### BACHIR BEATS THE HISTORY BOOKS

Becoming the first horse ever to complete the double, Godolphin's Bachir (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}), winner of the May 13 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas) and off at 4-1 this time, made all the running to take yesterday's G1 Irish 2000 Guineas S. at The Curragh by a neck over 9-10 favourite Giant's Causeway (Storm Cat). A really professional racehorse, Bachir progressed from two to three, and has built on each performance to make his own piece of history. Last year he followed success in the G2 Richmond S. at Goodwood in July with two third places behind the Ballydoyle pair of Fasliyev in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville in August, and Giant's Causeway in the G1 Prix de la Salamandre at Longchamp in September. This season he has even acquitted himself on dirt, winning the Kron Derby before chasing home stablemate China Visit in the UAE Derby at Nad Al Sheba Mar. 25. His French Classic victory was fair warning that he had made the necessary improvement to turn the tables on Giant's Causeway here, and he did so under a clever ride from jockey Frankie Dettori. Setting out to control the pace from the front, Dettori had things his own way as Giant's Causeway tracked him in second, with Cape Town (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}) close up in third. As they quickened from three furlongs out, Bachir held off Cape Town and Giant's Causeway on either side, getting down to battle it out in the closing stages when it looked as if the Ballydoyle horse might get to him. He always had too much, however, and held on well in an exciting finish. Dettori said, "Luckily for us the ground has dried up, as he needs to roll on good ground. I nicked a length two furlongs out, and the favourite ran out of ground. He tries very hard and he quickens well on good ground. He's won two Guineas, so he deserves credit." Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford commented, "He's a top-class, versatile horse, and he battled well. He'll now be put to the test at Royal Ascot by China Visit in the G1 St James' Palace S. (June 20)." While Cape Town improved on his unplaced effort in the English Guineas, Barathea Guest (GB) (Barathea {Ire}) took too long to get going, but managed a strong final run to finish a respectable fourth. ### PRADO, POSTPONED PERFECT IN PAN

A perfectly judged ride propelled Postponed (Summer Squall) to a 3/4-length victory over even money Unshaded (Unbridled) in yesterday's GII Peter Pan at Belmont Park. The 1/2-length winner of an entry-level allowance at Gulfstream Feb. 12, the Scotty Schulhofer charge was fifth in the GI Florida Derby and an even sixth in the GII Wood Memorial at Agueduct Apr. 15 in his next two outs. Most recently, the bay was a pacepressing second against his elders at Aqueduct May 3 and was sent off a 9-1 chance back in against his peers. Postponed bided his time at the back of the pack, but began an advance on the far turn. Jockey Edgar Prado shifted Postponed towards a narrow gap along the rail once into the stretch, got through and withstood a solid late run from the favorite to prevail. "This is a real nice little horse," said Schulhofer, who trained last year's Belmont winner Lemon Drop Kid. "He's bred to go long. If everything is all right, we'll definitely consider the Belmont." Trainer Carl Nafzger was pleased with the effort of the runner-up. "I thought he ran a terrific race. He gave 10 pounds to the winner and he was getting to him near the end," he said. Nafzger indicated that owner Jim Tafel would make the final call on whether to pay the \$100,000 supplement for the Belmont. "Right now I've got no gut feeling about it," Nafzger added.

Akhenaton, a A\$70,000 Magic Millions graduate who only broke his maiden status at Newcastle six starts back, will now target next month's Queensland Derby following his all-the-way victory here. "As an early three-year-old he ran second behind (subsequent AJC Derby winner) Fairway (Aus) over 1,500 metres and we've deliberately run him up in grade a lot," said trainer Bill Mitchell. "He's a horse that takes at least four runs to get fit every preparation." Said jockey Glen Boss, "He's got a great ability to switch off and has good barrier speed. Potentially he's a top-class horse."

After breaking her maiden over the Santa Anita lawn Jan. 14, Classy Cara was switched to the main track to win the San Jose S. by six lengths at Bay Meadows, a win which encouraged trainer Doug O'Neill to try her against the best of her division. The chestnut put in a sustained late run to finish third, just three parts of a length behind Surfside in the GI Santa Anita Oaks before shipping to Oaklawn to win the GII Fantasy S. by 1 1/2 lengths. Third by eight lengths in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 5, the Washington bred was let go at 6-1 in her return to the infield. Classy Cara was eager to run from the gate, but jockey Iggy Puglisi was able to relax her in eighth position under a long hold down the backstretch. Kentucky Oaks favorite Kumari Continent assumed a short lead turning for home, but by then, Puglisi had his filly in top gear, hit the front inside the final sixteenth and inched away late, despite lugging in a bit. "I've had some good horses, but never one of this quality," O'Neill commented. "I'm thrilled because I had to wonder if this race was coming back too quick, but she had been eating everything we put in front of her and she had trained well."

A confirmed sprinter, Peach Flat celebrated the highpoint of his career last summer when following up a neck victory in the Pirate's Bounty S. at Del Mar with a bang-up, 1/2-length second to Big Jag in the California Sprint Championship H. at Bay Meadows. Off form since, the gelding showed some signs of life when third in the Ken Maddy Sprint H. at the Bay two back, but was most recently sixth in a Santa Anita optional claimer Mar. 15. Making his first-ever start at this trip and first beyond 6 1/2 furlongs, jockey Jose Valdivia took advantage of his rail draw to put the six-year-old on the engine from the start. Challenged on the far turn by Boss Ego, Peach Flat dug in gamely and just held for his first graded-stakes success.

#### A Fly in the Calder Ointment:

Calder General Manager Randy Soth has a problem. The track has flies. At the beginning of the year, the co-regeneration plant where Calder was sending its straw and manure had a fire and shut down for a couple of weeks. That was the beginning of the fly problem. A re-generating plant is a privately run company that takes in certain combustible materials, for a price, and converts it into energy. Before the fire, the plant's main source of combustibles was six trucks a day six days a week from Calder and an endless supply sugar cane leaves from the surrounding county. Currently they are only taking a fraction of that number of trucks from Calder, creating the fly problem. Soth is mired in complaints from horsemen as he tries to solve the problem. "We are spraying for flies and spreading powder to try and keep the population down," said Soth. "Those are short term solutions." The long term solution is for Calder to build their own re-generation plant, a costly project. "Florida Power and Light estimates it will run around \$5 million," Soth said. "Then they buy back the electricity at one penny a kilowatt, which they resell for eight cents." If Calder built the plant on their property and used the power, they could offset the \$85,000 a month electric bill they currently run up when they're racing, and if they could talk Gulfstream and Hialeah into paying to dump their straw and manure, they could start paying down the \$5 million start-up cost.

The two-year-olds include colts and fillies by the leading and proven sires Acatenango (Ger), Big Shuffle (USA), Goofalik (USA), Lagunas (GB), Lomitas (GB) and Platini (Ger) as well as the smart young sire Sternkonig (Ire).

### **GELSENKIRCHEN GROUP 1 SAVED FOR NOW**

The G1 Gelsenkirchen-Pokal, one of Germany's most prestigious events, will remain at the financially troubled track, for now. It became clear last week that Gelsenkirchen racetrack could not survive without another substantial loan from its banking partner, and the German Jockey Club had demanded a security sum of DM300,000, or the Group 1 race would have to be re-routed to another track. On Friday, Gelsenkirchen's managing director Helmut Kappes was relieved to announce that the bank had guaranteed the demanded sum. A sponsor for this year's edition of the Gelsenkirchen-Pokal has still to be found.

#### **BREMEN TO MODERNISE**

The senate of Bremen has granted a huge investment package amounting to DM15.8 million in order to modernise the city's racetrack. It is the most substantial loan granted in German racing history. The track will be completely modernised and a new training centre will be built under the management of leading German architect Ferdinand Leve. Gunther Gudert, Bremen's managing director, is now optimistic that these future plans will persuade trainer Andreas Wohler to stay in Bremen instead of making his planned move to Dortmund.

#### MILKSHAKE CLARITY NEEDED

Vets have called for an independent public inquiry into pre-race bicarbonate levels in racehorses. Australian Equine Veterinary Association president Dr David Lovell said the inquiry was needed to establish and properly define the maximum acceptable level of bicarbonate (TCO2) in horses about to race. In Thoroughbreds, the maximum level has been set at 36 millimoles per litre with a tolerance of 1.2 millimoles, while the level for harness racing horses is lower at 35 millimoles. Substances such as sodium bicarbonate can be administered to a horse via a tube to delay the onset of lactic acid build-up during a race. The issue surfaced again last week after the gelding Far Beyond (Aus) was found to have an elevated TCO2 level detected in a test taken before he ran in the Tamworth Cup on May 12. Trainer Tim Martin will front a Thoroughbred Racing Board stewards' inquiry on Monday over the incident. Far Beyond is the first Thoroughbred in New South Wales to record a high reading.

#### CYCLING TOUR TURNS SOUR FOR HAYES

A cycling tour of Tuscany by leading trainer Peter Hayes turned disastrous when he rode over an oil slick and broke his hip. The leading trainer in Melbourne and Adelaide with a combined total of 109 wins, Hayes will spend 45 days in traction.
