CAN THEY FLY?

A field of 10 three-year-olds will go to the post for today's GII Peter Pan S. at Belmont Park. For some, it is a chance to prove they are fast enough to join the cream of their crop in the June 10 GI Belmont S. Globalize (Summer Squall) was kicked off the Triple Crown trail--literally. The winner of the Mar. 25 GII Turfway Park Spiral S. (his lone previous try at the Peter Pan distance) and runner-up in the Apr. 22 GII Coolmore Lexington S., he was kicked by the stable pony while training for the Kentucky Derby and had to skip the race. "It has healed nicely and we haven't missed a work with him," trainer Jerry Hollendorfer said. "He's been really happy at Belmont." He added, "It's always nice to have a fresh horse in these races...but we would have liked to run in the Derby." The chestnut has been first or second in seven of his nine career starts. Unshaded (Unbridled), winless in two starts at two, has come around this season, going a perfect three-for-three to date. He made his stakes debut in the Lexington and rallied for a three-length score, and blew out for this race with a bullet five furlongs in the mud at Churchill May 23. "He's always been real professional," Sara Dunham, assistant to trainer Carl Nafzger, said. "He has beaten some nice horses and this race should serve as a nice gauge of his ability." Runspastum, fifth making his stakes bow in the Spiral after taking two in a row at Gulfstream Park, ran his record since the addition of blinkers to three-for-four with a win in the Apr. 22 Federico Tesio S. at Pimlico last time out. Five horses have used a win in the Peter Pan as a stepping stone to a Belmont S. triumph: Gallant Man, Cavan, Coastal, Danzig Connection and A.P. Indy.

LUCKY 13 IN IRISH 1000

A full field of 13 fillies will answer the call for tomorrow's G1 Entenmann's Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh. While the British-trained horses have a fine record in this Classic, providing six of the winners in the 1990s, Ireland knows how to defend itself when it comes to having a top-class filly in the race. One such prospect could be Michael Grassick's Preseli (Ire) (Caerleon), who will bid to follow the likes of Ridgewood Pearl (GB) and Kooyonga (Ire), Classic Park (GB) and Tarascon (Ire), who triumphed here for the home country during that decade. Rated the joint top juvenile filly of 1999 after success in the G1 Moyglare Stud S. here in September, she returned to give weight and a beating to her rivals in the Listed 1000 Guineas Trial Leopardstown May 14. That was a fine performance, as Guineas hopefuls Storm Dream (Ire) (Catrail) and Theoretically (Theatrical {Ire}) finished behind her that day. Storm Dream was receiving seven pounds, and although she went under by a short head, she will have to improve to figure here. She has been sold to Lael Stables in a deal negotiated by The Curragh Bloodstock Agency. After her Guineas run, she will continue her racing career in the U.S. The British challenge is spearheaded by the G1 English 1000 Guineas S. second and fourth, Princess Ellen (GB) (Tirol {Ire}) and Seazun (Ire) (Ziten) respectively, who chased home Lahan (GB) at Newmarket May 7. The latter boasts two-year-old form that includes success in the G1 Cheveley Park S., while the former's connections will be encouraged by the fact that three fillies who were second in the British 1000 went on to win the Irish equivalent in the last decade. Godolphin, who have yet to add this race to their tally, have supplemented Newmarket maiden winner Meiosis (Danzig), and although she looked very impressive that day, she faces a large task to overcome inexperience here. Aidan O'Brien provides five entries, among which is the progressive Chiang Mai (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), who came back this year to beat She's Our Mare (Ire) by a short head in a conditions race here Apr. 9, maintaining her unbeaten record in the process. Torgau, a Group 2 winner and twice Group 1 placed in Britain and Ireland last season, made her 2000 bow against the toughest company in the May 7 G1 English 1000 Guineas at Newmarket. Sent off at 25-1, she made a middle move, but flattened out to be seventh. The bay gets Lasix for her U.S. debut. Another import, Islay Mist, looks to go three-for-three on the year. A conditions winner on both turf and dirt in Britain, the bay was fourth in a stakes on the Fairplex main track in his U.S. bow last September, but came back after a sixmonth layoff to take an \$80,000 claiming race Mar. 15 and then rallied to success in the Apr. 28 GIII Senorita S. at Hollywood Park.

ERNIE SAMUEL DEAD Ernie Samuel, one of the most influential and powerful forces in Canadian Thoroughbred racing, passed away Thursday night. He was 69. Born in London, England, Samuel, a vice president of the Board of Directors of The Ontario Jockey Club, founded Sam-Son Farm in 1972. Sam-Son has received 39 Sovereign Awards for its horses, including Horse of the Year six times, leading Owner five times and top Breeder twice. In 1991, Samuel received an Eclipse Award in the U.S. as Owner of the Year. His horses have earned three Eclipse Awards: Dance Smartly (1991), Sky Classic (1992) and Chief Bearhart (1997). In addition, Sam-Son Farm bred and owned two Canadian Triple Crown winners--Regal Intention (1988) and Dance Smartly (1991). "Ernie Samuel was one of the giants of Thoroughbred racing, both in Canada and internationally," said David Willmot, president and CEO of The Ontario Jockey Club. "He was a treasured friend, a man of great integrity and compassion and a tireless contributor to our sport in many capacities. His accomplishments in racing are immeasurable and our sense of loss is just as profound."

LORD FLASHEART TO CALIFORNIA One of this season's better French-trained three-year-olds, Alain de Royer-Dupre's Lord Flasheart (Blush Rambler), has reportedly been sold to American owner Edmund Gann and will continue his racing career in the U.S. after one final run in Europe. The gutsy winner of the 11-furlong G2 Prix Hocquart at Chantilly May 8, he was a leading candidate for this year's G1 Emirates Airline Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly June 4, but will point instead to the nine-furlong G1 Prix Jean Prat Emirates Airline on the same card. He will then ship to California, where he will be stabled at Bobby Frankel's barn.



Puncher went gate to wire to take an Aqueduct allowance test over a sloppy strip Apr. 21, but tired badly trying turf for the first time in his latest and finished eighth and last in that May 13 event. Shortening up off that mile effort and going turf to dirt, the gray went right to the lead, set serious fractions and held the 7-5 chalk Unreal Madness at bay for the score. The runner-up was disqualified and placed third for bothering Truly Topflight during the drive.

DERBY HOPES TO THE RACES FOR WORKS King's Best (USA) (Kingmambo {USA}), winner of the G1 2000 Guineas S. at Newmarket May 6, will travel to Sandown racecourse for a canter Monday morning as part of his preparation for the June 10 G1 Epsom Derby S. He will be accompanied by a stable companion over seven furlongs at 7:30 a.m. The colt has suffered close examination after losing his chance at the start of the G1 Dewhurst S. by being too keen in the race, which had led to doubts about his temperament in the lead-up to the G1 2000 Guineas S. He dispelled those doubts with a remarkable winning performance, but he was described by trainer Sir Michael Stoute as "a horse with a lot of nervous energy." Joe Mercer, Racing Manager to owner Saeed Suhail, commented: "He's just a very good racehorse, and his temperament is wonderful. He's going down to Sandown as part of his preparation, and at Sandown he can hear the mics. As for the Derby, he's bred to stay a mile-and-a-half, and we're hopeful he'll stay and handle the track." Another trainer preparing to go to the races with his Derby hopefuls as part of the training plan is Henry Cecil, who takes Beat Hollow (GB) (Sadler's Wells {USA}), Wellbeing (GB) (Sadler's Wells USA}) and Bien Entendu (GB) (Hernando {Fr}) to Yarmouth Wednesday. The colts had all scoped with mucus in the lungs, which meant that they missed their racecourse trials in preparation for the G1 Epsom Derby S., but they are back at work now.
