#### WHO'S THE BEST MILER OF THEM ALL?

Eight horses, eight furlongs. Who will come out on top in today's GI Met Mile at Belmont Park? Sir Bear (Sir Leon), winner of the '99 Met, boasts a perfect four-forfour record at a mile. The seven-year-old had finished off the board in three straight, but rebounded to take the Apr. 22 GIII Texas Mile by a head in his latest. "His best game is a flat mile, especially a one-turn mile, trainer Ralph Ziadie said. "A mile and an eighth is too long and seven furlongs is too short." If the gelding gets his second Met Mile trophy, he will be the third to take back-to-back runnings, following in the footsteps of Gulch and the mighty Forego. The late-running Sir Bear will have plenty of pace in front of him. Likely to be on the lead are GIII Westchester H. winner Yankee Victor (Saint Ballado) and Richter Scale (\*Habitony), who goes for his fifth consecutive stakes win. Yankee Victor has blossomed since having surgery in January. The fourvear-old had one of his testicles removed, then came back to win an allowance at that track Feb. 5. Second in the Mar. 11 GIII Creme Fraiche H., he then handed subsequent GI Pimlico Special winner Golden Missile a 3 3/4-length defeat in the Westchester and added an Aqueduct allowance win May 6, speeding the mile in 1:33 2/5 that afternoon. "Since [the surgery], we've had a new horse," trainer Carlos Morales said, adding, "He always runs on the lead. I don't think it's a good idea to change that." He could have company in Richter Scale, who was fourth after setting the pace in the 1997 Met Mile, but didn't compete in the last two editions. The six-year-old jumps up in class after taking the Apr. 16 GII Commonwealth Breeders' Cup S. at Keeneland. "This is obviously going to be his toughest test yet," said trainer Mary Jo Lohmeier. "He's doing well and now's the time to try. This is a race the owners have pointed for because this race makes stallions." That's not a factor for Big Jag (Kleven). The seven-yearold gelding makes his Belmont debut after winning the Mar. 25 Dubai Golden Shaheen S.; he was also third in the Dec. 12 Hong Kong Sprint, sandwiching a second in the GII Palos Verdes H. between the two international outings. "We've always felt more confident at seven furlongs than at six," trainer Tim Pinfield said. "I don't know if he will get the mile, but the way he runs, it looks like he should." (Met Field, p. 5)

#### CRIMPLENE COMPLETES GUINEAS DOUBLE

Clive Brittain's Crimplene (Ire) (Lion Cavern) made virtually all the running at 16-1 to take yesterday's Irish 1000 Guineas at the Curragh from 7-1 shot Amethyst (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) and earn her second Guineas success. She is fast gaining a reputation as a globe-trotter, having wintered and run in Dubai before racing in Britain, Italy, Germany and now Ireland. Her time in Dubai was well-spent, as she ran sixth in the UAE Derby at Nad Al Sheba Mar. 25, form which is looking very solid. On her return to Britain, she was third behind Iftiraas (GB) in the G3 Dubai Duty Free S. Newbury Apr. 14, and the decision was made by her owner to go to Italy. She finished a creditable third to Xua (Ire) in the G2 Premio Regina Elena (Italian 1000 Guineas) at Rome Apr. 30, before winning the G2 Henkel-Rennen (German 1000 Guineas) at Dusseldorf May 7 in a time just over a second faster than the English version. Here, she broke well and took to the front and was only headed briefly before the turn by Bells Are Ringing (Sadler's Wells). The rest of the race was hers and jockey Philip Robinson's. Amethyst looked as though she might go past with two furlongs remaining, as the favourites Meiosis (Danzig) and Preseli (Ire) (Caerleon) made no headway, but the winner found more as she ran towards the rail. This helped straighten her for a powerful finish which took her safely to her second Classic success. Trainer Clive Brittain was ecstatic after the win, but also mulled over what might have been. "I'm absolutely delighted to come here and have another winner," said Brittain. "I thought we should have run in the (English) 1000 Guineas, but Sheikh Marwan said to go to Italy, where she was third, and then we won in Germany, but I think if we'd have gone for the English and then the German, we would have won both. I'll have to speak to the owner, but I'd have thought we'll go for the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot (June 23), and then let them all come."

The winner of two of five starts since being transferred to trainer Eduardo Inda's barn, Riboletta had announced herself a presence to be reckoned with in the older filly and mare division on the West Coast with a win in the GI Santa Margarita H. and the GII Hawthorne H. in her last start May 7. The latter was an awesome display--a front-running seven-length win over Excellent Meeting, among others. Second choice to that rival in their last meeting, she was accorded more respect here as the even-money choice to Excellent Meeting's 5-2. Breaking from the inside, she dueled for the lead down the backstretch under a snug hold from jockey Chris McCarron with Spanish Fern (El Gran Senor), Bordelaise and Smooth Player (Bertrando) to her outside. The group laid down quick early fractions of :23 and 45 4/5. "I was surprised we were pressed that early and that forcefully," said McCarron, who let her out just a notch on the turn and she inched away, turning for home with the lead and drawing clear through the stretch with one crack of the whip and a strong hand ride. Excellent Meeting saved ground in fourth early, tried to slip through on the rail at the top of the stretch but found no room and was switched to the outside, but could not get close to the winner. Riboletta ran down on her right hind, but Inda did not appear overly concerned. "It happens to a lot of horses," he said. "A couple days and it should be okay." He said that the June 25 GI Vanity H. at nine furlongs would be next.

Montjeu returned with a vengeance to win this Group 1 contest unextended, his performance matched only by the nerves of steel diplayed by his jockey to squeeze through horses with 100 yards remaining. After a threeyear-old season which included wins in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club, Irish Derby and Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, his connections might have been excused for rushing him off to stud, but the decision was made to allow racegoers to enjoy him for another year. The winner of last year's Irish Derby may have been more impressive on his return to the Curragh here despite some pre-race antics; he refused to go into the parade ring, forcing his handlers to bring him in through a side entrance. Once the race was underway, though, all was smooth; he was kept in fourth on the rail early as Urban Ocean (Fr) (Bering {GB}) set a fair pace. His jockey held on to him for as long as it took, as first Mutafaweq, and then Greek Dance (Ire) arrived at the front of affairs with a furlong remaining. It looked as if he may not find room, but a confident Kinane saw enough daylight to bring the huge horse through and swept between the leaders for the win. "There was just a little worry, as it looked difficult for Mick to come through," said owner Michael Tabor, "but he won very easily in the end, and I'm very happy. It's very exciting for the races ahead this year. He'll race at a mile-and-a-quarter, and at the end of the year at a mile-and-a-half, with the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe and Breeders' Cup Turf as targets."

Although Kallisto did not get off the mark in two races last year, he has progressed into an impressive individual in 2000 and came into this race undefeated in two starts in the new year. The winner of a conditions race at Frankfurt Mar. 26, Kallisto also accounted for the G3 Fruhjahrspreis at the same course Apr. 23. Germany proudly boasts if ever there was a consistent horse, it is Kalatos. The eight-year-old won last year's Fruhjahrs Meile at Cologne in April and was placed in a further four Group or Listed races. Picking up where he left off last year, he reappeared with a second-place finish in the G3 Buchmacher Lindner Trophy at Gelsenkirchen Apr. 9, and followed up by winning the Listed Excelsior Hotel Ernst-Meile at Cologne Apr. 30 in his only other start this year. He had to dig deep into his reserves to fend off the challenge of Bernardon to add this race to his portfolio. Nobody seemed willing to make the running but Alabama Jacks (Ire) (Magical Wonder) took the initiative with Faberger prominent. As the field entered the straight, Alabama Jacks began to fade and Kalatos began to make his move. It was Kalatos and Bernardon who went in the last furlong or so and the pair hooked up for a driving battle to the line with the former just prevailing. Faberger kept on well in the closing stages and held on safely for third as Jashin (Ire) (Soviet Star) finished in good style.

Trainer Joe Orseno has announced that Preakness winner Red Bullet (Unbridled) will skip the June 10 GI Belmont S. "We don't want to squeeze the lemon dry," Orseno explained after conferring with owner Frank Stronach. "We already won the Preakness with a horse that didn't race as a two-year-old and we think it's best to give him more time in between his races right now." Red Bullet will now be pointed to the Aug. 6 GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park with the Aug. 26 GI Travers S. as his major goal. "It comes down to knowing your horse," explained Orseno. "Neil Drysdale (trainer of Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus) knows his horses and sometimes gets a little flack for the things he does. But we know our horse too, and this is the right thing to do," concluded Orseno.

#### PETER PAN POSTLUDE

Saturday's GII Peter Pan winner Postponed (Summer Squall) will, indeed, head to the June 10 Gl Belmont S., confirmed trainer Scotty Schulhofer yesterday. "He's bred to run forever," he said. "Red Bullet skipping the race opens things up a bit more." The Belmont status of runner-up Unshaded (Unbridled) won't be decided for several days, said trainer Carl Nafzger, who seemed to be leaning against it. "He's got a shot to be a real nice horse," he said. "My inclination right now is that he's not ready for the bears yet." Fourth-place finisher Tahkodha Hills (Prospector's Halo) will also likely point to the Belmont. "I thought there were some pretty nice horses in the Peter Pan and he didn't disgrace himself," said trainer Ralph Ziadie. "He'll stay here at Belmont and train up to the race." In other Belmont S. news, Aptitude (A.P. Indy) worked six furlongs Sunday morning at Hollywood Park under jockey Alex Solis in 1:14 1/5.

Prince Fahd Salman will shift his focus from racing to Thoroughbred sales, according to a report on *Thoroughbred Times Online*. Salman, who raced the 1991 Epsom Derby winner Generous (Ire), cited his disappointment over the low purses in England and increased commitments in his native Saudi Arabia as reasons for his decision. According to a statement released by Newgate Stud, the Prince intends to disperse most of his yearlings at auction, but will keep and race a few fillies as broodmare prospects. "I'm not really surprised," Salman's trainer Paul Cole told the *London Times*. "If Prince Fahd has very important things to tend to at home, obviously racing is going to suffer. From my point of view, it's a shame because he has been a super owner and we've had some fantastic times together."
