus in the GII Wood Memorial on a wet Aqueduct track Apr. 15, and the decision was made to forego the Kentucky Derby and instead point for the Preakness. "Give Frank Stronach all the credit you can," Orseno remarked. "It was a tough decision to pass on the Kentucky Derby, but we knew we had a horse with a lot of talent and we knew to pick our spot and point for the three-year-old championship." The homebred colt had blossomed in the past few weeks and recorded a bullet work of :58 4/5 over the Pimlico surface May 13. Jerry Bailey, who had ridden the colt to an allowance score at Gulfstream Feb. 5, was tapped to ride the colt yesterday. Allowed to settle well off the pace, Red Bullet began to advance nearing the far turn, moving in tandem with the favorite. "When he [Fusaichi Pegasus] didn't beat me to the quarter pole, I thought I had a pretty good chance," said Bailey. Splitting horses off the turn, Red Bullet quickened impressively and opened up on his rivals, coming home 3 3/4 lengths in the clear and giving Stronach his first Preakness winner. As for the Belmont, a decision will be made in the next few days. "We'll let the horse tell us," commented Orseno. Fusaichi Pegasus weakened a bit late, but held on for second over the laterunning Impeachment (Deputy Minister).

No Fun for Fusaichi

Sent off at 1-5 in his quest for the Triple Crown, Fusaichi Pegasus appeared to dislike the sticky going in his runner-up finish. "He couldn't handle the track," said trainer Neil Drysdale. "That's the way I saw it, that's the way Kent [jockey Desormeaux] saw it. It was a greasy kind of track and he just couldn't go with it." Desormeaux knew he was in trouble on the turn. "We were together, the winner and I, we both pushed a button, and he [Red Bullet] opened up on me," said Desormeaux. "He just ran wild." Despite the denied Crown, the Derby winner will point for the Belmont. "If he comes of this race all right, he'll go to New York," said Drysdale. *Preakness chart p.2*

IT'S ALL ALJABR

Aljabr set the pace and made all with relative ease to bring his Group 1 winning tally to three here, and launch a four-year-old campaign which may see his connections experiment with ten furlongs for the first time in the horse's career. In 1999 he returned to England to take the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood in July, but on either side of that race had the misfortune to cross paths with joint top-rated European miler Sendawar (Ire), in the G1 St James Palace S. at Ascot in June, and the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp in September. Here he broke well and was soon swinging along in front, with the field lining up behind ready to expose any chinks in the favourite's armour. Yet when push came to shove, Indian Lodge (Ire) drifted left under pressure, taking Sugarfoot (GB) (Thatching {Ire}) with him, and Trans Island (GB) did not have the speed to close the gap as Aljabr lengthened to a comforatble two-length win. Trainer Saeed bin Suroor was delighted. "We've had a slow start, but we knew our horses. Aljabr has recovered from his problem last year [when he cracked his knee bone in the Prix du Moulin], and he was very quick and very good today. Mentally and physically he's done very well and he's stronger than last year. We think that maybe he will stay a mile-and-aquarter this year."

Champion Beautiful Pleasure ended 1999 with three straight stakes wins, taking the Aug. 27 GI Personal Ensign H., Oct. 10 GI Beldame S. and Nov. 6 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, but things did not go her way in her 2000 debut. Bet down to 4-5 in the Apr. 9 Gl Apple Blossom H., the bay was too fresh early and then ran into traffic at the quarter pole en route to a disappointing fifth-place finish. She made amends for that effort here. Going right to the front, she set solid fractions while unchallenged on the lead and dashed away from her rivals down the lane to win as she pleased. "She was well within herself the entire time," Chavez said. "I knew she was the best filly in the race." Added trainer John Ward Jr., "She'll get a lot out of this race. She's not wound down tight by any means. She'll only get fitter and in better racing shape off this race." The fiveyear-old will return to her home base in Kentucky, returning to Belmont three weeks before her next target, the June 24 GI Hempstead H.

Abby Girl finished determinedly for her first graded score and in the process remained unbeaten in 2000. A daylight winner of her first two starts at two, both sprints, the chestnut filly was less effective at longer distances, winding up 1999 with a third behind Surfside in the GI Hollywood Starlet in December. Shortened up for her return, she rallied three wide to take the Santa Paula S. at Santa Anita Apr. 16 and breezed twice on the lawn in preparation for this outing. Stalking the pace while saving ground, she split rivals in midstretch before finding room along the fence, getting the nod in the final strides. "The only thing that bothered me was that we drew the rail," remarked trainer Craig Dollase. "But Corey rode her perfectly, and he got her there. She just tries all the way to the wire, and that's what I love about her."

Dr. Max started his career over a muddy Pimlico strip, besting cheap maiden claimers by six lengths last June, and went on to win five of his next six. The gray spoiled the streak after he lost his jockey when swerving during the stretch run of a Laurel allowance in August, but rebounded to take four in a row, the last three in photo finishes. He hadn't visited the winner's circle since taking an optional claimer at Laurel Dec. 9, but came back after a 2 1/2-month layoff to be second in the Apr. 15 Fire Plug S. over this track last time out. The longest shot in this field, the colt trailed for a half, but came flying down the wide outside in the stretch to catch Moon Over Prospect at the wire.

Saiko Kirara was the winner of her first three career starts, including a 1 3/4-length success in the G2 Yonsai Himba Tokubetsu going seven furlongs at Hanshin two back Mar. 12. The 4-5 favorite in the Apr. 8 G1 Oka Sho (Japanese 1000 Guineas) in her most recent effort, the dark bay lacked the needed punch in the stretch and finished fourth, beaten about three lengths. She could make amends at solid odds today. Cheers Grace, second to Saiko Kirara at Tokyo in her seasonal debut Feb. 5, was 10th in Group 3 company at Hanshin Mar. 4, but pulled off a 17-1 surprise in the Oka Sho, winning by 1 1/2 lengths. She comes into the race on the heels of a brilliant seven-furlong workout this past Wednesday in 1:21. Silk Prima Donna won her first two career outs by 16 lengths combined before finishing second in the Yonsai Himba Tokubetsu. Third, just two lengths behind Cheers Grace in the Oka Sho, the bay looks to rediscover her winning ways this afternoon.

Overseas-trained runners look set to dominate this Italian Classic, which has attracted the largest field since 1973, with the raiders led by Godolphin's Dignify, the English trio Naval Affair, Croeso Cariad and Tanzilla, and the German-trained Well Minded. Dignify, formerly trained in France by David Loder, won the G3 Prix d'Aumale at Chantilly in September, when Well Minded was a short neck second, but was then unplaced in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac in October and has yet to run this term. 
