SENDAWAR CAPTURES PRIX D'ISPAHAN

Sendawar (Ire) (Priolo) was establishing his name among the great horses to have run in the famous green and red colours of the Aga Khan last year, after taking the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas), St James' Palace S. and Prix du Moulin de Longchamp. Soft ground stopped him from finishing the job, by ruling him out of the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois and Queen Elizabeth II S., but his on-track work may well be complete by the end of the year if his sensational performance in yesterday's G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp is a sign of things to come. Racing beyond a mile for the first time since he was second to Montjeu (Ire) here in the G2 Prix Greffulhes last April, the bay was settled in second early as Indian Danehill (Ire) (Danehill) took the field along at a steady gallop. Sendawar was ridden with the utmost cool by Gerald Mosse until the straight, where the temptation to let him go and use his power with two furlongs remaining proved too much. He accelerated clear within strides without being asked a serious question, and put the race to sleep in an instant to record a facile success in his return to the races. Trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre knew the going would not stop his charge. "I inspected the course early this afternoon and I could see that it was not too soft. He is a much stronger horse than last season and that helps. He is in the G1 Eclipse S. (Sandown, July 8), and that is where he will probably go next. He has won over a mile-and-a-quarter first time out last year, and over fast ground he seems capable of staying the trip against the best." The Aga Khan added, "He has improved since last year, and he has made natural progress. He should have a good season." Chart p. 2

TIMI WINS ONE FOR THE HOME TEAM

Italian-trained horses have bucked the trend of recent years by winning all three Italian Classics run so far this year and Italians filled the win and place spots in yesterday's G1 Oaks d'Italia in Milan. Winner of the Listed Premio Gino Mantovani here last July, Timi (GB) (Alzao) began this campaign with victories in two Rome conditions events and was then half-length runner up to Xua (Ire) in the G2 Premio Regina Elena (Italian 1000 Guineas) in Rome Apr. 30. Partnered by Italy's champion jockey Mirco Demuro, Timi raced in midfield until the turn into the straight as Godolphin raider Dignify (Ire) (Rainbow Quest), having her first start of the year, set the pace. Early in the straight the outsider Polar Charge (GB) (Polar Falcon), unplaced in the Regina Elena, grabbed the lead from Dignify and was still in command 300 metres out where Demuro set his mount alight. Responding to his urgings, Timi quickened brilliantly to come through to catch Polar Charge in the final strides for a dramatic victory.

This trial for the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes (French Oaks, Chantilly June 11) was dominated by the entries of last year's joint top-rated juvenile filly Goldamix (Ire) (Linamix (Fr)) and Criquette Head's promising America (Ire) (Arazi), but it was the maiden Reve D'Oscar who came through the test with a game maiden success in her first try in Group 1 company. A promising second in her debut at Saint-Cloud last year behind Folie Danse, Reve d'Oscar returned to twice fill the runner-up spot this season at the same course, the latter of which came in the G3 Prix Penelope Apr. 12, where Folie Danse was fifth. Settled in last early as Goldamix towed them along racing keenly, Reve d'Oscar made headway before the final turn, in a position to challenge as they entered the straight. As America failed to fire and Goldamix faded, the eventual winner joined battle with Hidalquia and Folie Danse on either side, managed to get on top with a hundred yards remaining, going away in the end to win a shade comfortably. Trainer Myriam Bollack-Badel said, "We will come back in the Prix de Diane Hermes with legitimate ambitions. My filly is a good one and I have always thought a lot of her. She was unlucky on her first run this year when ridden by an apprentice and she should not have been a maiden going into the race today. We were soundly beaten by a good filly last time but you never know what can happen in racing. She is the third Prix Saint-Alary winner that I have bought at the sales after Prodice (Fr) won in 1972, and Air De Rien (GB) (who won in 1990)." Goldamix, reported to have needed the run, will also go to Chantilly to take her on in the Classic.

Muhtathir continued the good run for the older Godolphin horses with this easy victory at a track where he won the G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua in October. Two months after that win, he was sent to Sha Tin to finish fourth in the G2 Hong Kong Mile. Off the track until Mar. 28, he finished third in the Godolphin Mile at Nad Al Sheba in Dubai. Adopting his usual front-running tactics here, he set a searching pace, which effectively burnt off the English raider Alrassaam (GB) (Zafonic), who had tried to go with him, in the final furlong.

PRIX VICOMTESSE VIGIER-G2 results cont.

Amilynx's finest hour last season came when he took the G1 Prix Royal Oak here in October, defeating Tajoun (Fr). He progressed throughout last year, and has clearly trained on at least as good as he was, with fine efforts when seventh behind Fantastic Light in the G3 Dubai Sheema Classic over an inadequate 10 furlongs Mar. 25, and when successful in the G3 Prix de Barbeville here Apr. 30. He gave weight away all around here in delivering a solid performance. Settled well in fourth early, he was swinging along on the bridle until the pace increased with six furlongs remaining. Asked to quicken by Olivier Peslier, the odds-on choice eventually got into top gear and hit the front easily enough inside the final furlong, before staying on well under hands-and-heels riding to hold off the late run of Le Tintoret. Roland de Longevialle, Racing Manager for Jean-Luc Lagardere, said, "He could go for the G1 Ascot Gold Cup (June 22), but a decision is not made yet. He could also wait for the staying races in the autumn, or we can try something different and run him over a shorter trip, in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud (July 22)."

Preakness Top Three May Meet in Belmont:

Red Bullet (Unbridled) returned from his victory in Saturday's GI Preakness S. in fine shape, according to trainer Joe Orseno. "He came back great, no nicks or anything," Orseno said from his Belmont base. "Right now, I'd say we're 50-50 to go in the Belmont (June 10). We'll probably take a week to make a decision."

Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr. Prospector) came out of his runner-up finish in the Preakness with a small cut under his knee, according to trainer Neil Drysdale. "He pulled up well after the race and was quite bright and playing in the test barn," the conditioner said. "He seems quite happy. He wasn't tired. He'll leave Pimlico at six in the morning (Monday) and temporarily will go to Aqueduct." Drysdale thinks his colt will be suited to the 1 1/2-mile Belmont S. "He's a big, long-striding horse," he commented. The Derby winner is zero-for-two in races called by track announcer Michael Wrona. Wrona was Hollywood Park's announcer when Fusaichi Pegasus finished second in his Dec. 11 debut and Wrona called the Preakness for ABC Radio.

Impeachment (Deputy Minister) was fine after his third-place Preakness effort. The colt left Pimlico by van for Belmont Park at 6 a.m. Sunday. "The plan all a long was to run in the Preakness and then go in the Belmont," explained trainer Todd Pletcher. "He ran a good race and we're very pleased. Assuming everything goes well now, he'll run in the Belmont."

YEARLING SALE GETS UNDER WAY

The Scone HTBA yearling sale got under way yesterday, with a total of 170 lots going through the ring at the White Park complex for an average \$15,756 and gross of \$2,676,500. The top price at the sale was \$80,000 for a Danzero (Aus)--Translantic (Atlantic Flyer {Aus}) filly offered by Arrowfield and knocked down to trainer Steve Englebrecht. Second highest price was for a Dehere (USA)--Greek Miss (Aus) filly, hammered down for a final bid of \$57,500 to Darrell Cooper. A filly by Rory's Jester (Aus)--Jade Court (Aus) filly made \$56,000, accounting for the third highest-priced yearling of the opening session. Lot 144, the Dolphin Street (Fr) half-brother to Lord Essex (Aus), was knocked down to Olympia Bloodstock for \$45,000, while Lot 206, a Dolphin Street (Fr)--Marillion (Aus) (Rory's Jester {Aus}) colt was puchased by Ron Dufficy for \$50,000. The sale continues today with a second and final session.

DOLPHINS SWIM DOWN UNDER

The owners of 55 mares who patronised Dolphin Street (Fr) at a reduced fee last spring--he stood at \$6,000, down from \$8,000 in 1998--will be encouraged by his solid sale ring performance to date. Last season Dolphin Street's produce averaged \$50,000 at auction and his sole Easter offering, a big strapping colt from Testa Rossa's dam Bo Dapper (Sir Dapper {Aus}) fetched \$500,000. Robert Sangster noted ruefully during his recent visit to Collingrove Stud that he'd sold Dolphin Street (Fr) before second-crop representative Road To Success won the G1 Blue Diamond S. in early March. Even though the French-bred son of Bluebird (Ire) is among shuttle stallions who have failed to scale the steep heights expected of their ilk, the 10-year-old stallion managed a first-crop stakes winner in speedy two-year-old Fappiano's Son. It was a while before Dolphin Street was heard from again, that is until Road To Success became his first graded stakes winner. A \$19,000 purchase, Road To Success is among stakes winners including last weekend's G2 Queensland Guineas victor Magnifier, who beat AJC Derby winner Fairway (Danzero {Aus}). Dolphin Street also has sired the talented filly Spinning Hill, as well as several stakes placed runners among his 41 winners from 124 starters to date. Yesterday's Hunter Thoroughbred Breeders' Association Yearling Sale at Scone provided further evidence of the young stallion's appeal, as he was the sire of two of the top five priced yearlings during the opening session.
