YANKEE DOODLE DANDY

Coming off a pair of impressive victories at a mile, Yankee Victor (Saint Ballado) made it three in a row with a front-running win in yesterday's \$750,000 GI Met Mile at Belmont Park. Sent off the 4-1 co-third choice in the eight-horse field, the dark bay battled Straight Man (Saint Ballado) through a half in :45.58. turned back a challenge from Richter Scale (*Habitony) as they raced six furlongs in 1:10.04, then turned it on in the stretch to dash away to a 4 3/4-length score over the late-running Honest Lady (Seattle Slew), with 1999 Met Mile hero Sir Bear (Sir Leon) another three-quarters of a length back in third. Winning trainer Carlos Morales credited surgery performed last January to remove one of Yankee Victor's testicles with the winning streak. "After we did the surgery, he became a different horse," he said. "When he would come into the stretch and change leads, that was when it would bother him." As for the future, Morales said, "I would like to keep him at a mile." He cited the June 25 GIII Hanshin H. at Arlington as a possible next target. California shipper Big Jag (Kleven), the 5-2 favorite, made a move on the turn, but lacked a late kick and finished fourth. "He just seemed to tire," jockey Alex Solis said.

ALL HEART

White Heart (GB) (Green Desert), a Group 3 winner in Germany at the end of last August, came back after an eight-month layoff and made his U.S. debut in a Hollywood allowance May 10, posting a game three-quarter length triumph. Let go at 5-1 to make it two in a row, the Gainsborough-bred stalked the pace while saving ground, angled outside with a half mile to run and just got up to best 16-1 Self Feeder (Ire) (Lycius) by a neck. "They started sprinting at the half-mile pole, and my experience is that if you start sprinting there, you usually come up a little empty in the stretch," winning jockey Kent Desormeaux said. "I thought if I would... save my horse a bit, I'd have a good chance. It worked out very well." Trainer Neil Drysdale added, "His trainer [in Europe], Mark Johnston, said he is a very tough, game horse." The race was marred, however, as the 9-10 favorite Dark Moondancer (GB) (Anshan {GB}) had to be pulled up before they'd gone a half mile and was vanned off. "[Jockey Chris McCarron] said he heard something pop, but he said when he pulled him up he looked all right," Dark Moondancer's trainer, Ron McAnally, said. "He thought maybe something was wrong behind, but when he walked into the ambulance, he said he looked OK. I can honestly say he has never, never been unsound since we got him, so I don't know what happened here."

Perryston View is best known as a seasoned handicapper blazing away over sprint trips from Ayr to Newmarket, and before today his most notable success had come in the 1997 Ayr Silver Cup. Having proven himself in that company, connections have been more ambitious this year, taking in the Listed Palace House S. Newmarket May 6, and although he was unplaced there, he came back to win impressively in this Group 2 event. Taken to the front early, he was allowed to grab the rail and power away, which seemed to suit him as he quickly put distance between himself and the higherdrawn horses, who were struggling to close the gap from halfway. As both Sampower Star (GB) (Cyrano De Bergerac (Ire) and Imperial Beauty (Imperial Ballet (Ire)) floundered in the ground, the race was taking place up front as Rambling Bear and Proud Native tried in vain to catch the free-wheeling leader. Perryston View was not to be caught, however, and he captured this prize in style. Jockey John Reid said, "I was able to give him a breather and he picked up as soon as I asked him. He gave me a really good feel, the way he was travelling. He's a pretty good horse, he's very tough and now he's a Group 2 winner."

Never out of the top three in his brief career, Luftikus was a five-length winner of an entry-level allowance at Hollywood Park last May before being sidelined for seven months, and returned with a wireto-wire victory at Santa Anita Jan. 8. Second by 9 1/2 lengths to General Challenge in the GII Strub, the chestnut was runner up in a Santa Anita optional claiming event Mar. 1, but bounced right back to record his first stakes victory in the Tokyo City H. Mar. 24. Third, two lengths behind Sir Bear in the GIII Texas Mile Apr. 22, Luftikus was made the favorite here. Away very well from post 11, the colt tracked pacesetting Lexington Park (Williamstown) from second through a swift opening six furlongs in 1:08 4/5. Jockey David Flores asked Luftikus for more run turning for home to dispose of Lexington Park and finished well to hold Nite Dreamer safe for the victory.

The only filly in the field, Gold Mover broke her maiden at first asking on the next-to-last day of the Keeneland meet Apr. 26, coming from off the pace and four wide to mow down the opposition by 3 1/2 lengths. Shipped over to Churchill, the chestnut displayed her liking for the local strip with three very solid morning trials, most recently clocking four furlongs May 22 in :48 3/5, but was let go at 5-1. Odds-on Unbridled Time was off to an uncharacteristically slow start which enabled City Zip to set the pace, with Gold Mover tracking intently on the outside from second. The latter drew even with City Zip while between rivals turning for home, gained a short advantage inside the eighth pole and prevailed under vigorous urging. "She's the real deal," said jockey Craig Perret. "She broke real sharp and when I saw that Pat (Day aboard Unbridled Time) wasn't there, I decided to go on." The winner could reappear in Churchill's GIII Debutante vs. fillies July 8.

Mi Narrow, winner of the GIII Oceanport H. over this course last July, was off the board in his next three before rebounding with a win in the Meadowlands Endurance S. in October. He closed out the year with a fourth in an overnight handicap at Aqueduct Nov. 6, and returned to be second in the Mar. 25 GIII Bougainvillea H. at Gulfstream. But he failed to fire in his latest, running ninth in the Apr. 22 GII Hialeah Turf Cup H. over that course, and was let go at long odds here. Never far from the front, he rallied on the outside on the far turn and kept coming in the stretch to pick up the win. "He has been training well and he loves his home track, so I wanted to give him a shot in here," trainer Eddie Broome said. The 15-10 favorite Strategic Mission (Mr. Prospector), making his stakes debut following three consecutive allowance tallies, had, however, been off since Feb. 5. The dark bay pressed the pace, took over after six furlongs and was in the lead as they came into the stretch, but weakened in the final yards to be fifth.

Although Persian Punch may not be getting better with age, he seems to be getting ever more courageous and tough, and he entered the history books here by becoming the first horse to take this race three times. This year he was a short-head second to Orchestra Stall (GB) in the G3 Sagaro S. Ascot May 3 before disappointing when last in the G2 Yorkshire Cup York May 18. If there were any doubts that his best days had gone, he dispelled them with this battling success. Setting out to dictate the pace, he had the field struggling to pick him up from the back in the heavy ground. Only Churlish Charm looked a threat as they entered the straight, and he headed the game front runner with two furlongs remaining, but Persian Punch dug deep for reserves and forged his way back into the lead inside the final furlong to deny the younger horse. Favoured Arctic Owl could not get any closer than third. Owner John Smith paid tribute to his gelding, saying, "He's a magical horse, and he's at his best when he is in a fight. He finds extra every time." The trainer added, "I don't know what happened at York last time, but today he bounced back like his old self. Three times he's been to Royal Ascot (for the G1 Gold Cup), and he's run disappointingly each time, but Philip (Robinson) say's he'll get the two-and-a-half miles there." The jockey was punished for marking the horse by hitting him behind the saddle, and incurs a three-day ban, which will see him miss Epsom Oaks S. day June 9.

Squirtle Squirt ran fourth in his two-furlong debut at Santa Anita Apr. 21 before graduating from the maiden ranks with a 1 1/2-length score May 5 over this track and distance. The dark bay colt stalked the pace, bid three wide into the lane, exchanged bumps with Our Magistrate in deep stretch and won in a driving finish. "I was just looking for a place to go because I know he can run," commented winning rider Laffit Pincay. "I knew those horses in front of him were going to stop and I didn't want to get stuck on the inside. In the middle of the turn, I got a chance to get out and I got out. I lost a little bit of ground, but that's where I wanted to be. From then on, he finished really good."

Ataraxia ranged up on the outside to lead past midstretch and was joined by Air Shakur, but that one bore in late and Agnes Flight came with a strong late run to get his nose down on the line.



No one in the U.S. needs convincing about the merits of Mr. Prospector's stallion sons, but it has been a somewhat different story over in Europe. Mr. Prospector's status as a sire of sires suffered a sizeable setback when Hello Gorgeous, his first major European winner, proved a disaster as a stallion in Ireland during the 1980s. European studs did not rush to stand further sons of Mr. Prospector, who next tried to establish his male line with Procida in France and Damister in England. Procida quickly decamped for Kentucky, where he was to sire the Classic-winning French colt Shanghai, and Damister was in Japan by the time his extraordinary son Celtic Swing won the French Derby in 1995.

Mr. Prospector's best chance of establishing himself in Europe rested with his admirer Sheikh Mohammed. Aware that European breeders were becoming increasingly short of alternatives to the Northern Dancer male line, he acquired Mr. Prospector's champion French son Machiavellian for his Dalham Hall Stud and then added a second Group 1-winning son, Lycius, a year later in 1992. Lycius was transferred to his owner's Irish stallion station after one season, with his place at Dalham Hall eventually being taken in 1994 by Lion Cavern, yet another of Mr. Prospector's sons.

While Machiavellian is still very popular, Lycius and Lion Cavern fared less well at a lower level of the market. Neither attracted a full quota of mares in Europe in 1999 and they would probably have been even harder to fill this year, had they stayed.

Instead they are currently completing their first season in the U.S.--Lycius in Florida and Lion Cavern at Wimbledon Farm. I am sure both stallions have bright futures in their new homes, and Lion Cavern is busily reminding English breeders that it is dangerous to reach hasty conclusions about a young stallion. Two fillies from his third crop have recently done very well at Classic level, with Peony failing by only a neck to snatch victory in the G1 French 1000 Guineas a week after Crimplene had easily won the G2 German 1000 Guineas. Now Crimplene has notched a notable Classic double, leading virtually throughout in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas.

Lion Cavern himself contested the 1992 French 2000 Guineas, running well to finish third, beaten less than a length by Shanghai, but even his best form left him some way short of the champions of his generation. Neither Timeform nor the compilers of the International Classifications rated him higher than 117 during his two years in Europe, but a breakthrough looked imminent after he was transferred to Bill Mott. Racing on the dirt, Lion Cavern got off to a great start, winning a sevenfurlong allowance at Gulfstream, then reappearing three months later to carry top weight to victory in the GII True North H. over six furlongs. Unfortunately three defeats followed, confirming that Lion Cavern was very good, without quite belonging to the top flight.

The same could have been said, to a lesser extent, of Lion Cavern's famous brother Gone West. The Blood-Horse handicappers rated this GI Dwyer S. winner nine pounds below Alysheba and Java Gold as a three-yearold but that hasn't stopped him earning a stud fee of \$125,000. Gone West has a particularly fine record with mares by Northern Dancer's son The Minstrel and has also sired very good winners from daughters of numerous other Northern Dancer stallions. Lion Cavern too has sired some of his best winners, such as the Jpn-G3 winner Dublin Lion and the smart Beraysim, from grand-daughters of Northern Dancer, but it is interesting that neither Crimplene nor Peony have any Northern Dancer blood. Peony is inbred 4x4 to Bold Ruler. while Crimplene's pedigree features two lines to both Native Dancer and Mixed Marriage, thanks to her broodmare sire Diesis, who is enjoying a good year in this role.

KING'S BEST COMES THROUGH TEST

King's Best (USA) (Kingmambo {USA}), winner of the G1 2000 Guineas S. Newmarket May 6, and antepost favourite for the G1 Epsom Derby S. June 10. pleased connections in his racecourse work yesterday at Sandown. He travelled over ten furlongs of the Esher course in the morning, and stayed calm and relaxed, even when he was paraded in the afternoon during racing. Jockey Kieren Fallon said afterwards, "That was fine and that is the way he behaves at home. He's quite clever and was taking it all in." Trainer Sir Michael Stoute added, "The change of scenery was what we needed. As a two-year-old he ran two of his three races at Newmarket and his two this season have been at home. He was a little bit uptight when we took him down for the G2 Craven S., but he was quite relaxed this morning and it went remarkably well. He looked cool, but he'd have got warm if I'd taken his sheet off. He has been a natural from the beginning, and even before we started to gallop him we had hopes for him. I am convinced that in last year's Dewhurst S. he got his tongue pinched so we have fitted a Bowker bit, which keeps his tongue in position." When asked about Epsom, Stoute said, "A thorough study of his pedigree gives us hope but confidence wouldn't be the right word. I am just going to try and get him there in the best frame of mind that I possibly can, but a slight doubt must remain." Meanwhile, it was yesterday announced that Henry Cecil's trio of Derby hopes, Beat Hollow (GB) (Sadler's Wells {USA}), Wellbeing (GB) (Sadler's Wells {GB}), and Bien Entendu (GB) (Hernando (Fr)) will work in between racing on Wednesday at Yarmouth. Clerk of the Course David Henson confirmed that all three will work over a mile and three furlongs.

NO DECISION YET FOR GUEST

Barathea Guest (GB) (Barathea {Ire}) is in the G1 Epsom Derby S., but a decision to run will be made after trainer George Margarson can see how he has come out his fourth-place finish in last Saturday's G1 Irish 2000 Guineas S. Jockey Philip Robinson said of the horse, "The ground was faster than we thought, and a mile on that sort of ground would be as short as he wants these days. He wants a mile-and-a-quarter and possibly a mile-and-a-half. He's usually a bit low after a race so his trainer will have to see how he comes out of this before any decision is made."

SCENE IS SET FOR FILLIES' REMATCH

Crimplene (Ire) (Lion Cavern {USA}), winner of Sunday's G1 Irish 1000 Guineas S. at The Curragh, and Princess Ellen (GB) (Tirol {Ire}) are set to meet again in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 23, where they will also take on G1 2000 Guineas S. winner Lahan (GB) (Unfuwain {USA}). "She'll go for the Coronation S. and I think she'll stay at a mile for now, although the way she stayed on it looks like a mile-and-a-quarter would not be a problem," said trainer Clive Brittain. "I wouldn't want to make excuses but I hope it is not like a bog at Ascot." Gerard Butler, trainer of fifth-placed Princess Ellen, also cited Royal Ascot for his filly, "She was heavily in season-it is not an excuse I like to use, but at least it explains the run. Other than that, she is absolutely fine and there are no problems. The obvious race for her now is the Coronation S. at Royal Ascot and that looks like it is going to be an interesting race, to say the least."
